


- Queries, protests, horse abuse as per PCAV handbook of by-laws.
- Dogs are prohibited without exception.

Horse Event Declaration Waiver

I understand that due to disease such as equine influenza. The Victorian Department of Primary Industries. Or other State or Commonwealth government body, may restrict or prevent movement of horses, vehicles and personnel for a period of time ('Standstill'). I acknowledge and agree that a Standstill is a risk of competing at the event and I agree to pay all costs or expenses as a result of a Standstill.

Refund policy
