Club Policy

The club has a strong belief that success will be determined from the development of local youth, providing young men with the opportunity to create lifelong friendships in a safe and healthy environment. Development includes on field skills, acceptance of responsibility, leadership, and this is enhanced with education, respect, and loyalty, to the club and one another.

In pursuit of success, the Maroochydore A.F.C. applies the following policy:

1. Eligible Players are to be considered for selection to the First and Reserves teams based on attitude, ability and performance, both on and off the field.
2. During finals, selection for all teams will be based on ability and performance, with an exception for outstanding financial obligations or disciplinary reasons.
3. Players eligible for Under 18 selection are to train and play with their peers unless personally invited to join Senior teams by the Under 18 Coach or Senior Coach.
4. In the case of Under 18 and junior eligible players, selection to First and Reserves teams by the selection committee is on the proviso both the player and their parent/guardian approves.
5. Where numbers permit, a third senior team may be entered, whereby every individual will be encouraged to play and enjoy AFL during the home and away season
6. All players not playing in any week through injury or selection will be expected to assist in game day activities.
7. All players and officials are expected to abide by the club code of conduct and rules and regulations
8. All players are expected to willingly support and participate in club functions and development programs
9. No player will be cleared whilst any financial obligations to the club remain outstanding against their name
10. Committee decisions must prioritise development of the club and player and promote a safe and healthy environment to participate in AFL
