

# Aussie Hoops

Club/Association Agreement



## What is Aussie Hoops?

Aussie Hoops is about kids having FUN and experiencing basketball skills. The activities can be played all year round, inside or outside and can be enjoyed by children of all abilities including kids with mobility, vision or hearing impairments.

The Aussie Hoops program has a range of resources to help teachers, coaches and parents run the program. The aim of the program is for kids to:

- Have FUN;
- Learn new basketball skills;
- Spend time with old and new friends;
- Be safe.

The program, its logo, printed material and merchandise are the sole property of Basketball Australia and may not be used by the Association in any manner except under these terms and conditions or with the express written consent of Basketball Australia.

Aussie Hoops provides insurance coverage for all participants of the program under the Basketball Australia National Insurance Scheme.

Basketball Australia respects the rights and obligations of the *Privacy Act 2000* and only uses data obtained purely for basketball purposes.

## How is Aussie Hoops Delivered?

Associations/clubs can run Aussie Hoops at schools or at their stadium. Doing Aussie Hoops in schools is a great way to reach a large number of kids because every kid goes to school! The “In school program” can be during or after school time, can be a “one-off” session or weekly program. Aussie Hoops at the stadium can be an excite session, holiday camp or a weekly program during the school term.

There are a plenty of activities you can do, handy session plans and activity cards mean that coaches, parents or even teenagers can easily run a session. All they need is a sense of fun!

Associations/clubs can use the Aussie Hoops brand such as “Darwin Basketball Aussie Hoops” as well as the program merchandise and resources. This connects them to Associations throughout Australia and also to our national leagues where Aussie Hoops is a presence at games. Associations/clubs can sign up for Aussie Hoops by contacting their state/territory association. This then entitles them to the following benefits.

- Affordable and quality merchandise for participants;
- A full range of presenter gear for people delivering the program;
- Assistance from state/territory;
- Resources such as Association Guide, Coaches Manual, DVDs and session plans;
- A comprehensive National Insurance Scheme;
- Access to restricted website information;
- Aussie Hoops stadium signage;
- Listed on Aussie Hoop Association locator;
- National recognition.

The state/territory association can work with you to determine the best way to run the program for your association.

## Terms and Conditions

Basketball Australia is the owner of the Aussie Hoops program and in collaboration with state and territory associations has designed and developed all printed material, associated artwork and merchandise in which, it owns the rights to and the brand name "Aussie Hoops."

There are many benefits to being an Aussie Hoops club or association and only those that have signed an agreement can use the Aussie Hoops name.

Your obligations under this agreement are:

- (a) To name your introductory junior program (for kids aged up to 12) Aussie Hoops. You are encouraged to use your name (eg the Gloucester Magpies Aussie Hoops program).
- (b) You may run a number of programs for young children, from learn to play to competition. You do not have to call each stage "Aussie Hoops". However, what must be called Aussie Hoops is a skill development program that is focused on FUN!;
- (c) Ensuring Aussie Hoops is presented as a fun activity for all children at their level of choice and ability;
- (d) To only use Aussie Hoops or the state/territory association endorsed equipment and merchandise is used in the program;
- (e) Register participants as required by your state/territory association;
- (f) Offer online registration for all programs. Registrations can also be taken offline.
- (g) Record the following data and provide it to your state association, who will also provide it to Basketball Australia:
  - Number of schools visited (if any);
  - Number of kids seen at school (this can be an estimate based on class sizes);
  - Number of Aussie Hoops members (a member is someone that has

paid you to do an Aussie Hoops session and has provided basic contact details to you).

- (h) Get the approval of your state/territory association before for any local sponsorship of your Aussie Hoops program.
- (i) Agrees to indemnify and keep indemnified Basketball Australia and their officers, directors, committee members, employees and agents from and against all claims, actions, suits, proceedings, causes of action, damages, losses, demands, moneys, costs and expenses (including legal costs) arising or incurred by the association directly or indirectly in connection with any act, omission or misconduct by this association/club or any breach or non-performance by us of our obligations under these terms and conditions of use.
