

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. Play by the rules.
- 2. Never argue with a referee or assistant referee. If you disagree, have your captain, coach or manager approach the official on your behalf.
- 3. Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable or permitted behaviours in soccer.
- 4. Work equally hard for yourself and your team. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you.
- 5. Be a good sport; recognise all good plays whether they are part of your team or the opposition.
- 6. Treat all participants in soccer as you like to be treated. Do not bully or take unfair advantage of other competitors.
- 7. Cooperate with your coach, team-mates and opponents. Without them there would be no game.
- 8. Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please parents and coaches.
- 9. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
