CORRIMAL Rangers, Founded in 1891, were one of the founder members of the then South Coast League. Steeped in history, the club won its first trophy in 1893, winning the Bode Cup against Balgownie 2-1.

1943 was one of the club's most successful seasons on record, winning the NSW Premier League, the Sheahan Cup and the Gibson Cup, clean sweep.

In modern times Rangers Reserve won the old Premier League Reserve Grade trophy in 1978, 1982 and Grand final winners in 1985.

Of late, Corrimal have struggled to maintain its high standard of performance, but in its youth, have a shining light for the future, with some promising displays this season.

Last week the First grade put in a fighting display of their own against Thirroul going down 1-0, while the week before only lost 2-0 to third placed Helensburgh.

In the cross over rounds, Corrimal put in a inspired performance, but eventually lost to heavy-weights Balgownie 2-0, while narrowly losing 1-0 at Bellambi, so on this form, improvement can be expected.

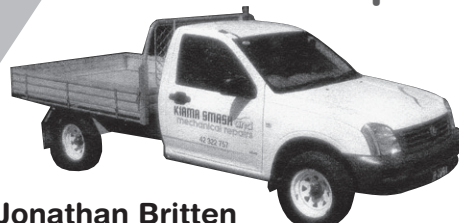

WHISTLE HAPPY REF SPOILS A GOOD GAME

Kiama 3 Helensburgh 1

ONCE again Kiama Quarriers just got the better of Helensburgh Thistle in a great IFA District League game in The Quarry last Saturday, coming away with all the three points in a 3-1 thriller.

When the two teams last met back in April, Round 3, Kiama pinched all three points converting a controversial free-kick from the edge of the area to win 2-1 in the 91st minute.

Third placed Helensburgh, had carried some baggage over from that game and came out firing, totally dominating the first 15 minutes of play. So it was no surprise to see the visitors hit the front with a well-worked one-touch passing movement goal from Jason Wellings.

After the hectic pace started to slow down, Kiama hit their straps and slowly realised it was "game on" and a defeat was on the cards. Playing some constructive football and feeding Blake Coates up front with some intelligent balls, the hosts started to dominate.

Paul Gaffney once again inserted his style of play on the game and was a constant threat

from distance, while Coates and Keiron Duncan worked well against an organised well disciplined defence.

After a Duncan effort was pushed over the bar in the 22nd minute, Kiama did manage to level the scores moments later when Gaffney rifled in a pass into the area from the left which Coates managed to control, turn and score from 15 metres in a crowded goalmouth.

With the score at 1-1, Kiama lifted to another level, but full credit to Helensburgh which kept pushing forward and created four corners in the space of 20 minutes to try and regain control. Helensburgh's leading scorer, Mark Balbi, was a constant threat, but was subdued by Brett Fleming and teenager, Brendon Apperley, who continues to impress with his solid workmanlike performances at the back.

It was turning into an excellent game of football, with both sides committed to the cause, but some niggling fouls and yellow cards handed out like confetti at a wedding, with both the referee and players alike starting to bring the game down to a debacle rather than the spectacle it could have been.

But Kiama hit the front when a long through ball by Gary Vian found Coates wide out left, and after some wonderful skill, managed to piledrive his shot from an angled 15 metres, beating the keeper on his near post.

If the first half told the viewing fans anything about the game, the second period proved it, with the carried over baggage from the teams first encounter against each other from Round 3, railroading over a perfectly good contest.

The referee's whistle became like a world cup vuvuzela, with its constant thrill from the man in middle blowing his whistle. 8 yellow cards and 2 reds were handed out over the course of the second half, in a game which was sometimes spiteful, but by no means negative. Just two teams wanting to win, as second place on the ladder was up for grabs!

Helensburgh were playing a very tight back four, pushing up to the halfway line at every opportunity, often catching Coates, Duncan and Gaffney offside several times.

But by plying that tactic and in such a close game, it has to be precise, and on the hour mark Gaffney's speed, managed to unlock the offside trap and round the keeper to score with a very cheeky goal to make it 3-1.

As the game started to get physical due to no direction from the man in the middle, players frustrations started to boil over, denying the

public viewing audience of some of the games more animated players. Both Gaffney and Wellings receiving their marching orders with only 8 minutes remaining.

After the weekends results, the ladder stands at Balgownie still four points clear at the top, but Kiama has extended its lead over Helensburgh to ten points.

The Youth grade found it hard to break down a resolute Helensburgh defence, but to both teams credit battled away for 90 minutes to come away with a deserved 1-1 draw. Barry Jones dispatched his penalty at the second attempt to equalise after 18 minutes, but Jacob Cooper missed from the spot 10 minutes later.

Both sides fought hard to garner all three points but it just wasn't to be and the game ended all even.

The result means that Kiama are still on the top its league, but now only two points clear of Balgownie (33pts) and Shellharbour Falcons a further three back in third on 30pts.

Earlier in the day, the Kiama reserves lost 3-2 to Woonona. 3-0 down at one stage, The Quarriers staged an almighty comeback but just failed to score that all important equaliser in the end.

TODAY's rosters pits Corrimal Rangers against the Quarriers District League teams, while the Division One side travel to University and are in with a chance of gaining its fifth win of the season.
