FJI IN CALIFORNIA

In Fresno, California at a meet on 16/17 May, Jone Delai lowered his Fiji NR and SPB from 10.30 to 10.27. No wind reading was given, but it is assumed that it is legal.

At the same meet Soloveni Nakaunicina ran a sensational 45.98 for the 400m to get within reach of Saimoni Tamani's wonderful record of 45.82 which has stood since the 1970 Commonwealth Games in Edinburgh.

The above athletes, plus Aminiasi Babitu are at West Valley College in California. We look forward to getting results for Aminiasi in the near future.

Jone has achieved yet another World Championship qualifier (A Qual) and Soloveni has his first with a B Qualifying performance.

With Jovesa Naivalu already having two qualifying performances, that brings the number of Fiji athletes, who are now Athens bound, to three.

Other Pacific Island athletes studying in California are Brent Butler from Guam and Tonga's Paea Kokohu.
