

2010 President's Report

On The Field ~ Netball A great effort Netballers, four teams played finals and were very competitive with the 17 & under going all the way and winning back to back flags — well done young Ladies. To Julie Gerrand thank for your commitment and hard work this year. The Netball has certainly improved this year as evidenced by the majority of teams making finals.



Congratulations to A Grade on reaching the preliminary final, B Grade reaching the elimination final, C Grade reaching the preliminary final and 17 & under winning the grand final as well it's worth mentioning that the 17 and under are undefeated in 2 years of competition a fantastic effort girls. A special mention to D Grade who, even though they didn't make the finals had some good wins during the year.

I think the senior netballers have benefited from the 17 and Under participation which has given an injection of youth and enthusiasm as well as extra depth to draw players from. This augers well for the future of Netball at Rosedale.

On Field ~ Football We had a settled start to 2010 with the reappointment of Damien Birss Senior Coach, appointment of Steve Grover as Reserves Coach and reappointment of Chris King Under 18's Coach which was subtle development of last years coaching personnel. Steve Grover took over as reserves coach from Daniel Hopman.

I take this opportunity to thank Hoppy for his coaching contribution in 2009. Hoppy had the same old difficulty with numbers last season but battled on and never stopped ringing players to encourage them to train and play, it must have been heartening to see what the reserves were capable of through this season.

The season start was a change from recent years as we had a full pre-season from mid January right through to the season start. It certainly proved to be a telling factor given that the seniors played off in the grand final and the reserves finished on top of the ladder after the home and away season. The under eighteens were unfortunate in that they started really well and looked to be a finalist yet a cruel run of injuries to top players reduced their bench to nil from halfway through the season onwards.

Performance ~ **Seniors** The seniors had a mixed start to the season dropping games against lower opposition due to inconsistency. As the season progressed the seniors had some good wins against quality opposition to get back on track. Towards the end of the season it become evident that the battle for fifth spot would be between Heyfield and Rosedale, the boys came through with a good win over Heyfield at Heyfield to sew up fifth spot.

Any side that finishes fifth is regarded as the chopping block for the other finalists however our players had other ideas. A strong win by 74 points in the elimination final over last year's grand finalists Churchill started proceedings, the following week in the first semi-final a win by

102 points over 3rd placed Glengarry ensured a showdown with Gormandale in the preliminary final for a crack at the grand final. A fighting come from behind win by 57 points ensured that our players had the chance for ultimate glory the following week against Sale City.

As fairy tales go it was not to be and Sale City won by 29 points. Even though Birssy and the players were tremendously disappointed they can look back on 2010 as the year that Rosedale Football Netball Club rocked the NGFNL by coming from 5th and playing off in the Grand Final. I'm sure there would have been some angst amongst the teams that had to play our boys during that finals series.

Now that the players know what is needed to play deep into finals and ultimately win the big one, I'm sure this is not too far away.

Congratulations to Birssy for a great year, the work put into this season by him should not be underestimated as well as recruiting, arranging training camps and time spent going over the team plan as well as getting the best out of his players he was always available to us as a committee and players alike. Thanks Birssy and the senior eighteen for a successful and entertaining season. (Next year we may need to have a carton of smokes carried by the trainers for when things get tight in a game)

Reserves ~ The reserves under Steve Grover had a fine season finishing on top of the ladder with only one loss. This was tempered however by the losses in finals which meant a flag was not to be this year. I consider that the season was successful in that players were at training a lot more and most participated in pre-season training, this directly helped the senior team who could draw from fit and match hardened players, a far cry from previous seasons.

Well done for a good effort by the reserves players of 2010 you showed that you can win games regularly. The finals series showed inexperience, however learning from this year should take you on to better things in 2011. So keep your fitness and start 2011 as you started 2010.

Thanks Steve for a great year, it may not have finished the way we wanted it to but good progress was made with the reserves so you should be proud of your efforts.



Under Eighteens ~ *Chris King did a lot of work and contacting pre-season to generate a strong team, despite all his efforts the fickle nature of footballers meant that a lot who promised to come and play preferred the easy option of going off to play at other clubs with their mates.*

Kingy kept up the training and encouragement and we saw results with some good wins early in the season. They headed the ladder early and looked about to repeat the tradition of our under 18's featuring in finals on a regular basis when severe injuries struck down a number of our top players. With a small bench in the first place this was to prove the Achilles heel for the team as they could never have a bench to rest and recuperate, in this modern game of Aussie Rules these rests are crucial to winning and the players were unable to perform at their best.


