

## Basketball WA Affiliation

Affiliation with Basketball WA has the following benefits:

- 1) Membership of a Professional Body to administer basketball in Western Australia.
- 2) Through Basketball WA, affiliated Associations and Registered members are linked to Basketball Australia and FIBA. Any international decisions and rule changes come through these bodies.
- 3) Access to Basketball WA Policy on Health and Member Protection as well as National Tribunal Guidelines.
- 4) Basketball WA is recognized by the WA State Government as the peak State Sporting Body for Basketball. Various Department of Sport and Recreation grants, seminars and courses are only available to Basketball WA and their affiliated Associations.
- 5) Only Affiliated Associations and BWA Registered members are eligible to participate in competitions conducted under the auspice of Basketball WA. These include:
  - i) State Basketball League
  - ii) Western Australian Basketball League
  - iii) Basketball WA Summer Classic
  - iv) Basketball WA Country Championships.
- 6) Basketball WA provides funding through the State Development Network to your Region to develop the sport. Under this program, Development Officers attend local primary schools and promote your Association to prospective young players.
- 7) Registered members of affiliated Associations are able to represent Western Australia at
  - i) Basketball Australia National Championships
  - ii) Basketball Australia Junior Club Championships
  - iii) Australian Junior Basketball Country Cup.
- 8) Registered Members are able to participate in Basketball WA Regional Academy programs, including
  - i) National Intensive Training Programs for U16 and U18 age groups
  - ii) Local Regional Basketball Academies
  - iii) Basketball WA Regional Academy Camp
  - iv) Under 12 Shooting Stars program and State-wide Jamboree
  - v) Under 14 Hot Shots program
  - vi) Country Cup, Pacific Slam and other specialised programs
- 9) Registered members of Affiliated Associations are eligible to become accredited with Basketball Australia and the Australian Sports Commission as Nationally Accredited Coaches, Referees and Score Table Officials.
- 10) Members and Affiliated Associations have access to Basketball WA's Education and Training resources and courses for Coaching, Officiating and Score Table at substantially discounted rates.

- 11) Affiliated Associations are able to obtain Green Shirts for non-accredited Referees and Black & White Shirts for accredited Referees at significant discounts to normal costs.
- 12) Members are able to obtain access to Basketball WA's DVD library
- 13) Affiliated Associations are able to have access to the Aussie Hoops website, Aussie Hoops merchandise and Aussie Hoops brand to develop their junior entry Level programs.
- 14) Affiliated Associations have free access to Sporting Pulse technology including Free FIBA Organizer software for competition and database management as well as results management.
- 15) Affiliated Associations also have access to a free Sporting Pulse website for communication within your Association and promotion of your Association to the general public.
- 16) Affiliated Associations are able to obtain advice regarding Business Development and Sponsorship arrangements through Basketball WA's Association Development Officer
- 17) Affiliated Associations are able to obtain access to the 5 on 5 Online self-Appraisal program.

18) Insurance Cover

Insurance cover is provided as follows:

- a) Public Liability \$20,000,000 per event
- b) Products Liability \$20,000,000 per event
- c) Property Insurance \$100,000
- d) Professional Indemnity \$5,000,000
- e) Personal Accident \$100,000 including provision for the following:
  - i) Death and Disability
  - ii) Loss of Income
  - iii) Student Assistance benefits
  - iv) Home help
  - v) Non-Medicare medical expenses
  - vi) Parents inconvenience allowance
  - vii) Funeral expenses
  - viii) Home/Motor vehicle modification expenses
  - ix) In-memorial expenses
  - x) Dependant children's allowance
  - xi) Home nursing care
  - xii) Ancillary non-medical expenses
