Flag up for grabs in race to the finals

Michael Barlow and James Podsiadly have put the spotlight on the VFL, and the competition has lived up to the hype with one of the most even seasons in recent times.



Pick up a newspaper, listen to the radio or switch on the television and there's a fair chance Michael Barlow and James Podsiadly will be, to use a football term, front and square.

Barlow and Podsiadly have captured the imagination of the football public with their stunning AFL debuts and put the focus on the VFL to a level never before seen.

Not before time people are now paying due respect to the VFL, which continues to grow in status.

As evidenced from the state match triumph against Western Australia, the VFL talent pool seemingly has no ceiling. Like Barlow and Podsiadly, all those aspiring players are only waiting for an opportunity to showcase their talent.

While many players emerged in the state match – Matthew Little, Ed Curnow, Peter Faulks, Stephen Clifton and Michael Stockdale to name but a few – they are not the only VFL players

whose performances have attracted attention from AFL scouts.

This is as a result of the competitive nature of the VFL. In the first half of the competition's season, we have seen on a number of occasions lowly-ranked sides upset their more fancied rivals to notch surprise victories.

With eight home and away matches remaining, only percentage separates the first three teams on the ladder, there is only two games from first to sixth and only Frankston seems out of final eight contention.

This equality throughout the competition provides ample time and opportunity not only for clubs to seal their finals fate, but also for players to continue to enhance their prospects so they can be playing in the AFL next season alongside Barlow and Podsiadly.

Recently, AFL Victoria has partnered with the AFL Coaches' Association and a Victorian Government initiative that focuses on addressing the issue of alcohol-related violence.

The 'Championships Moves' campaign encourages young men to help their mates by using 'moves' when they have had too much to drink and are headed for trouble. The campaign is one that everyone in the community should embrace in stamping out the problem and also in supporting the victims to help them get back on their feet.

Put simply, the Championship Moves campaign is all about delivering a straightforward message to young Victorians: real champions look out for their mates and respect everyone's right to a good time (for more information see page 11).

Alcohol-related violence affects all parts of society, including the AFL and VFL, and there is a responsibility on professional and semi-professional players to act in such a manner that they are revered as community role models.

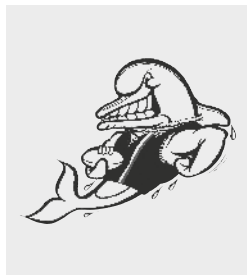
WERRIBEE TIGERS

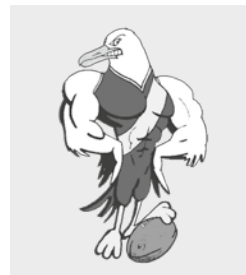
COBURG TIGERS

Playing for recreational purposes

A new form of football mixing genders, ages and rules has been introduced at community level.

Kick it to me!" screamed out Nicole who was playing forward for Ringwood Church of Christ. A centimetre-perfect pass from Peter found her in the scoring zone and kicking for a nine-point goal. With a chorus of support from the spectators, the resultant kick put the Ringwood team further ahead and sealed a grand final berth in the State Youth Games Under-18 AFL Recreational Football competition.

AFL Recreational Football was one of 30 sports played by church youth groups from all over Victoria in an action packed weekend of sports and activities in June for over 3000 young people organised by Youth Vision Victoria – the youth ministry arm of the Churches of Christ.

AFL Recreational Football is an exciting game with some abridged rules that has people from all

ages, ability levels and genders joining together to form social teams to play in local community competitions throughout Victoria's recreational reserves and parklands. AFL Recreational Football is non contact, easy to play, not physically demanding, can be played by all ages and genders and, most importantly, has an emphasis on fun and safety.

Played in a friendly social environment, it enables people of all ages and ability levels to participate in male, female or mixed teams. Goals kicked by girls attract a nine-point score, whereas goals from the boys only score six points. This has a dramatic effect on the team dynamic and encourages everyone to share scoring opportunities. Players also wear tags on their uniforms which, when grabbed by an opponent, indicates a successful tackle and the ball

must be surrendered to the other player, another innovation that encourages participants of all abilities and strengths.

This year the State Youth Games competition attracted 28 mixed teams in four divisions who battled it out in cool conditions in Warragul for the honour of AFL Recreational Football champions. The competition was exciting and played with fantastic spirit, with many games going down to the wire.

In Division A1, One Community defeated Ignite Youth by 15 points and in A2 Doncaster Church of Christ was able to overcome North Ringwood Uniting Church by a solitary goal. In Division A3, Warrandyte had the better of Ringwood Church of Christ by seven points, while in the last grand final, in division A4, Donvale Presbyterian defeated Warrandyte by only five points.

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Real champs look out for their mates

A new government campaign is reminding everyone that alcohol-fuelled violence can ruin lives.



The Championship Moves program encourages footballers to look after their mates.

AFL Victoria has chosen to partner with the Victorian Government to promote the 'Championship Moves' campaign to help tackle the issue of alcohol-related violence. Throughout the football season, AFL Victoria will undertake a variety of activities to help encourage young adult players to look out for themselves and their mates both after the game and when they're out on the town.

Alcohol-related violence is a big issue affecting our communities, and particularly young people. The statistics reveal the prevalence of the problem, as an average year in Victoria will see 1500 assaults in licensed premises, 10-15,000 people apprehended for public drunkenness, 2000 assaults involving young people affected by alcohol and 759 alcohol-related deaths.

In as much, it is clear to see the misuse of alcohol is having a major impact on our society. Closer to

home, this is also an issue that affects the AFL football community.

The Victorian Government is implementing a range of measures such as tougher liquor license regulations and increased bans and fines for disorderly behaviour and possession of weapons.

Yet, what is really important is personal responsibility and how young adults react in potentially violent situations and this is the focus of the Championship Moves campaign.

They are a series 'moves' a mate can pull to keep his friend away from trouble. There's the move known as the 'waterboy' (giving a mate a bottle of water); the 'muzzle' (cover your mate's mouth if he's shouting off at someone) and the 'receptionist' (using a fake phone call to get him out of trouble)

In reality, there are plenty of moves – most of them not rocket science. But if a mate applies one of these tactics to avoid trouble – to

avoid a fight – then he has done his mate a great favour.

The AFL Coaches' Association has also come on board to support this campaign in several ways.

The coaches will not only be relaying the messages back to their own clubs, but also making presentations to local coaches and players requesting they take the Championships Moves campaign messages back to their clubs to influence their players at a time when they are most at risk of falling victim to alcohol-related violence.

Furthermore, the AFLCA coordinated a meet and greet for Luke Adams and the Carlton Football Club, following Adams being a victim of alcohol-related violence in a fast food outlet in 2009. The coaches association is determined to support victims and help them get back on their feet.
