Drug education and awareness the focus

AS news of the recent ACC Report and ASADA follow up continues to prevail throughout the media, it's timely to highlight AFL Victoria's position.

First and foremost illicit and performance-enhancing substances will not be tolerated in our game. Breaches of the AFL's Anti-Doping Code rightly results in heavy sanctions.

Education and awareness are two unwavering tenets that must prevail in understanding the game's Anti-Doping policy.

AFL Victoria works with all VFL Clubs to help educate players and officials regarding the requirements of the Anti-Doping Code with annual pre-season education sessions, which all players are required to attend and then acknowledge their understanding. VFL Clubs support the importance of these sessions and many provide additional follow up in various forms throughout the season.

The education sessions are very similar to those presented at AFL Club level and have been delivered at VFL Clubs for as long as the AFL Anti-Doping Code has existed.

No VFL player is permitted to play in the VFL or the Development League until they have completed and signed off on the education session.

All players have a clear responsibility to check and know what they are purchasing or taking and whether it contravenes the specific Anti-Doping rules that apply.

The fact that prohibited substances can be contained within commercially available supplements should serve as a warning to players who choose to purchase and consume these products.

The assumption that because a substance can be purchased off the shelf therefore makes it 'legal' is erroneous. Products/supplements purchased on-line may also contravene the Code or, in fact, be illegal.

AFL Victoria fully supports the work of the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) and liaises with ASADA each year to ensure we comply with their requirements and

that our education strategies are appropriate.

ASADA doesn't detail its testing regime, for the integrity of its testing program, and nor does AFL Victoria ever expect to know the intricate operation details of the testing program.

Every registered player, including those within community level in country and metropolitan Leagues, can be tested by ASADA. It flows from Clause 21 of the Laws of Australian Football, which links the AFL's Anti-Doping Code to every competition in the country.

The level and frequency of testing at community level is also determined by and at the discretion of ASADA.

Also, players should understand that match day testing is not the only way ASADA can identify players who have breached the Anti-Doping Code. Government agencies have the ability to notify ASADA about the purchase of what it considers "suspicious" products. In this respect, you do not have to be tested to breach the Code.

If players have any doubt whatsoever they should not order, purchase or consume a supplement without first seeking medical or professional advice on whether it contains a banned performance-enhancing substance. ASADA also has a hotline service that can also provide important and relevant advice or visit www.asada.gov.au

AFL Victoria are in regular contact with the AFL and other state football bodies to discuss more broadly how we can collectively develop additional education programs so all players understand their obligations and responsibilities under the AFL Anti-Doping Code.

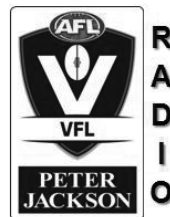

Captain Searl

ONE of the pillars of North Ballarat's sustained success has been its leadership on and off the field.

Certainly, coach Gerard FitzGerald has been a beacon in this regard, but so, too, Shaune Moloney and Marc Greig, who between them captained the club for the past seven years.

Now, the baton has been handed to Michael Searl whose contribution to the club can't be underestimated during a distinguished career.

While he had been a premiership player and a member of the club's leadership group for several years, Searl said he certainly didn't expect to have the captaincy presented to him.

He noted the club was lucky to have quality leaders in Myles Sewell and Stephen Clifton, who are both Liston Trophy winners.

"It's a great honour," Searl said.

"Playing under 'Spider' (Shaune Moloney) and 'Greigy' (Marc Greig) you feel like you have massive shoes to fill.

"I'm trying to be the leader I am, but they were phenomenal leaders."

Searl said he's fortunate that Moloney and Greig are still involved at the club so he can not only seek counsel, but also bounce ideas off them.

He added he was in the advantageous position to be surrounded by quality people in the leadership group.

"We have lots of guys who pull their weight. It is not just me that does all the work," Searl said.

While North Ballarat is 1-2, Searl said he doesn't believe the club is far off the pace and is eager to atone for the disappointment of missing the finals for the first time in six years.

He noted the club had more possessions than Collingwood in the season opener loss and, apart from an eight to two goal second quarter disaster, matched it with the unbeaten Casey Scorpions.

North Ballarat posted its first win with a resounding win against Bendigo Gold, a victory that Searl said gave the players the confidence they needed.

"Hopefully, that win will kick start us into gear," Searl said.

Searl is mindful that the Roosters don't want to fall off the pace early in the season as they did last year and then had to spend the rest of the season playing catch-up.

"Our start to last year was poor. I think we were 3-7 and although we got some momentum in the second half, we had lapses where we would leak goals," he said.

"Each week is a new challenge. You can't look at the results from the previous week and say 'they beat them and them so we should be a chance'.

"Each week you just have to match up as best you can, focus on that and have more blokes win their position than the opposition to get the result in your favour."

State Game - Peter Jackson

VFL Perspective

THE Peter Jackson VFL squad for next month's state game versus the West Australian Football League (WAFL) will be vastly different from the one that thrashed Tasmania last year.

Included in the VFL's team that posted a 108-point win was Sam Dwyer, Brett Goodes, Leigh Osborne, Kyle Martin, Kyle Hartigan and Dean Towers, who were all selected by AFL clubs at the various Drafts.

Liston trophy winner Shane Valenti, who has missed the opening three rounds with injury, won't be considered.

And, with the State match falling a fortnight earlier this year it doesn't give coach Gary Ayres and his assistant coaches and selectors – Gerard FitzGerald, Simon

Goosey, AFL Victoria State League Manager John Hook, AFL Victoria VFL Academy coach Darren Flanigan, Peter Weightman and Bruce Davis – much leeway.

Ayres said coaches and selectors had two preliminary meetings to gauge a feel for the composition of the VFL squad.

He said he hoped the squad would begin to take greater shape following this weekend's round.

The VFL squad will have an introduction night/medical check on May 6, train on May 7 & 9 and then fly to Perth on May 10.

With such a short lead in, Ayres said selectors look at last year's VFL Team Of The Year, see who is still available, who is playing well, but primarily who has played well in the opening weeks of the season.

"I think the past few years would say we got it pretty right," Ayres said.

"Injuries are always going to occur so you just have to do what you can and hopefully the players that come in will be able to grab that opportunity."

Ayres said selectors had faith in the ability of players who had previously represented the VFL and had proven over the journey to be quality VFL players.

He said the over-riding factor is being available, fit and healthy, playing well at the time and having the right structures and formations.

"But, I'm sure any player who was asked if he was to be selected for his State would be ready to go, I'm sure the answer would be yes," Ayres said.

"Hopefully, there are some good young kids pushing through. Out of last year's game we had Dean Towers, Sam Dwyer, Kyle Martin, Kyle Hartigan, Brett Goodes, Leigh Osborne that were all drafted at the end of the year.

"We'd love to be able to grow and nurture players like that this year. We've seen how a guy like Sam Dwyer has been able to walk straight in and have an impact."

Destiny awaits those who choose it.

State Game – WA Perspective

PLENTY of familiar faces, both from the AFL and VFL, are in the WAFL's initial squad for next month's State match against the VFL.

Former Sandringham rover Marc Webb, a former WA State player, takes over the coaching of the Sandgropers, which host the VFL in Northam on May 11.

Assisting Webb is current East Perth and former State Coach Brian Dawson, former State 18s coach, Dockers and Claremont player Brad Wira, and ex-East Perth and Carlton player Adam Pickering. Claremont Assistant Wayne Orsi is the Chairman of Selectors.

The VFL has defeated WA in its past three State matches, stretching back to 2004, including two in Western Australia.

When the States last met in 2010, the VFL, captained by Brett Johnson and with current Essendon VFL Operations Manager Matthew Little winning the Frank Johnson Medal, defeated WA by 61-points at Leederville Oval.

Included in the WA squad of 33, which had its first training session last Monday, is former North Ballarat premiership player Josh Smith.

Smith, a former North Melbourne player, who won the 2008 Norm Goss Medal awarded to the best player on the ground in the VFL Grand Final, is no stranger to State games.

He was awarded the 2011 Simpson Medal for best on ground in a State match.

Smith played in all three of North Ballarat's premierships and coach Gerard FitzGerald noted he was as influential a player as big Orren Stephenson.

Paul Johnson, co-winner with Ian Callinan of the 2005 JJ Liston Trophy when he was playing with Melbourne's then affiliate Sandringham, is also in the squad.

Johnson, who also played with the Box Hill Hawks, is also a winner of the Simpson Medal.

Former Werribee defender Sean Tighe, who last played for the VFL Tigers in 2011, is another player well known to VFL fans.

And, then there is the expansive list of players who recently spent time on an AFL list: Paul Bower (Carlton), Steven Dodd (Fremantle), Jay Van Berlo (Fremantle), Garry Moss (Hawthorn), Ryan Neates (West Coast Eagles), Mark Seaby (West Coast Eagles/Sydney), Andrew Strijk (West Coast Eagles) and Paul Bevan (Sydney).

Gordon ready to cement senior spot

FOOTBALL can be as unforgiving as it is rewarding. Certainly, there are no givens as Tom Gordon has discovered in his short career.

After spending the 2011 season on the Collingwood rookie list, Gordon chose the Box Hill Hawks as the club to continue his career at, impressed by their history of having players drafted or re-drafted.

Gordon played just the solitary game for the VFL Hawks last season, spending the year in the Development League.

It was character-building at best, soul destroying at worst. Many could have walked out disillusioned, but Gordon decided he would direct all his energy into the pre-season.

Gordon said he wanted to control what he could control, and be positive so he could present an impression that would leave an indelible mark on coach Damian Carroll and the coaching staff.

Gordon recalled that it took him the best part of the first half of the season to get a handle on the coaches, game plan as well as his new teammates

"It was a bit hard when you are thinking 'I've been on a (AFL) list and here I am playing in the twos every single week'," Gordon said.

What drove Gordon to remain at the Box Hill Hawks was the hunger that he still wanted to play AFL and the best pathway was to stay in the Peter Jackson VFL.

"I'd got to experience the day to day life of doing a full time job of what you love and that was playing football," he said.

"That dream of a kid growing up wanting to play AFL, I wasn't going to let slip by just because I played a year in the twos.

"I put a pretty big effort in the pre-season, I thought it was my best and I thought I played well up forward in the practice matches and then to get picked in the twos, I was annoyed.

"But, when I thought about it, I said to myself 'I'm not going to let it slip now after putting in all that hard work'."

Carroll remembered Gordon playing for Oakleigh Chargers from his days as Gippsland Power coach. He knew the talent he possessed.

The Box Hill Hawks coach noted how hard Gordon worked pre-season and the results were evident in the practices matches.

"He'd been known more as a defender and we thought going forward it might be an opportunity for him to be a forward," Carroll said.

After a standout game for Box Hill Hawks' development team, Gordon won a call-up and seized the opportunity by kicking four goals in the club's win against Essendon.

It was a satisfying experience, but both Gordon and Carroll know that one good game doesn't carry an entry card to the team for the rest of the season.

Much more hard work is required, but Tom Gordon understands the situation.

AFL Victoria VFL Academy

WHEN Darren Flanigan sat down in February to identify the AFL Victoria VFL Academy he found himself staring at a list of 80 names.

As impressive as the depth of the list was, the problem for the new AFL Victoria Academy coach was that he had room for 60 less players.

The origins of the 80 came from nominations from Peter Jackson VFL clubs and coaches, TAC Cup Talent managers and coaches as well as Anton Grbac and Leon Harris, the AFL Victoria High Performance Managers.

On top of that came input from AFL recruiters who mentioned players who they considered unlucky not to have been selected in one of the AFL Drafts.

Methodically, the list was whittled down to about 35 who were then invited in to do fitness testing and their form was monitored over the pre-season.

"Some went really well, others struggled and that's how we ended up with 18," Flanigan said.

"We're allowed to have a couple more and a couple of kids have missed a fair bit of pre-season footy with injury and some others are starting to run into a bit of form.

"So, I have saved a couple of spots for anyone who bobs up in the next month or so."

Flanigan said the key criteria for a spot in the AFL Victoria VFL Academy are that a player must have "AFL Draft potential".

He noted the weight of an AFL recruiter carries significance and therefore if four or five recruiters think a player has potential to be drafted within the next 12-24 months there is "an obligation to continue to develop them".

Last Tuesday was the first time the Academy met collectively with Flanigan who ran through how the season's program would unfold.

Initially, players are taken through work load management, injury prevention, work/social life balance, nutritional discussion as well as psychologist advice.

The Academy will meet as a group about six times during the season where they will have training sessions with specific themes.

Already tall players had a session with Josh Fraser and Brendon Lade and then went to the MCG to watch the Geelong/Hawthorn match and filled out a work sheet.

"It's just trying to add value to what they're doing at the VFL level," Flanigan said.

Flanigan said an individual program is then tailored for each player in consultation with his VFL coach so they can work on areas of their game that are deficient.

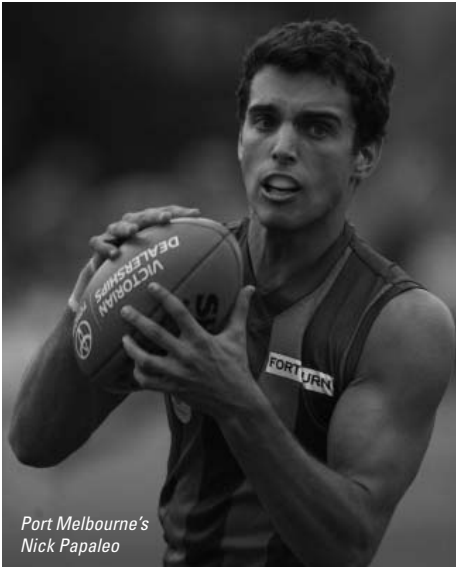
He said assistance in given on a raft of areas whether it is a dietician providing a specific eating plan that will help them put on weight.

"Kicking seems to be a common area that needs work. We have some AFL assistant coaches or kicking coaches that will come along to a training session to give the players some pointers," Flanigan said.

"There is a range of things that can hopefully improve their draftability."

Flanigan said recent history reveals that VFL players can make a fairly seamless transition to the AFL.

He said one of his roles was to provide the AFL recruiters with as much information as possible, plus ensuring the players remain on track by presenting and fitness testing well.

“At the end of the year we want to be in a position where we can hand the AFL recruiters a dossier and say ‘this is what the young fellow has done’,” Flanigan said.

“The recruiters would have seen them play, but I will let them know what they are doing off the field and hopefully that will be enough to get them on a list.”

Flanigan said it is not necessarily critical for AFL Victoria VFL Academy players to play each and every game in the seniors.

He said the standard of the VFL Development League continues to soar with a strong, competitive standard.

Jack Frost, who played 12 games in the VFL Development League last season, provided a classic example as he was

selected by Collingwood in the AFL Rookie Draft.

“As long as the kids are showing continual improvement and are more draftable than they exited the TAC Cup, that’s what recruiters take into account,” Flanigan said.

The Academy also includes players who didn’t come through the TAC Cup program like Jake Wilson, who this season is on the Werribee list.

Flanigan said Wilson created a favourable impression playing for Portland and had carried that through to the VFL Tigers in the early stages of the VFL season.

“He’s a 195 cm defender with really good closing speed,” Flanigan said.

Flanigan, who spent a decade as the Dandenong Stingrays Regional Manager, said his experience in the TAC Cup taught him that some players are ready to be drafted at 18 while others are not ready until they are 21.

He said the latter players were afforded a great opportunity to realize their football dreams by utilizing the pathway the VFL offers.

“Michael Hibberd who played at the Stingrays when I was there was pretty close to being drafted, but once he had a good season of VFL footy with Frankston he was picked up,” Flanigan said.

“There’s examples of that all the time when the window is not open for those kids at TAC Cup level, but if they stay keen and do the right things and keep working on it they can get picked up through the VFL.”

Thomas ready to fire

FOUR years at a club doesn't put you in the veteran category, but it does in this era of the Northern Blues and as such Tyson Thomas is an elder statesman.

He's seen a sea of faces come through the Cramer Street Oval, many who are no longer there.

He's seen the club's fortunes fluctuate like the Dow Jones Index, but he can foresee more of the dizzy heights than the basement views with this latest group.

Apart from reigning premiers Geelong, no team owns a better win/loss record since midway through last season.

After a 1-10 start to 2012, which also saw them lose a coach, the VFL Blues ended the season with a 5-2 run and have started this season with an unbeaten run.

Thomas noted he's never seen the club play better team-orientated football, in stark contrast to last year, which he viewed as a "bit of a rabble".

He said the leadership group discussed the predicament and it was agreed players needed to train and stick together more.

"We all really want to drive for finals and hopefully win a premiership, that's our ultimate goal. We have a good group of boys down here that we want to achieve that with," Thomas said.

"We made a commitment to each other that we would stick together because we lost a fair few talented players the year before. We thought if we can keep this group together for a few years that we can seriously win a flag together."

And, that's with the knowledge that in an alignment the AFL Listed players can easily bump out of the team a VFL player who may be in form. As many as 18 Carlton players were in the team against Bendigo Gold in Round 2.

"I think it is a challenge every week for the boys," Thomas said.

"It can be tough and frustrating for some of the boys to have to step aside. I've been in that situation a few times and it's not the best feeling.

"Everyone seems to bounce back. The Carlton boys embrace us and what we're about down at the club."

Thomas said new coach Luke Webster has brought with him a steely determination to succeed.

"He was the main driver of the team first, at all cost attitude that has helped us get to where we want to be," Thomas said.

"I could not speak highly enough about him."

Thomas, who kicked 11 goals in the first two games – nearly as many as he kicked the entire last year, said he's fitter than before and understands the competition better.

"We made a big emphasis pre-season of trying to play as a team.

"Whatever Carlton players we have on the weekend we drill that into them and make sure that's the main requirement.

"We all want to be on the same page."

Tigers secure Moore than a player

WHEN the curtain dropped on his time at the Sydney Swan and there wasn't another AFL suitor, Jarred Moore needed to take stock.

Moore knew several things: he loved playing the game and he wanted to make it a career beyond his playing days.

He's been able to secure both desires virtually without missing a beat.

First and foremost, Moore landed a position as a development coach at North Melbourne and as an extension he's able to play with the Kangaroos' aligned club Werribee.

It fits the buzz phrase – a win/win situation.

"When I finished up at Sydney, aged 26, I still love footy and wanted to keep playing, but I also wanted to look at what I was going to do after footy and I really felt like I wanted to get into coaching," Moore explained.

"The perfect fit for me was to do both. I was lucky enough to get a role at North Melbourne to be able to link the two."

Moore said the experience of working with Brad Scott, Darren Crocker, John Lamont and Brett Allison had been rewarding.

He said to be able to impart some of that knowledge when he went to Werribee had proved "very beneficial".

Along with Werribee captain Robbie Castello, Moore works as the VFL Tigers midfield coach.

"It's a pretty good situation as we have a lot of North Melbourne guys come through the mid-field," Moore said.

"It's a pretty good fit for us with two playing midfield coaches."

Moore played 68 games with the Swans and savored the jubilation that accompanied the 2005 and 2012 premierships even though he didn't play. It was something he will always remember.

Given he was drafted from the Dandenong Stingrays, Moore, unlike many players on an AFL club, has not experienced playing in the VFL.

"It does change from week to week and you don't know what the games are going to be like or the line-ups or what you are going to face," Moore explained.

"But, that makes it pretty easy in that you know you have to play well, bring your 'A' game each week."

While adapting to the Peter Jackson VFL or more particularly the volatility of team line-ups and consequently results on a weekly basis, Moore hasn't lost his passion for the game.

"I always love playing footy so nothing has changed," Moore said.

"As long as my body holds up, I'll be playing for a couple more years yet."

Round 3 review

We look at how the games unfolded in Round 3 of the Peter Jackson VFL:

NORTH BALLARAT d BENDIGO: North Ballarat recorded their first win of the season with an 85-point win over regional rivals Bendigo. The final margin was not a true reflection of the game up until three quarter time, with the Roosters only in front by 20 points at the final change. But injuries to the Gold, and a 12-goal to one final term saw the Roosters race to their first win of 2013. The visitors shared the goals around with Aaron Black kicking five, Jason Linke four and Marcus Darmody three. Steve Stroobants was the only multiple goal kickers for the Gold with two. Ben Jacobs was best for the Roosters with 41 possessions – 23 contested - followed by Myles Swell and Black.

GEELONG d BOX HILL HAWKS: In a typical battle of when the Cats and Hawks clash, Geelong ran over the Box Hill Hawks in the final term to claim a five-point victory. In a game that never saw the margin surpass 17 points, the Cats kicked the first three goals of the final term to turn an eight-point three quarter time deficit into an 11-point lead. Late goals to Luke Lowden and Brian Lake once again got the margin within five points, but that was where it stayed when the final siren sounded. The major talking point after the game was another knee injury to returning Cats AFL listed player Daniel Menzel.

CASEY SCORPIONS d ESSENDON: Casey claimed their third win on the trot with a seven goal to three second term helping set up the Scorpions 82-point win. In the battle of the young up and comers, Essendon's Joe Daniher and Casey's Jesse Hogan both finished with four goals, but the Bombers had no answers for the forward pressure of the Scorpions boasting eight multiple goal kickers. Jordie McKenzie and James Magner led the possessions for Casey with 31 each, with David Rodan (24 and three goals), Michael Riseley and Jake Spencer amongst their best. For Essendon, former Gippsland Power player Anthony Tipungwuti impressed as the 23rd players, as did Ariel Steinberg and Will Hams.

FRANKSTON d COLLINGWOOD: Frankston found themselves sitting in the Peter Jackson VFL top eight at the end of Round 3 after they recorded their first back to back victories since Rd 16/17 2008. Led by returning Dolphins recruit Michael Lourey with eight goals up forward, the Dolphins grabbed the early lead and held onto it, despite

a fast finish by Collingwood which got them within 13 points with the breeze in the final term. The Dolphins have been able to kick two winning scores without key forward Khan Haretuku who remains on the sidelines, with Dave Gallagher and Lachlan Delahunty once again amongst their best. Andrew Krauker led the possessions with 36 for the Magpies, with Ben Kennedy (30) and Adam Oxley their best.

WILLIAMSTOWN d WERRIBEE TIGERS: Williamstown have made it 10 in a row over arch rivals the Werribee Tigers after waltzing to an 83-point victory. The Seagulls were ruthless in front of their home fans, slamming home six unanswered goals in the first term and continuing the carnage with a 10-goal second half. Patrick Veszpremi was easily best on ground with 37 touches and three goals, while captain Ben Jolley, Stephen McCallum and Fletcher Roberts also finished with three of their own. On a dark day for the Tigers, Ben Brown shone with the ruckman-come-forward takings several strong marks and booting two-goals.

SANDRINGHAM dw PORT MELBOURNE: Sandringham and Port Melbourne played out a thrilling draw at Frankston Oval. Two late goals, the last to Ryan Gale, drew the Borough level with the Zebras and that's the way things stayed with the final siren leaving both sides locked on 16.12.108. Two last quarter goals to St Kilda draftee Spencer White (three in total) looked to have given the Zebras the edge but the Borough wouldn't be denied. Christopher Cain bagged six goals for the Borough, whilst Chris Michaliades slotted three for the Zebras.

NORTHERN BLUES d COBURG: The Northern Blues emerged victorious after a see-sawing encounter with Coburg. In a game in which both sides enjoyed periods in control – with Coburg in front by a point 10 minutes into the final term - the Blues finished the stronger to post a 26 point win. Blues midfielder David Ellard was best afield with 23 disposals and 4 goals while Levi Casboubt and Luke Mitchell kicked 3 each. Kane Lambert (25 possessions and 2 goals) and Adam Marcon (24 and 1) were other stars in a team that looks capable of posing a serious threat come finals time. Aaron Edwards was Coburg's best with seven goals, while Orren Stephenson and Brad Helbig were both prominent.

Around The Grounds

Where's Frankston?

That could very well be the questions asked by the playing group at Geelong this weekend as they make their first trip to Frankston Oval since Round 13, 2007. This weekend's clash is a top eight battle, with Geelong sitting in third and the Dolphins sitting in sixth spot.

Quiet leading goal kickers

It was quiet last week at the top of the goal kicking ladder with only four of the seven top 10 goal kickers taking to the field kicking any goals. Melbourne's mini draft selection Jesse Hogan continues to impress for the Casey Scorpions with another bag of four goals, leading those in the top 10 last weekend and jumping into fourth spot. Simon Deery leads the way with 13 goals after a four goals haul versus Werribee, but he is closely followed by Williamstown teammate Ben Casley and Northern Blues' Myles Dorman who also kicked four. Port Melbourne's Jake Hammond kicked five to move him into the top four last weekend.

Win the hitouts but not the game

The Box Hill Hawks dominated the hitout count 75 to 17 last weekend against Geelong, but it did not equate to a win on the scoreboard. With Luke Lowden (41 hitouts), Jonathon Ceglar (26) and Sam Grimley (8) having a field day in the middle against new Cats VFL ruckman Sandy

Robinson (17 hitouts), the Cats at one stage resorted to using Jackson Hollmer at 186cm in the ruck. Geelong were suffering a ruck crisis of sorts with talls such as Mitch Brown and Matt Sully needed in defence all afternoon, and Nathan Vardy, Dawson Simpson, Josh Walker, Ryan Bathie and Andrew Banjanin on the sidelines.

Western dominance

Williamstown notched up win number 10 in a row against western rivals Werribee last Sunday at Burbank Oval. The last time the Tigers were able to defeat the Seagulls was in Round 20, 2008. With only one game scheduled this year between the two teams, the only chance of the sides meeting again before the 2014 season is meeting in the 'Powered by Milk' VFL finals. As our season predictions from a number of media reporters out west alluded to earlier in the month, they would be more than happy for an all-western grand final in 2013.

Former teammates meet again

While venturing to Queen Elizabeth Oval will be a long drive for Collingwood's Luke Ball as he returns from injury in the VFL, he will see a familiar face after he completes his drive up the Calder. Coaching against his Magpies will be Ball's former St Kilda teammate Aussie Jones, as Bendigo Gold host Collingwood in their final night game at QEO till Round 19 against Geelong.

Drawn game

The Peter Jackson VFL saw its first senior draw for season 2013. Ironically the venue for last year's only drawn game, the Round 12 clash between Frankston and Williamstown, was once again the venue for Port Melbourne and Sandringham's thrilling 108-point all draw. It was the first time ever that the Borough and the Zebras have experienced a drawn match in their 156 game history, with Port enduring 47 draws in their 2,364 game history, and Sandringham experiencing just 8 draws in 1,563 matches.

DALE WEIGHTMAN: In his playing journey he had nine coaches in sixteen years at the top level. His Under 19 coach was Don Davenport who was a great teacher of the game's fundamentals, while Barry Richardson introduced him to strategy, and Tony Jewell was hard and tough, and very direct with his feedback on your performance.
