
OVERVIEW

- Strengthen and develop the Youth Girls competition Under 12 19, teams from Altona, St Albans, Wyndhamvale, Melton and Melton Centrals with a database of over 100 female participants and club officials administering the clubs
- Strengthen and develop the Victorian Women's football competition, teams from Braybrook, Melton Centrals and VU St Albans with a database of over 150 female participants and club officials



- Database of over 80 community club officials administering clubs from the Riddell FL, Victorian Amateur FL, Western Region FL, Essendon District FL and the Ballarat FL
- Delivery of community strengthening programs to assist with developing the structures that underpin junior development at the grass roots level including Quality Club Program, Kids First Program, Government grants and funding support and volunteer recruitment and retention guidance
- Presentation at league president and secretary meetings to provide guidance, updates and direction on key portfolio activities



- Delivery of AFL player visits to the region from various AFL Clubs:
 - \circ 90 primary school visits with 16840 students participating
 - o 10 secondary school visits with 391 students participating
 - o 24 junior club visits with 2331 players participating
 - o 38 Auskick centre visits with 2870 kids participating
 - 5 Super-clinics with 450 kids participating
