1. U/15 girls team Bumblebees seeking approval for Jessica Haydock to play in a lower grade. Only 1 year older than should be and has never played before.

2. Approval of late nominations.

U/17 girls team Panthers seeking to be allowed to join league even though nomination form late. Players were part of previous team that split but handed in form. 8. Aussie Hoops Programme Co-ordinator

Aaron Pedlar to run for first 6 weeks, hopefully juniors to help run and hopefully someone can take over during second half of the season. Possibility of purchasing free standing hoops, or adding struts and hoops to existing rings. Association to possibly cover the costs.

9. Country Week, Seeking a Co-ordinator to run for 2011. Suggestions for sign ups early in the season, possibly a parent could be manager.

**General Business.**
