3X3Geelong

Participation Divisions Playing Conditions, Rules and Participation Agreement

The participation division of the 3X3Geelong tournament is the first of its kind to be conducted in Australia under FIBA's new format for 3 on 3 basketball.

Any group of players may enter this division, provided they meet any necessary age limits.

Groups of friends are encouraged to form a team and play together, although club or association teams are welcome to enter!

Preliminary Games in the participation division are being played at the Geelong Arena or Corio Leisuretime Centre, and finals, weather and conditions permitting, will be played at the Geelong Waterfront.

Games will be played across the three days of the Queens Birthday long weekend, from June 9 through 11.

Playing Conditions

The players, both individually and as a team, acknowledge the following:

- Some games of this event event are being held outdoors, on bitumen, and this carries a different risk to regular basketball games
- Being an outdoor event, the event will be subjected to inconsistent weather conditions, and while Organisers may choose to relocate games to an alternate location, this is completely at the discretion of the Organisers, who will make such decisions to ensure the event can be completed within the allotted timeframes and in the best interests of the event
- Otherwise, participants acknowledge that this is the first time this type of event has been conducted in Australia, and that the Organisers have sole discretion to modify or amend the structure of the competition, if necessary, to ensure the integrity and fairness of the event

Rules

The tournament will be played under rules established by FIBA for the conduct of FIBA33 events. These rules are published separately in short form and are available from the competition website www.3x3geelong.com.au.

Team Participation Agreement

The team acknowledges the following items relating to participation in the event:

- This is a "play by entry" event, and as such, acceptance of your team entry to compete is completely at the discretion of the Organisers
- 24 team entries will be accepted in each age group. However, should sufficient quality entries be received the Organisers may extend this provided a quality competition environment can be created and supported
- Whether the final competition is made up of 24 or more teams, the Organisers have the final and sole discretion to select the teams which will compete in the elite division
- All team members acknowledge that data based on their participation in the event (contact details, team and individual performance) will be uploaded by the Organisers to the FIBA 3x3 planet website, for the purpose of establishing worldwide 3x3 rankings
- All team members acknowledge that data based on their participation in the event (contact details, team and individual performance) will be uploaded to Basketball Australia's official 3x3 participation database
- Teams shall wear identical coloured singlets or t-shirts. Teams must have both light and dark uniform or t-shirt sets to allow for colour clashes. In the event of a colour clash, then the first named team shall change its shirts.

- If the uniforms have playing numbers, then numbers 0 through 99 only are permitted. Players shall not swap uniform numbers throughout the tournament
- Players will wear shorts of the same style and colour, without external pockets, throughout the tournament
