

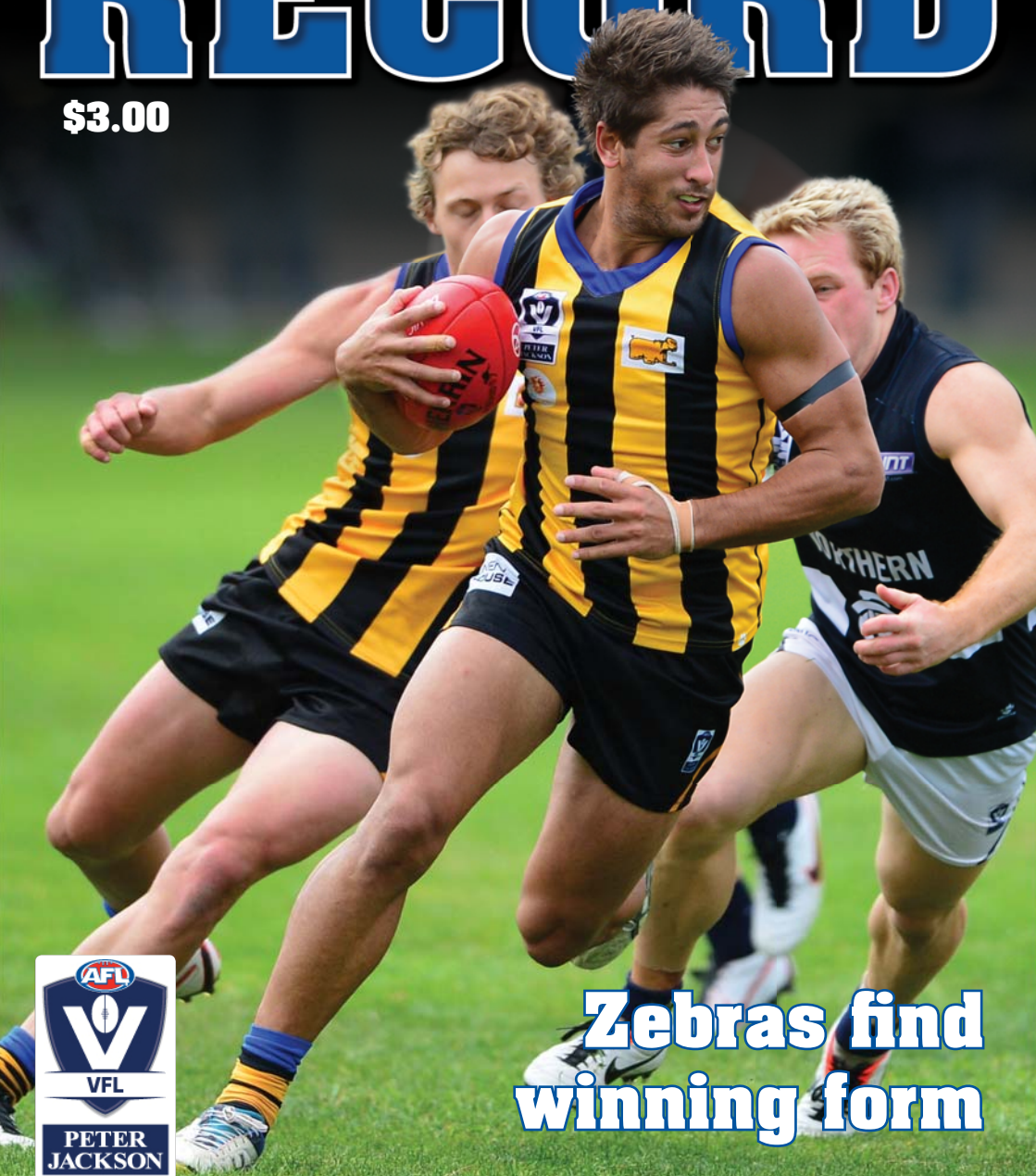

CONGRATULATIONS to the West Australian Football League for its victory against the Peter Jackson VFL last Saturday at Northam.

The host State emerged from a typically hard fought State match with a 17-point win after grabbing the lead midway through the last quarter.

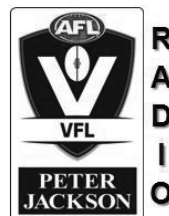

VFL gallant in defeat to WAFL

WHEN Frankston's Sam Lloyd snapped his second goal of the quarter and fourth for the match midway through the third term, the Peter Jackson VFL appeared set to register its fourth successive win against Western Australia.

Lloyd's goal extended the VFL's lead to 31-points, but momentum is a strange phenomena, especially in football.

Within eight minutes, the VFL's lead had shrunk to a solitary goal as the WAFL kicked four successive goals to make its intentions extremely clear.

While Port Melbourne's Josh Scipione extended the VFL's lead with his third goal just before three-quarter time, several missed chances late in the term would prove telling.

After WA kicked the opening goal of the match, the VFL dominated the opening quarter with Scipione and Michael Lourey each kicking two goals as they capitalized on the hard work of a rebounding Marcus Marigliani from a back flank, industrious captain Dom Gleeson and the polished Chris Cain.

WA responded with the first three goals of the second quarter, which included the first signs that Wayde Twomey, a former Carlton listed player and regular for the Northern Blues, would prove a headache.

But, the VFL was more than up for the challenge. Lloyd, Chris Michaliades, Kane Lambert and Ben Warren answered with four successive goals to allow the VFL to gain a 25-point break.

Twomey added two more goals to swing the pendulum again, but when Casey Scorpions skipper Evan Panozza and Lloyd kicked goals, the VFL went to the half-time break with a 25-point lead.

Marigliani, Cain, Gleeson, Liston Trophy winner Myles Sewell, Lambert and Scipione were all playing well.

That man Twomey again imposed himself on the game with a goal from a mark before the third quarter was one minute old.

While Lloyd's two third quarter goals were able to blow out the VFL's lead, the signs late in the third quarter suggested that WA was storming home.

And, storm they did. The host State set the agenda and controlled much of the game although the VFL's defence, led by Panozza, was resolute.

At the six minute mark, successive WA goals leveled the scores and for the next 10-minutes there was an old fashioned arm wrestle as both teams gave their all.

Scipione kicked a behind to give the VFL a one-point lead, but when Twomey kicked his fifth for the match, WA hit the front for the first time since the opening moments of the match.

As desperately as they tried, the VFL wasn't able to generate the run and carry and ability to break the lines like they had earlier in the match.

Two late goals by WA, which held the VFL to just two behinds in the last quarter, sealed the match and inflicted the VFL's first defeat against WA this century.

VFL STATE MATCH - Coaching perspective

MORE clinical, more efficient, more effective.

That's how VFL coach Gary Ayres viewed the 17-point victory by the WAFL, which overhauled the VFL's 14-point three-quarter time lead to claim victory.

Ayres said he was proud of how all the players went about their task, but noted full credit went to the victors who kicked 5.3 to 0.2 in the final term.

He praised his Port Melbourne premiership player Chris Cain, who was awarded the Frank Johnson Medal for the best VFL player in a State match.

"Chris has really elevated himself to another level and it was terrific for him to do it on a stage like this," Ayres said.

"Kane Lambert had a good game, so, too, Evan Panozza and Marcus Marigiani and Sam Lloyd had a good game with four goals.

"There was some very good players for us. It is just unfortunate that we didn't have a high enough contribution level."

Ayres said a hip injury in the first quarter to ruckman Michael Sikora, who had been providing the midfielders with first use of the ball, hurt the team.

He added the WA fitness and ability to spread proved telling in the last quarter.

He said the host State's "construction of play" when they entered the forward 50 was better in the pivotal last quarter.

"They had better separation with their key forwards, hence (Wayde) Twomey kicking five goals," Ayres said.

"We certainly never gave up – as you know the Big V would never do that – but in the end they were a bit more clinical, more efficient and more effective.

"We just didn't have that composure they did when we got the ball inside the forward 50 in the last quarter.

"We certainly had the better of them in the first half, but by three-quarter time we had not done enough with the momentum we earlier had."

Ayres said that the VFL several times were just one goal away from breaking away, but to WA's credit they remained in the contest with telling goals at telling times.

He said that ability to kick goals when needed not only kept WA in the match, but also kept the local crowd in the match and that played its part, too, in fuelling that self-belief.

"Full credit to the WA team. I'm aware it had been a

long time since they had defeated Victoria (1991), but they certainly finished far better than we did," Ayres said.

"We really failed to get the ball further than our half forward line and because we couldn't get any deep entries they were able to rebound and hurt us on transition.

"They were able to win 50/50 marks or contests better than us in that last quarter and it showed on the scoreboard."



VFL STATE MATCH - Frank Johnson Medalist

CHRIS Cain was in no mood to celebrate one of the highest accolades bestowed on a Peter Jackson VFL player.

Cain was named as the recipient of the Frank Johnson Medal for the best VFL player in a representative match.

He joins current Port Melbourne captain John Baird, who won the Medal last year, as well as Robin Nahas (2007) and Steven Lawrence (2004) as Port Melbourne players to win the Frank Johnson Medal

Despite his herculean efforts – he collected a team high 32 disposals and was forever trying to lift his teammates over a resolute opposition – Cain was devastated that the VFL had coughed up a 31-point lead midway through the third quarter.

Cain described as “nice” the Frank Johnson Medal, but was quick to note it would have been much better to come away with a win.

He said he was “pleased” to have a run in the midfield, but the taste of defeat lingered.

“Obviously, a win is what everyone is all about,” Cain said.

“We were looking pretty good early on, we probably needed just a couple more goals on top of that and it might have been a different story.

“We gave away too many free kicks and they came back at us really hard.”

Cain noted the transition from end to end was frenetic and that took its toll on the VFL late in the match.

“I think we just ran out of legs a little bit,” he said.

“In the last 10 minutes they were just able to run harder to contests.”

Cain said the injury to ruckman Michael Sikora was crucial as he had been in dominant form early in the match.

“He was awesome early, he was winning every tap,” Cain said.

“As soon as he went down, we had to go more defensive than we would have liked.”

It should not take the gloss of his game or the honour of the Frank Johnson Medal.

It is a medal struck in recognition of one of the greatest ever players in the competition's history.



Consider the achievements of Johnson, who like Cain, was a Port Melbourne player who set new standards.

Johnson played eight seasons for Port Melbourne from 1950 to 57. During that eight year period he won five best and fairests and he represented the VFA every year he played at the Borough.

More significantly, he was named an All Australian in 1953 and '56 and in 2008 he was inducted to the AFL Hall Of Fame – the only VFA player to be honoured by the AFL.

While he may not feel like it at the moment, Cain can reflect proudly on winning a Medal named in honour of a competition great.

Ferguson ready for VFL challenge

MAYBE it was his diminutive stature, but Lachlan Ferguson somehow fell through a crack and never played in the TAC Cup.

For many it may have been enough for them to close the book on ambitions to play AFL, but for Ferguson it just served as greater motivation.

While Ferguson is still a fair way off the AFL landscape, the 20-year-old is certainly putting his name back on recruiter's radars after an impressive start to his VFL career with Collingwood.

New Magpies VFL coach Dale Tapping saw Ferguson play for Collegians in the VAFA Grand Final, the third year in a row he'd played and the third time he'd impacted on the Amateur's biggest match.

Tapping noted that Ferguson, listed at 170cm and 73kg, has made "good progression" in his first VFL season.

"He was pretty dynamic in the 'A' grade Grand Final so we were pretty keen to get him on board. There was a fair bit of interest from a few other VFL clubs," Tapping.

"He's been pretty good. He has great speed and really hunts the ball well in his small forward role. He's busy, he's creative and has a really good appetite for the game.

"There's a lot to like and a lot of improvement in him. If he continues to track up who knows where he could end up."

Ferguson, who played with Collegians during his final year at Wesley College, recalled how he remained focused although he was overlooked at Oakleigh Chargers.

He said he was "stronger and better" for the disappointment of not playing in the TAC Cup.

The step up from VAFA to VFL hasn't overwhelmed Ferguson. In fact, he's made a seamless transition.

"I've always enjoyed a contest. I have always pictured myself as someone who is a tough and intense player," Ferguson said.

"I've enjoyed the VFL. I love the pace, I've loved the intensity about it."

Ferguson added that he's relished the opportunity to play alongside some Collingwood greats like Alan Didak, Luke Ball and Andrew Krakouer.

He said all the Collingwood players were so enthusiastic, supportive and helpful.

While not wanting to get too far ahead of himself, Ferguson said it had been a long held ambition to take his football as far as it could go.

"It's been my goal for many years and that's where I want to end up – on an AFL list," Ferguson said.

"The last couple of years I've been battling a hip injury. This is the fittest I've ever been, I'm ready to go."

Gallagher returns to VFL

WHEN David Gallagher left Sandringham early last year it appeared the curtain had fallen on the career of one of the best players in the VFL in the first decade of the new millennium.

Gallagher was the last member of the Zebras' super team of 2004-05-06 when Sandringham, under the coaching of Mark Williams, dominated the competition like few other clubs in the competition's history.

There was little that Gallagher didn't achieve at the Trevor Barker Oval – two best and fairests, including one in a premiership year, named four times to the VFL Team of the Year and captaining the club.

The former Adelaide/Carlton player was an integral part of that dynasty, but on the losing side of 30, it appeared Gallagher's VFL career had finished.

Wrong.

Gallagher, who played his first VFL match in 2002 when he was on Carlton's list and the Blues fielded its own VFL team, may be the second oldest player in the competition

– John Baird has him covered by 55days - but you would never know it.

He said he's as enthusiastic as he ever was during his time with Sandringham.

Last year Gallagher spent his time as assistant coach of University Blues in the VAFA and while he deliberately didn't play, he maintained his training regimen.

"I was still pretty fit and still pretty hungry to play good football," Gallagher said.

"I thought I still had some pretty good football in me and something to offer the game and in particular younger players as a teammate."

While he lives literally around the corner from Port Melbourne, Gallagher hit it off with Frankston coach Simon Goosey and Dolphins' General Manager Bryan Mace.

"I just liked their vibe," Gallagher said.

As for his departure from Sandringham, Gallagher noted: "My time had come for a change."

While the season remains in its infancy, Gallagher is loving his new 'digs' and reconnecting to the VFL.

"Frankston on its own is really, really in a good place right now in terms of the energy of the place and one of 'Goose's (coach Simon Goosey) fundamental beliefs is that football should be fun.

"He puts a lot of work into ensuring the boys are having a good time as well as the hard work. In terms of the atmosphere and energy of the place, it's awesome."

From his time with Uni Blues, Gallagher said he took away the importance of having a "responsible and hard-edged playing group".

Gallagher added that he's hoping he can have some "positive effect" on the young Dolphins in that regard.

As for the 2013 season being his swansong, Gallagher is not putting any boundaries on when his VFL career may end.

"I'm pretty sure my body would be completely fine to do it, but I don't really have a plan," Gallagher said.

"Short term I just want to play some hot footy and help the young boys do the same."

Career goes full circle for Welsh

FOOTBALL has a knack of turning a full revolution – just ask new Casey Scorpions coach Rohan Welsh.

When you trace through Welsh's career, back from the more recent days when he guided Vic Metro to two NAB AFL Under 18 Championships and was at TAC Cup region Oakleigh Chargers, who he took to the 2006 flag.

Scroll back further to his playing days at Carlton – he kicked two goals in the Blues' losing 1993 Grand Final match against Essendon.

And then you'll come to the VFL. Or as it was known when Welsh was playing the VFA.

In fact, Welsh had two stints in the VFA – his starting point at Dandenong, where he was a member of the Redlegs' 1991 premiership and then a two-year stint at Frankston when his AFL career had finished.

Delve a little deeper and you'll find a Rohan Welsh as the

winner of the 'Frosty' Miller medal in 1991 with 84 goals for Dandenong.

After he finished with Vic Metro last season, Welsh expected to have a season away from football when he received a phone call just before Christmas asking if he would be interested in the Scorpions' job.

Brett Lovett, who took Casey to the top of the ladder at the end of the 2012 home and away season, unexpectedly stepped aside.

"I said 'I can come down for a chat next week and they said can you come over the weekend'," Welsh said.

"I went there on the Sunday and they offered me the job on the Sunday night or Monday. It happened pretty quickly."



Welsh said he'd always been interested in doing "something" in the VFL and when the Casey opportunity arose he thought he'd take it.

While Welsh's position is part-time, he's immersed himself full time in the position.

As part of his role with the Scorpions, Welsh is also on the match committee for Melbourne, the affiliate for Casey. He does the reviews with all the Melbourne players who play with the Scorpions.

"From a development point of view for myself it's really good, just to see how an AFL club works," Welsh said.

While he has been in the position less than six months, Welsh is continually working on improving the alignment for the benefit of both clubs.

For the first time, Melbourne players who are playing with Casey train with the Scorpion players before a match.

While the logistics can be difficult, given that AFL players must have days off, a group of the Scorpion players have been travelling to AAMI Park to train with Melbourne on a Friday morning.

Welsh said the interaction between the two groups – Scorpions and Demons – has been greater than in the past.

"In the past they would come into the room and half would not know each other and they would just run out on the ground and try to play footy," Welsh said.

"From that point of view we've really started to work on the alignment. It has been a real positive."

Casey Scorpions didn't actively target any ex-AFL or other VFL players. It concentrated on young players from TAC Cup regions or local community leagues.

Welsh said one of the most encouraging aspects is the continual development and improvement of the young players.

"From a developmental point of view for the club, I think that is the way to go," Welsh said.

"There may be short term pain, but over the next couple of years I think the club will put themselves in a position where it will be pretty strong."

Dealing with disappointed players goes with the territory of a coach, but Welsh said he feels the best way to deal with it is to be "honest, up front" with players.

Welsh said the message to all players is that "inadequate performances" and/or "inadequate attitude" will not be tolerated.

He said senior players should not have to be reminded of what's required and that applies to both lists.

"It's up to them to get their way back into the team. It's not good for them to sulk and say 'it's all too hard' as at the end of the day they have to work their way back into the team," Welsh said.

"The easiest way for them to do that is to work hard."

Welsh said the criteria for selection revolved around form not reputation and he added that the prefix of being an AFL listed or rookie player doesn't guarantee anyone anything.

It has the endorsement of Melbourne.

"We've had that discussion with all the players and the playing group and that's the way it is," Welsh said.

"There's going to be times when more (Melbourne) senior players are coming back from injury and Casey players understand that they possibly wouldn't go into the Development team.

"That's the nature of the competition. It's like the 23rd player, he comes out of the TAC Cup, Gippsland Power and he gets an opportunity to play.

"I told the players that these are the rules, these are the parameters. As long as the guys know that the team is picked solely and purely on merit and form and if they don't perform they don't get picked."

JAMIE GRINDAL - 100th GAME

WHILE Jordan Banister and Leigh Fisher turned to umpiring when their playing careers finished, Jamie Grindal can be considered a "lifer".

Grindal, who umpired his 100th VFL match in the Round 5 North Ballarat/Frankston encounter, began umpiring when he was 10!

He followed the lead of his brothers who were umpires and after initially running the boundary for five years he switched to field umpiring.

He loved it that match he would umpire junior games on a Saturday and a Sunday before his passion for it saw him progress to the next level.

Grindal spent 10 years umpiring in the Diamond Valley Football League before he received an invitation to train with the AFL Victoria squad.

After breaking into the squad, Grindal umpired the 2007 TAC Cup Grand Final between Calder Cannons and Murray Bushrangers at the MCG.

He's racked up three AFL Victoria Development League Grand Finals as well as several senior VFL Finals.

"My goal is to do a VFL Grand Final, I've just got to keep working at it," Grindal said.

"The coaching staff is fantastic. People don't understand how much coaching we get, all the vision and feed-back that's given so that we can keep improving.

"I can't wrap them enough, they've been great. You just feel comfortable talking with them.

"You have your ups and downs, you might get the occasional kick in the butt, but you take it all on board and you just keep working on it. I've enjoyed every moment down there.

"I view it as a great achievement just to umpire in the VFL – it is such a great competition."

What has impressed Grindal is the interaction umpires have with the coaches and players.

Grindal recalled how North Ballarat coach Gerard FitzGerald, captain Michael Searl and club legend Shaune Moloney greeted him before the Frankston match.

It was 'Umpiring is Everyone's Business' week as well as his 100th match and neither was overlooked by the figureheads of the North Ballarat Football Club who visited Grindal and the other umpires before the match.

"'Fitz' is a fantastic bloke on and off the field. He and Michael came up to me before the game. They said they had a feeling it was getting close to my 100th game.

Round 5 review

We look back a few weeks at the results in Round 5 of the Peter Jackson VFL:

GEELONG d WERRIBEE TIGERS: Geelong continued their unbeaten start to the season defeating Werribee by 55 points to claim the K-Rock Cup. With 20 points separating the sides at three quarter time, Geelong stormed to victory with an eight goal to two final term to continue their great start to 2013; on top of the ladder as the only undefeated side after five rounds. Geelong had a number of options to goal, with Nathan Vardy and George Burbury both kicking six goals, and Shane Kersten kicked four on his return from injury. Burbury, Jordan Schroder and Jackson Thurlow were amongst the best for the Cats, whilst Jarred Moore was dominant in the middle for the Tigers.

NORTH BALLARAT d FRANKSTON: A seven goal to nil first term against Frankston helped set up North Ballarat's second win of the season. Whilst the Dolphins fought back in the following three quarters – with a six goal to three final term – the damage had been done early, with the final result 45 points in favour of the home side. The Roosters shared around the goals, with five multiple goal kickers – Cam Richardson (3), Lucas Cook (3), Myles Sewell (2), Billy Driscoll (2), Marcus Darmody (2) – from their 13 individual goal kickers. Luke Kiel was amongst the best for the home side, along with Steve Clifton (26 possessions) and Sewell (36 plus 13 tackles). For Frankston, Sam Lloyd and Michael Lourey kicked four goals each, whilst Shane Hockey, Russ Gabriel and Scott Simpson were named as their best.

PORT MELBOURNE d CASEY SCORPIONS: Port Melbourne staged a customary final term fight back, not once but twice, to keep their impeccable home ground unbeaten run intact as they defeat Casey Scorpions by just three points. The Borough inflicted the first defeat of the season on the Scorpions. With Casey enjoying a 23-point lead at three quarter time, Port Melbourne kicked the first four goals in the first five minutes of the final term to take the lead. Casey returned to the lead, before the Borough made one last charge, themselves jumping out to a nine-point lead at the 27 minute mark. Casey was unable to regain the lead as Port produced an epic win. Josh Scipione kicked four majors, along with Sam O'Sullivan with three, whilst for Casey, Jack Fitzpatrick, Dawes and Nathan Page kicked to three each.

COBURG d ESSENDON: Coburg stated their intentions early in their clash versus Essendon, kicking the first five goals of the game to race out to a 28 point lead. The Tigers extended their margin at every change, by 40 at half time and by 67 at three quarter time, before a last quarter lapse

saw Essendon kick six goals to one, for Coburg to win by 34 points. Versatility to goal was the key for Coburg, as they boasted 11 goal kickers, with Liam McBean and Robin Nahas kicking four each – Nahas kicking three of his four in the third quarter. Nahas was named best on ground, along with Shane Tuck (31 disposals, 10 tackles), Nathan Foley (27), Aaron Edwards (19 and two goals) and Nick Maric (18), whilst Will Hams, Trent Shinner (three final term goals) and Hal Hunter were amongst the best for Essendon.

BOX HILL HAWKS d BENDIGO: The Box Hill Hawks won two in a row for the first time this season recording an 87-point win over Bendigo. It took the Hawks a half to shake the determined Gold, as only 20 points separated the two sides at half time. A 14 goal to four second half secured the win for Box Hill, as Liam Tobin, Pat Lawlor and Amos Frank all kicked two three goals. Kyle Cheney was best for the Hawks in defence, and he was well supported by Shane Savage, Sam Iles and Tobin. Alik Magin was the best for Bendigo, along with Daniel Toman, Troy Kelm and Galen Munari.

SANDRINGHAM d NORTHERN BLUES: Sandringham staged a miraculous second half comeback, to turn a 38 point third quarter deficit - at the 20 minute mark - into a 13-point victory against the Northern Blues. Marcus Marigliani was pushed forward in the second half, with the captain kicking two goals, along with great input from Tom Curren (22 disposals), Hamish Shephard (22) and Tom Ledger (31). Chris Michaliades was named best for Sandringham, along with Sam Dunnell, Adam Cockie and Shephard. For Northern Blues, Levi Casboul (four goals) and Luke Mitchell (3) were the main avenues to goal, whilst leading disposals went to Tom Bell (26 disposals), Kane Lambert (25) and Andrew Collins (24).

WILLIAMSTOWN d COLLINGWOOD: In a tight game between Williamstown and Collingwood, a seven goal to four final term saw the Seagulls take the win by just six points. Trailing by nine points at three quarter time, Williamstown raced home in the final term kicking four unanswered goals midway through the term to set up their win - three of those to Leigh Williams. Cam Wood dominated against his old side, recording 50 hit outs in the ruck, whilst Williams led the goal kicking with four, Simon Deery kicked three on debut for the Seagulls, along with three to Kirby McConnon. Willie Wheeler, Josh Prudden, Fletcher Roberts and Williams were amongst the best for Williamstown, whilst Ben Moloney, Caolan Mooney, Marley Williams and Alan Didak were best for Collingwood.

Unfortunately for the emergency, which this year was to be Williamstown's Willie Wheeler, they have been unable to play on game day, and are there only as an injury emergency. Luckily for Wheeler, common sense prevailed between both leagues, and the VFL were able to play all 23 of their touring party. Here's betting 2012 emergency Kane Lambert, despite getting a berth in the 2013 team, would have loved for the emergency to have been given a game last year versus Tasmania.

Responsible gambling awareness week

Responsible Gambling Awareness Week aims to highlight to Victorians that perceptions often do not always match reality when it comes to gambling. The following is an article by former Melbourne footballer Daniel Ward.

The Cost of Problem Gambling

I am very happy to be part of this AFL Victoria initiative in raising the awareness for responsible gambling throughout regional, rural and suburban Victoria for the second consecutive year.

I was fortunate enough to play 136 games for the Melbourne Football Club, one of those matches being an AFL Grand Final. It was during this period, when I should have been living the dream, that I began my destructive path to a gambling addiction.

Gambling doesn't start as a problem, for most people it starts out as a fun thing.

I agree, it is a great way to socialise and to relax after a hard day's work, it can make you feel better if you are a bit down, and certainly gives you a good buzz when you win.

For me though, gambling became a problem – and I ended up spending everything I had. Some nights I would run my car out of petrol because I had spent the last \$20 on a bet.

When I started to gamble, I never thought that the cost to me would be any more than a couple of dollars that I could

easily cover with the money I was making as an AFL player.

Little did I know at the time, but gambling would pull my life apart.

I was a gambling addict. I was a liar. I hurt every person I'd ever loved.

As a player and coach of a country club in the Central Murray Football League I understand just how important a football and netball club can be – not only to the players, but often to the community that they represent.

With the increasing availability of gambling on phones and computers it is getting easier every day for a person to gamble. It is also easier to lose. The risks of problem gambling – even in country communities – have never been greater.

When my gambling was beginning to become a problem I noticed that I spent a lot of time thinking about betting, and I was actually spending more time gambling than with my teammates, family and friends.

I started to avoid paying bills so that I could use the money for bets, and with this, came the lies I would use to cover up that I was gambling.

I also started to place bigger and bigger bets in an effort to chase my losses. I did this until I owed people a small fortune.

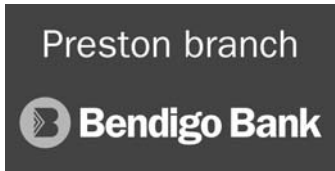
