- Run AFL Cairns Juniors U16 competition and U18 competition on rotation basis with other Junior Development Officers on Friday and Wednesday nights respectively.

- Run AFL Cairns Juniors U8, U10, U12 and U14 competition on rotation basis with other Junior Development Officers on Sundays
- Attend AFL Cairns Juniors Club training when possible
- Run Superclinics during school holidays
- Umpire Primary school competition
- Coordinate Secondary school competition
- Run summer development programs
- Other duties as requested
