AGENDA

1. **FEES UPDATE**
 - About six team registration fees have been received.
 - U/12 registrations have about 50% received.

2. **HEALTHY CLUB SPONSORSHIP**
 - Subsidize our referee/coaching courses.
 - Banner/logos to on display if sponsorship received.

3. **COACHING/REFEREE COURSES**
 - Friday 21st October proposed at NSHS for coaching course.
 - Referees' course Level 1 \$88.00 – There are three levels: Intermediate Association, Senior Association and Advanced (WABL etc)

4. **TRIBUNAL**

Members for the committee will be contacted by the association.

5. **INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATIONS**
 - 2 X 16yr and 4 x 14yr boys – Possibility of making a team or two players may be taken by Jayden's team and/or K. Heil's team. Contact Graeme Mason.

6. **UMPIRING CO-ORDINATORS**

Names for those able to go on rosters will be made available to co-ordinators.

7. **CASUAL PLAYERS – BY –LAWS**
 - ONLY to make up to six players in a team.
 - NOT covered by insurance as a casual player (because no registration fees is paid).
 - \$10.00 is to be paid to the Control Room for a pass.
 - NOT eligible for final series.
 - NOT eligible for Fairest and Best votes.
 - Three games maximum – then must register and pay full fees or half season fees whichever is applicable. The casual fees paid will NOT be deducted.
 - Higher grade playing by a registered player will incur an additional fee for a permanent position and will appear on the scoresheet.
 - Higher grade player (not registered in the team) is a casual player - \$10 fee to be paid to the Control Room.

8. **POSTPONEMENT OF GAMES**

If you wish to postpone a game:

 - Request a change from one team contact to the other team contact.
 - If opposition does not want the change – then the team requesting change is to forfeit.
 - If OKAY – Then make a date, time and book the leisure centre court.
Advise the umpires and if they are not available, organise own umpires.
 - Clear first half of season postponed games by Christmas break.
 - No rescheduled games are to be made for the last two weeks of the season 2012.

9. **FIXTURES**
 - These are not finalised yet.
 - M & Ms (girls) and Ag College (boys) have withdrawn.

10. **AUSSIE HOOPS**
 - 4 – 5 PM. Wednesdays.
 - 24 registered today.
 - Still open and taking names.
 - Commence second week of Term 4.
 - Drop down boards should be here by then.
11. **U/12 COMPETITION**
 - 32 registrations received so far, expecting about 40.
 - These will be split into teams – one complete girl's team and three teams of boys.
 - Majority of time will be spent on skills and drills, perhaps 3 on 3.
 - Week 5, 10 and 15 will play games of 5 on 5.
 - Three coaches will be required and the fourth is Graeme Mason.
12. **U/14 BY LAWS**
 - No zone defence – man on man
 - Coaches will be upskilled on this by-law so that there will be less confusion.
 - This will be brought in over the season.
13. **FUNDRAISING – GLORIA RADFORD**
 - Town Council approval for Coffee Machine to be in the foyer – leased from Hockey.
 - Money made will go towards a coffee machine for the Centre.
 - Thursday Nights – hockey canteen will be available for food purchases.
 - Raffle – Permit will be gained – Team contacts will be notified of their commitments for their teams eg. Hamper items.
 - Wheelbarrow has been already received.
 - Teams will donate an item to the value of \$50. (lists of items will be provided).
14. **EQUIPMENT**
 - Spring rings and adjustable backboards have been purchased.
 - The Basketball Office is “decked out” now thanks to Graeme.
 - Trestle tables will be purchased for the courts.
 - The scoreboards will be tested for operation.
 - Whistle can be purchased from the control room – but best to bring your own.
