### **COACHES AND SCORER INFORMATION**

Please make sure these instructions are followed as a team lost a point last week due to the following:

Scorers need to fill out the official score sheet with the players names spelt as they are registered. eg, Madeleine Plant, not Maddy Plant etc. Please make sure all scorers have the correct spelling.

From round 5 all names on score sheets are to be correct (spelling and full name). Remind all coaches that any fill-ins used need their age/section beside their name.

#### Loss of 1 premiership point for every infringement

Please ensure that "fill in" players are noted on the score sheet. It is most important that scorers write on the sheet which age group and section the player usually play in. (ie Madeleine Plant 15/4's) we don't want to lose points from these mistakes.

Coaches and players also need to be aware that if they require a "fill in" player, they need to keep track of how many games the player has played "up". Players are allowed to play as many games as they like in a higher age group. Eg: Under 15's can play any amount of games in U/17's or U/11's up in U/13's or 15's etc.

You are only allowed to play two games within their own age group. Eg: U/13'5 player can only play two games for any other higher U/13 team (not two in the section 2 team and two in section 3 team) If you are confused, ask a committee member or at the office. If there's any doubt, err on the side of caution and don't play them!! Points are hard to come by and we don't want to lose them.

Court 6 will be available as a warm up court from 10:45am until 1:45pm.

NO TEAMS are to use court 6 between 9:40am & 10:45am during the NetSetGo session.

Change ends at intervals 1 & 2 and 3 & 4. Do not enter court to coach, players should not leave the court. Drinks bought to the side line.

Remain at court "bench" – where you start is where you stay, this includes team manager/assistant coach and bench players.

- UMPIRE CONVENER—Attend committee meetings. Provide club umpiring roster. Allocate umpires to games. Support trainee umpires. Keep records.
- UNIFORM CONVENER—Attend committee meetings. Order new uniforms. Manage uniforms on selection day. Organise second hand sales. Maintain records.
- PURCHASHING OFFICER— Attend committee meetings. Arrange coaching bags. Replenish coaching bags. Maintain records. Purchase club requisites.
- INFORMATION OFFICER—Attend committee meetings. Produce club newsletter, update website.
   Produce Flyers.
- · GENERAL COMMITTEE—Attend committee meetings. Assist committee members where necessary.
