Penrith Swans JAFC welcomes all clubs for the preliminary final games to be held at Greygums Oval on Saturday 30th August 2008. All games will be played on Oval #1 which is closest to Greygums Rd.

Coach & Team Manager Information

Ground Managers / Timekeeping & First Aid station tent will be located on the western side of Oval#1, opposite the team dugouts. **Home teams** will use the dugout nearest the canteen end , **Away teams** the northern end dugout.

1. Team sheets are required at the Ground Managers table 15mins prior to start time.
2. Boundary & goal umpires fees per team total \$25 , are to handed to Ground Manager prior to game start time. For U10's and U11's fees are \$10.00 per team
3. A second approved interchange will be used only for "players sent off " this will be located in front of the ground managers tent on the opposite side of the oval, the regular interchange will be located between the dugouts.
4. Change rooms are available and will be clearly marked Home & Away
5. Comply to the "Codes of Conduct" as set down by GSJ Competiton Rules & By Laws

Parent /Spectator Information

1. Parking will be available behind the amenities block at the southern end of the ground and along Greygums road. Please do not block or park across resident driveways in the area . Unfortunately this has happened in the past and it does make it difficult for the club.
2. Spectators must remain behind the fence for U11's and above, for U10's parents & spectators we will mark, with training cones, the spectator area on the main oval.
3. No animals or consumption of alcohol permitted. Smoking is not encouraged and is not allowed inside the fence of Greygums Oval regardless.
4. Canteen & BBQ will be available all day.
5. All spectators & parents must abide by the AFL Code of Conduct ,anyone breaching the Code of Conduct will be asked to leave Greygums Oval immediately . A copy of the Code of Conduct for Parents & spectators can be provided by your Team Manager , Coach or Club Committee

Contingency Plans

In the event that times are delayed due to tied games (ie extra time), the Management Team may decide to compensate by moving the u12 match to Oval #2, thus allowing u14s-u16s to commence as per normal advertised time on Oval #1.

In the event of fading daylight or reduced visibility, the Host club will switch on the light towers as per the discretion of the Match Referee.
