CORRIMAL RANGERS got off to a solid start with a 1-1 draw against one of the league's title aspirants, Woonona, on the opening day of the 2012 season.

In Round 2 Corrimal came across current ladder leaders, Kemblawarra, losing 3-1, themselves a title contender.

Rangers have met with some stiff opposition so far in its opening two rounds, so today's encounter against a Quarriers side still searching for its first win, but neither undefeated, will be a good test in what should be another close game in The Quarry.

The last time the two teams met was last season in the cross-over Round 9 which resulted a stalemate 2-2 draw.

Previously it was in July 2010 when Corrimal last visited The Quarry in a very close game ending in a 2-1 win for The Quarriers.

Corrimal were resolute throughout and it was only a penalty in the 63rd minute dispatched by Val Tasevski which broke the deadlock.

Steve Allen equalised in the 68th minute from a corner, but it was a second penalty again by Tasevski which gave all three points to the Quarriers in a fortuitous win.

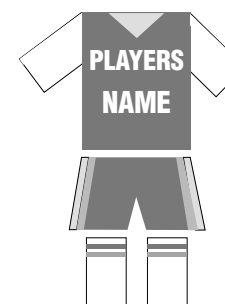
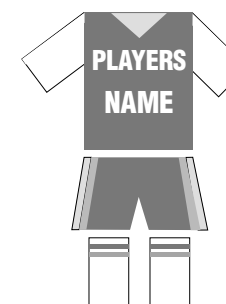
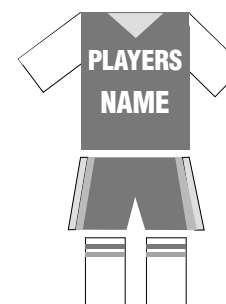

period, scrambling the ball over the line.

But Kiama, to its credit, dug deep and always looked dangerous on the counter attack.

Speedy strike partners, Daniel Swinton and Jamie Kadwell were always a threat and support from the strong running of midfielder Danielle Pisani helped the strikers' cause, while the tenacious Trent Cruickshank niggled away at the Berkeley midfield often regaining possession on loose balls.

A tiring Steve Parkes made way for Jacob Cooper on the hour which sparked Kiama into life as the youngster linked up well with Kadwell, Forrester and Swinton down the left.

On the 58th minute mark one such move produced the goal of the game. Forrester in his own half found Kadwell out wide and after turning a defender in a two-touch move found the onrushing Swinton who smashed the ball home from close range for a well deserved equaliser.

Berkeley then chased the game and in a goal-mouth melee, hit the bar with a close-in header with Guden stranded, but at the other end Swinton went close again only to see his shot balloon over the bar with minutes remaining.

THE RESERVE team went down 2-0 in a hard fought game which at one point could have gone

either way as Kiama played well in patches and dominated periods of play.

Sweeper, James Spence, controlled the back four of Nathan Harrod, Pete Tidswell, Elvis Necovski and Jeremy Bull well and orchestrated the team from his deep position while organising midfield players in front of him. Midfielder John Dover was a stand out chasing every ball and supported by Jacob Cooper and winger Aaron Murphy which threatend on occasion.

The Quarriers however, gave the ball away far too often in dangerous places and eventually paid the price midway through the first half to go a goal down.

Kiama were always working the ball out wide to Aaron Murphy, who played well under the circumstances, but was missing the target man for that final telling pass.

THE YOUTH Grade completed a remarkable comeback having gone 2 goals down early on to claw its way back into the game and eventually over run Berkeley 3-2 in a pulsating finish to an exciting game.

Kyle Noronha (2) and Josh Keatley were on target for the Quarriers in an entertaining game which saw two red cards and some frustration towards the end of the tie as Kiama managed to stay focussed at the job at hand with Daniel Sigmund a stand out performer in defence.

THE Quarriers started the season off with a workmanlike 2-2 draw against Berkeley in its ICU District League in The Quarry last Saturday.

It was a new-look Quarriers which took to the field after its mass-exodus of players from last season. Only Kerian Duncan was a recognisable face among the starting line-up, with a sprinkling of last year's reserves and a few old faces having their second spell at the club.

In a lively start on a hot autumn day, it was The Quarriers who took the lead, when Steve Parkes drifted into the area from his wide position and beat the keeper with a fine strike from 12m in the 14th minute.

Kiama had the better of the play in the early stages, but Berkeley slowly came back into the game in the latter part of the half and equalised in the 38th minutes with a wonderful headed goal, which gave Kiama keeper, Volkan Guden no chance.

Kiama's back four of Jay Reid, Sean Poulton, Jason Forrester and Keiron Duncan and aided by the deep lying Kel Ferguson, were put under pressure for the remainder of the half but held firm.

The Quarriers were immediately again under pressure from the restart and Berkeley continued where they left off and scored within minutes of the commencement of the second
