1. A Nomination Fee of $\$ 40$ must accompany this nomination. The Nomination Fee Covers associated paperwork and data entry.

Teams forfeits - If a team forfeits there game and does not give 2 clear work days notice prior to the game they will be required to pay the game fee for failing to notify of the forfeit

Teams forfeiting due to representative commitments must have minimum of 3 rep players in the team
The team coach or contact person is the only person who can notify of a a forfeit to CHBA
2. Each team is required to nominate a minimum of seven (7) players
3. Match fees-OPTION 1-\$60 per game, per team x 16 rounds or OPTION 2-One payment of $\$ 912$ which covers 15 rounds (equals 5\% Discount).

To receive the $5 \%$ discount on season game fees, the total amount must be paid on or before Saturday 12th March 2011
4. Players must be registered with Coffs Harbour Basketball or an affiliate member (please see below for details).

The NSWBA Registration and Insurance fee for 12 month coverage. This is not payable to your school-it must be paid to CHBA
Players turning 11 years of age and under in 2011. Mini Ballers: $\$ 60.00$
Players turning 12 years \& 17 years and under as of 2011. Juniors: $\$ 65.00$
Players turning 18 years or over in 2011. Seniors: $\$ 75.00$
5. Referee Clinics are held during the year. If players or parents would like to attend a clinic they should contact CHBA Referees Co-Ordinator Sarah Mottram on 66523539
