Code of Conduct

All players and parents participating in the Tenambit Soccer Club agree to abide by the standards of conduct outlined.

- Racist or sexist, comments or acts will not be tolerated and will result in the immediate expulsion from Tenambit Soccer Club Inc and may result in legal action being taken.
- Theft of any kind, vandalism or wilful damage to any Tenambit Soccer Club Inc property or equipment will result in the immediate expulsion from Tenambit Soccer Club and may result in legal action being taken.

Players

1. During training sessions, all players are expected to conduct themselves in a manner, which enables and promotes a learning atmosphere for everyone there. Abusive language and behaviour or disrespectful acts towards teammates, coaches, managers, referees, officials and Club administrators will not be tolerated.
2. Sportsmanlike conduct is the rule at all times. This includes showing respect for officials, competitors, teammates, coaches and the public. A player represents the Tenambit Soccer Club at all times whilst wearing Tenambit Soccer Club Inc clothing. Your actions reflect on the Club both on and off the field and the player is to behave appropriately at all times.
3. Players must attend all training sessions and matches. If they are unable to attend training or games the coaching staff must be notified prior to the training session or games.
4. All junior players must be at the ground 30 minutes prior to the start of their game. Senior players must be at the ground 45 minutes prior to the start of the game. Or as directed by their respective coaching staff.
5. All players are expected to support all Tenambit Soccer Club social and fund raising activities as required.

Coaching Staff

1. Encourage players by using positive and supportive methods. Criticism and abuse from a team's coaching staff will not be tolerated.
2. Abusive behaviour towards match officials or opposition representatives will not be tolerated.
3. Coaching staff must attend all games and training sessions.
4. Coaching staff must attend all Coaches & Managers meetings.
5. Report any problems or issues that may affect the individual, team or Club, immediately to the Club executive.
6. Participate in grading sessions as required.
7. Continually strive to develop personal coaching skills.
8. Develop both individual and team skills.
9. Gain assistance from the Club Coach as required.
10. Maintain Club equipment in good order. Report any problems to the Gear Steward as soon as practical

Parents and Supporters

1. Encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and Officials at all games and training sessions. Abusive language or behaviour will not be tolerated.
2. Provide support for coaches and club officials working with your child to provide a positive, enjoyable experience for all.
3. Encourage from the sideline do not coach.

Violations of the Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary action up to and including immediate expulsion or non-retention for the following year as determined by the Tenambit Soccer Club Executive.
