REGISTRATION INFORMATION SUMMER SEASON 2012/13

Dear Vulture Club Members,

A few IMPORTANT housekeeping and vital information needs to be addressed before you commit to the new season. They are:-

❖ Registrations Due Date

All registration forms **MUST** be submitted no later than **Friday 3rd August 2012** either via email to mnicey@bigpond.net.au or handed in at one of the registration nights or sent to P.O. Box 169 Vermont 3133. Please ensure ALL details are filled in correctly.

All teams must be submitted to the Junior Committee **by 24th August 2012**. Any late registrations will be placed on a waiting list and if there is availability on a team, your child may be placed there.

❖ Team Selection

Making up teams is very difficult and your empathy and understanding regarding make up of teams would be appreciated.

The Team Manager or Coach will be sent the list of their team and they will make contact with you welcoming your child to the team. If you are unhappy regarding your selected team you will need to put your concerns in writing (not email) outlining your reason(s) and address it to The President, P.O. Box 169 Vermont 3133. **Please do not telephone the Club** as this will be a Committee decision and they will meet to consider your objection at a given date and only those in writing will be considered.

* Once teams have been finalised Registration Fees **will not** be refunded. If you are faced with certain circumstances please discuss your situation in strictest confidence with the Club President who will consider your request.

** Clearances will be not given if deemed unfinancial.

❖ Teams

Once teams are finalised, that is it. If you are also playing another sport or have extracurricular activities and are concerned that this will clash with your basketball commitment, then we urge you to seriously consider your options. We cannot finalise teams only to have players pull out due to training clashes or assignment of coaches at the eleventh hour. This has occurred whereby teams have been left struggling to field a team. If we can't field a team the cost of a Walkover is \$70.00. Withdrawal of a team will incur a cost of \$170.

❖ Training Days and Times

Many volunteer hours is required to manage and coordinate training. If you know that you have specific commitment on a given night and it means that your child will be unable to train on that evening –we may be able to take this into account when deciding the teams. However you need to be aware that your child may not be in a team of his or her standard and we may not be able to accommodate your request.

Please remember that playing basketball at a club level is not only about learning the game and developing skills, it is a chance for your child to meet new people and to give them the opportunity to step out of their comfort zone in a controlled manner for only 2 hours in a week.

We hope this doesn't deter your passion for basketball, but we felt it necessary to ensure everyone is aware of what is required to run the Vermont Vultures Basketball Club successfully.
