GRADING SECRETARY

As many of you would realise this club, and Knox Basketball, relies heavily on volunteer input to ensure that the 4,600 junior players in the Knox Association are able to take to the court each week. One of the critical roles in the association is that of Grade Secretary.

As a club, the Falcons are required to supply at least two Grade Secretaries to Knox Junior Domestic Competition. This season, after completing the role for many seasons, Geoff Oxlade has decided to retire from the role leaving the club with only one nominated Grade Secretary.

The committee of the Ferntree Gully Basketball Club would like to thank Geoff for undertaking this role on behalf of all the members of the club.

With Geoff stepping down we need to source at least one more volunteer to undertake this vital role.

In brief, as a Grade Secretary you will be allocated either boys or girls and usually one or two age groups. The Grade Secretary is required to:

- Watch as many games as possible during the grading season (you will receive free entry to all stadiums for the season).
 - Keep notes to assist you at the re-grading meeting
 - Endeavour to watch all grading games, but ensure you see every team two or three times at least
 - Ensure you watch every "critical" game, i.e. first v second, bottom v second bottom
 - $\circ~$ Be alert to any coaches hiding players or generally attempting to play below their standard
- Attend the re-grading meeting convened by your age coordinator
 - Be prepared to nominate the teams you feel should move up or down
 - You must endeavour to create an even competition in all grade levels where all teams are at least competitive
- Liaise with the age coordinator and fellow grade secretaries if you have any doubts on whether a team should be re-graded
- Attend the re-grading meeting for clubs
 - At this meeting you may be asked by a club representative to explain a re-grading decision.
- Determine the initial grading for teams for next season
 - Clubs submit their teams after round 16
 - Age coordinators will convene a meeting to determine the initial grading for the new season
- Predict the grand final winners
 - This is a semi-serious exercise. Immediately after the preliminary, submit one or two lines predicting the grand final winner for each of your grades. These are printed in the grand final booklet.



Dear Members

The beginning of this season saw an unparalleled amount of issues surface, primarily due to player requests. The behaviour of some parents was completely unacceptable and will not be tolerated.

The Committee wish to clarify that player requests are just that – a request. When forming teams the Committee and in particular the Boys and Girls Coordinators take each request on its merits but only after establishing balance of skill types and abilities within each team, to ensure that we field competitive teams where player groups are provided the challenges needed to grow in their basketball development. Player requests are not a given instruction and should not be assumed as such. In order to ensure any requests in the future are captured, considered and genuine in nature the Player Request Form shall only be available by request from an Executive Committee Member of the club.

It has always been the intent of the player requests to be used for particular circumstances of which the club should be aware, not as a general request to play with existing friends. Naturally forming teams based on friendships is not readily possible due to differing skill levels or team balance, in fact to do so has the realistic potential of weakening teams and disadvantaging other players within the club. In looking at the past seasons requests, we received so many that forming teams would not have been possible.

Player requests are carefully looked at and considered, as we do each and every season and we always endeavour to place players in teams according to our Player Selection Policy. It must be noted that our Player Selection Policy is an ongoing Work-in-Progress and is regularly refined following learning's identified at the end of each season.

It is unacceptable that Coaches or members of the Committee be pressured, threatened or spoken to in an unacceptable manner. Please note that from today onward acts of this nature will be fully investigated by the Club Executive with real potential for disciplinary action (including expulsion from the club) where a member is found guilty of such. The Club is taking a Zero Tolerance approach to this type of inappropriate behaviour.

If parents have a valid complaint to make once teams are released, the correct course of action is by correspondence to the President AND Secretary either by mail or email. Due to the issues incurred this season the Boys and Girls Co-ordinators will no longer take calls from parents.
