Your team will be rostered to complete scorebench duty. Please provide four competent score bench personnel for your duty. Every effort will be made to assist teams when able. As Host we will cover the opening games each day plus semi-finals and finals (possibly other fixtures personnel permitting).

Team Roster

Please ensure that all your players are registered with the BBNZ office and are eligible to compete in the tournament.

Once a teams first game commences, only those players listed on the scoresheet for the first game may participate in the remainder of that Tournament as players. [BBNZ Internal Regulations F1.5]

There will be a spectator fee of \$2.00 per person per day.

Awards Ceremony

The awards ceremony will be held 15 minutes from the conclusion of the last game of the tournament.

Score Sheets

Scoresheets will be provided for each game.

Rubbish

Please be considerate and ensure your team removes any rubbish from the bench at the end of your game. Please do not leave rubbish in the changing rooms and leave in a tidy state for other teams.

Traffic in Auckland

Allow plenty of time to get to your games.

Disputes Procedure

In the unlikely event of a dispute the procedure is: the team captain is to sign the bottom of the score sheet in the box provided within 20 minutes of the completion of the game. The team then has one hour to lodge a written report and pay a bond payment of \$250 to the Tournament Director. A Judicial Committee will be assembled to consider the dispute. The Judicial Committee is made up of three representatives – Technical Commissioner, Tournament Director and a BBNZ Representative. If the Committee rules in favour of the dispute, the bond will be refunded to the team.

Important Details

- Forfeit of Game - \$500 fine.
- Uniforms – in the event of a clash Team A is to wear their light coloured uniforms and Team B is to wear their dark coloured uniforms, unless teams can come to a mutual agreement.
- Team Benches – Sitting at the scorebench; Team A **MUST** sit to the left and Team B **MUST** sit to the right. Please ensure all games start correctly with this procedure. Only the rostered players and management are allowed to sit on the team bench. All supporters must sit in the stands.
- Scorebench - If there is a problem with the scorebench, only the coach may approach on a dead ball and then ask the referee to check the enquiry. Other management may approach the bench during the 2 minute break at quarter time and at half time. They **MUST NOT** approach the bench any other time to check the score sheet or query the scorebench.
- The tournament will use BBNZ Internal Regulations and FIBA Rules.
- The top four teams from each zone will qualify for the U17 National Championships. Please note that the host of the U17 National Championship will gain automatic entry of 1 x mens and 1 x womens team.
- The U17 National Championships will be host by North Harbour Basketball Association June 3-6 at the North Shore Events Centre, Silverfield Lane, Glenfield, North Shore.
