President Dale Burton thanked all interleague coaches and assistants for their fantastic voluntary efforts which bring so much joy and benefit to players in our League.

Query raised about numbers on the field and after lengthy discussion, the By –laws hold true and will be the guide for all matches ie.

- Each team may consist of up to 24 players maximum
- A minimum of 12 players is required to play
- A maximum of 16 players or 18 (max) by agreement are allowed on the ground during play.
- Given the above, Clubs can agree to vary the numbers on the field based on the team sheets provided to the umpire **20 minutes** prior to the match commencing.
- Games must start with equal numbers on the field
- Clubs must maximise the playing opportunities for all players on the team sheets including numbers on the ground.

The CDJFL Executive in attendance will decide the outcome of any dispute.
