

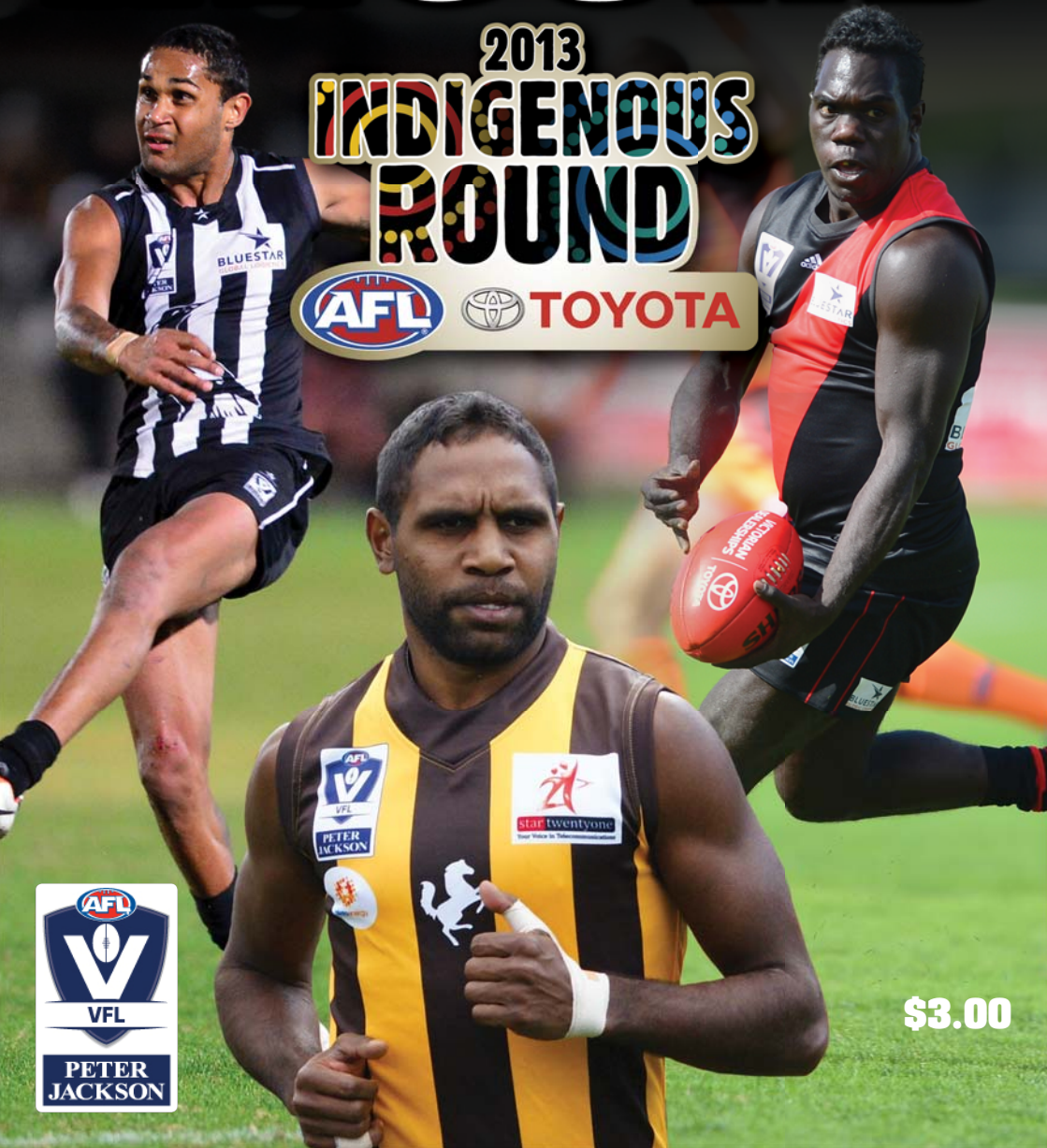

Indigenous round

IT'S been 20 years since Nicky Winmar stood defiantly at Victoria Park, raised his St Kilda jumper and proudly pointed to his identity.

Much has happened since that poignant moment in Australian football history, which still serves as a lasting symbol of resilience, determination and pride for many Indigenous people, but also for all Australians.

As we reflect on the trail blazers like Winmar and legends like Graham 'Polly' Farmer, Syd Jackson, Barry Cable, Gavin Wanganeen, Maurice Rioli and Michael Long, we can only marvel at the numerous Indigenous players that have excited and entertained football fans as well as helped grow our great game.

The AFL's Indigenous Round, highlighted by the Dreamtime at the G match on Saturday night, allows everyone to celebrate and share aspects of the Indigenous heritage, history and culture.

Certainly, Indigenous Round provides a fabulous opportunity to recognise, honor and salute the achievements and ever-increasing contribution Indigenous players have made.

At the AFL level this season there are more than 80 Indigenous players or, more significantly, 10 percent of club lists.

This involvement at the game's elite level is underpinned by the many programs and competitions throughout Victoria and Australia.

Earlier this year in Townsville a combined Victorian/Tasmanian U15 team made the national AFL KickStart Championship Grand Final where they were gallant in defeat against Western Australia.

It was an extension of the newly created High Performance Camp that provided 50 participants with fitness, skill testing and an introduction to the four pillars of Kickstart which include resilience, communication, identity and culture and decision making.

In addition, earlier this year, AFL Victoria announced the development and implementation of the Laguntas Indigenous Tigers program.

Supported by the AFL, the Korin Gomandji Institute (KGI) and AFL SportsReady, the aim of the program is to further develop the pathway to the AFL competition for Indigenous players in Victoria. In the future, it is planned that the program will provide training and education to support the off field development of up to 50 Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islanders annually.

This year the Laguntas Indigenous Tigers team play three games that will be incorporated into AFL Victoria's talent pathway program match schedule including playing against some TAC Cup sides.

In this edition of the Football Record Oakleigh Chargers' Jay Kennedy-Harris, the first Indigenous player to captain a TAC Cup team side, speaks about how beneficial the KickStart program has been to his career.

Kennedy-Harris this weekend will represent Vic Metro against Queensland in the opening match of the NAB AFL U18 Championships.

At Victoria Park on Saturday, the U15 Kickstart team will play the U16 Ahmed Saad Squad as a curtain raiser to the Collingwood/Essendon Peter Jackson VFL game.

Ultimately, AFL Victoria hope that our Indigenous programs will result in a better defined more inclusive pathway so more Indigenous people can be involved at all levels of the game, including the TAC Cup and Peter Jackson VFL competitions.

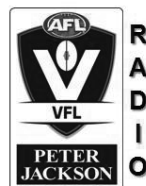

Williams ready for full season

LAST year was supposed to be the start of something exhilarating, something special, something that would remain forever etched in the memory of Leigh Williams.

Williams won't forget season 2012, but for all the wrong reasons.

After Melbourne chose Williams with selection No 59 in the Rookie Draft the Norwood forward from the Eastern Football League had much reason to be excited about.

Excitement switched to concern. Serious concern.

Early in the pre-season, Williams, who kicked 89 goals in the 2011 season with Norwood, suffered back ligament damage, which delayed his start to the year.

Events would, however, spiral downwards.

Williams endured what he described as a "minor concussion", which led to Meningitis, an inflammation of the protective membrane covering the brain and spinal cord, and then Encephalitis.

"It wasn't the greatest of years, it was pretty disappointing," said Williams, who took three months to recover.

After playing four games with Casey Scorpions, Williams injured an ankle, which ended his season.

Worse still, Melbourne delisted him at the end of an eminently forgettable season.

Fortunately, Williams has made a complete recovery from the illness issues and apart from a few little niggles, his ankle is fine.

Williams, desperate to return to the AFL, chose Williamstown as the club to launch his comeback.

"With me trying to get back into the AFL system, I just thought Williamstown would be the place to go," Williams said.

"They're moving forward and going stand-alone next year as well I thought with all the professionalism there it would be the right place for me."

Williams is enjoying his new digs, even if his goal conversion rate could be better, but his four goal haul against Collingwood proved the difference between a six-point win and a loss.

It was a positive contribution, but Williams candidly admitted he's struggled for form early in the season.

"It was good to pinch a couple of late goals against Collingwood and build some confidence for the upcoming weeks," Williams said.

"(My) kicking has been a let-down so far. I'm hoping it will get better and soon."

With the Western Bulldogs alignment coupled with ex-AFL players Brent Prismall, Cam Wood, Justin Sherman as well as the Williamstown component, Williams noted there was a lot to like about Williamstown.

"There is a pretty good mix of players running around and the professionalism around the club is great," enthused Williams.

"It's really good for all the young guys to have these sort of experienced players running around with you at training and on game day."

Above everything, Leigh Williams is just happy to have last year behind him and back playing footy.

Baird gains VFL life membership

NO one has more authority or 'cred' to talk about the revamped VFL than John Baird – he's literally seen the competition unfold.

Baird is the only current player who played when the AFL Reserves morphed into the new VFL back in 2000.

As he prepares for his 175th VFL game this weekend and therefore earns VFL Life Membership, Baird can remember playing some games – six, in fact – in Box Hill Hawks seniors at the start of the new millennium.

The then 21-year-old, on Hawthorn's rookie list, would make a much bigger impression the following season.

Not only would he play in the Box Hill Hawks premiership, under the guidance of 'super coach' Donald McDonald, but he would be named as the Norm Goss Medalist for best-on-ground.

Baird remembers vividly that Box Hill Hawks went in as "massive" under dogs after Werribee had defeated them comfortably twice during the season.

"Donald McDonald coached very well and we had an amazing attack on the ball. We were harder and tougher than Werribee on the day," he recalled.

Baird was the centre half back in the VFL Hawks victory and apart from the Norm Goss honor, his game didn't go unnoticed.

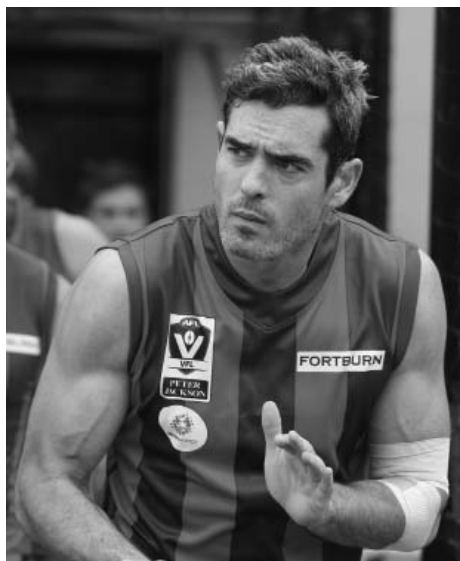
It was a performance that saw the Kangaroos draft him as a rookie and via the Roos' then affiliation with Port Melbourne would introduce him to the Borough.

After playing 46 games with the Kangaroos, Baird was delisted and ventured to Adelaide where he played for the Port Adelaide Magpies in the SANFL. It turned out to be a one year visit.

Port Melbourne got wind about Baird's return, spoke to him and soon after signed him. That was at the start of the 2007 season and he has since forged a career that ranks up with the all-time great Boroughs.

Consider what Baird has accomplished: for openers five years as captain and that makes him the club's equal longest serving captain, joining another club legends Billy Hanneysee, who captained the club between 1886-90, and Billy McGee, who captained five times stretching over a 10-year period, beginning in 1901.

Now, there's some history for you.

He was also captain during its extraordinary 2011 season where Port went through the year undefeated; he's has won two best and fairests, named four times in the VFL Team Of The Year; captained the VFL.

And, sandwiched in those achievements is a season where he missed after damaging his Achilles, which erased an entire season.

The time away whetted his appetite and gave him a greater appreciation for the game and the club.

Queries from others about his ability to rebound from such a serious injury also propelled him. "I thought 'well, maybe I'll just prove some of those people wrong'," Baird recalled.

"Looking back, I've been pretty pleased with some of the things I've accomplished, but there's also been disappointment – losing a couple of Grand Finals.

"Maybe I've been lucky."

Baird is over-playing the modesty card. He's been a bona fide star of the competition.

He may well be the oldest player in the VFL and on the doorstep of his 33rd birthday, but you would never know it. Just take a straw poll of his peers.

Significantly, Baird said he's never enjoyed his football more and he attributes that both to his teammates, and also coach Gary Ayres, who re-shaped his career by elevating him to captain in his second year at the club and converting him from a defender to midfielder.

"I always liked the idea of running around in the midfield rather than having to follow someone around as a backman," Baird said.

"When Gary took over, I think I might have mentioned it at some point that I wouldn't mind a run around in the middle. He might have thrown me in there in the last quarter of a tight game early in the season and might have had an impact and it's rolled on from there.

"Today, I exclusively play in the midfield because I would be no good anywhere else with my lack of speed and jumping ability. It suits me and I think I've become a much better footballer by playing in the middle.

"Where you are finding enjoyment in things you are able to bring the best out of yourself.

"Probably the only reason I'm still playing is the enjoyment factor."

Baird's love for Port Melbourne was nowhere near as passionate when he was on the Kangaroos list. Then the club was more of a means to an end.

He believes that can undermine aligned clubs because, understandably he notes the AFL listed players want to play well to serve their own purpose.

"Being blunt about it, that's just the way it is," Baird said.

"As I've been back now for seven years, the place grows on you. It's far from perfect, but there are a lot of good people involved and that makes it the place it is.

"I've really enjoyed my time at Port Melbourne. A lasting memory I will take away from football will be my days at Port Melbourne, more than anything."

Sully grabs defensive post

FOOTBALL can be character building in so many ways, just ask Matthew Sully.

Last year Sully played in Geelong's first two VFL finals as the 23rd player and from all reports played well.

But given how the rules governing the 23rd work the Cats were then faced with a choice – play Sully on his merits as a VFL player or leave him out of the team.

With Geelong over-flowing with available AFL listed/rookie listed players, Sully couldn't force his way into the Cats' Preliminary Final or Grand Final team, which included just four and five VFL players respectively.

"It was sort of bitter sweet, I suppose," mused Sully.

"I was rapt the boys won. I watched it from home with mixed emotions. Obviously, I would have loved to be out there.

"I was happy that I could do whatever I could to get them there. Hopefully, I'll get my chance in the next couple of years."

With Andrew McLean, the general of Geelong's VFL defence, retiring after the premiership, Geelong VFL coach Matthew Knights told Sully the position was there for the taking.

Sully accepted the offer to step up to replace a seriously good VFL player. So much so that he was selected in the VFL squad to play Western Australia earlier in the month.

Again, Sully was a victim of the number crunching game. He missed the cut.

Mindful of the heartache from last year, several friends sent Sully a text to bolster his spirits, but while disappointed, the 20-year-old was pleased he'd made enough of an impression to make the Peter Jackson VFL squad.

"I was pretty happy to make the initial squad then disappointed not to make the final team, but really it's my first full year playing VFL," Sully said.

"I got a message from a few of the boys to say 'keep your head up'. It was a good experience to train with the VFL squad."

Sully had the choice of playing with North Ballarat, where he played with the club's feeder club North Ballarat Rebels, or Geelong, given he hails from Warrnambool.

After a meeting with James Rahilly, a former Geelong 90-game player, Norm Goss Medalist in the Cats' 2002 VFL premiership and current Geelong assistant coach, Sully decided to pursue his football with Geelong's VFL club.

It helped that Rahilly played with South Warrnambool, the club he played in a premiership with in 2011.

"He spoke about Geelong, what a great club it is, so I went up there and trained and I've loved it," Sully said.

"The coaches are really good at communicating to us younger blokes. Everyone knows their role."

Matthew Sully knows his role and wants to lock it away so there can be no further disappointment.

Kiel given stopping role

WHEN he left Frankston Oval after watching Geelong harpoon the Dolphins, North Ballarat coach Gerard FitzGerald identified David Gallagher as a player the Rooster's needed to subdue in its upcoming encounter.

While Gallagher may be on the losing side of 30, FitzGerald's in-depth knowledge of the competition stretching back to the turn of the competition afford him a telling insight into the dynamics of Gallagher.

FitzGerald knew first-hand just how dangerous a player is Gallagher, one of the few players whose speed and explosiveness can ignite a team.

He pointed to Gallagher's significant contribution when Sandringham posted a premiership three peat.

"I had clearly in my mind that he had to be closed down. He's a barometer as well as being that senior statesmen figure that resonates with the Frankston players,"

Fitzgerald said.

"I thought if we can make life tough for him, we might damage them a bit."

FitzGerald assigned the task of nullifying Gallagher to Luke Kiel, a veteran of four games.

Luke who?

The previous week FitzGerald assigned Kiel to combat Essendon's Leroy Jetta in the second half after Jetta had cut apart the Rooster's in the first half.

Kiel was able to subdue Jetta and he was even more effective on Gallagher, limiting the three-time premiership player to a handful of possessions.

What made Kiel's game stand out even more was that he was able to collect 18 possessions and kick a goal.

"We thought he had a really good game," FitzGerald said.

Kiel, who was playing for Swan Hill in the Central Murray Football League, was recommended to FitzGerald two seasons ago.

He tried out with Bendigo Pioneers, but didn't make the list.

"I decided to make the move. I was living in Swan Hill and I'd just had enough of it, it's a small little town," Kiel said.

"I'd always wanted to have a crack at some decent football. It's easy to stay at home and make good money, but I thought I'd come down to Ballarat and have a crack."

Kiel spent the entire 2012 season playing with North Ballarat's Development League team. He had no issue.

"I'm glad that I didn't get a game because I wasn't up to it," Kiel declared.

"I was told to work harder in the pre-season. 'Fitz' (FitzGerald) told me to stick around, he said 'you've got it, but you've just got to get yourself right'.

"I probably wasn't as fit as I should have been. I was my first pre-season and I'd only trained a couple of times before Christmas."

While a shoulder operation slowed his start, Kiel hit the gym and entered the season much fitter than he'd ever been.

Not only has Luke Kiel made it into the North Ballarat team, but he's making a considerable impact.

Riddle leads by example

THE enormity of the role bestowed upon him is not lost on Nick Riddle.

Just days before his 21st birthday, Collingwood's VFL coach Dale Tapping rang Riddle with the news that he and Jack Hellier would co-captain the VFL Magpies during 2013.

With Kris Pendlebury, the Collingwood captain the previous three seasons, deciding to move to Werribee, the captaincy position was vacant, but Riddle didn't view himself as a candidate.

"Kris was a big loss. I've taken on his responsibilities down back and then to be made co-captain with Jack Hellier was something I didn't expect," Riddle said.

"It was a very good surprise. It's a bit strange; I've never captained any side at any level. I find it challenging in a good way.

"I look forward to developing my leadership, it's an area I definitely need to work on."

If it's not daunting enough for a 20-year-old to be playing alongside dual AFL premiership player Darren Jolly as well as other premiership stars Luke Ball, Alan Didak and Dale Thomas, to captain a team with those above-mentioned players takes it to a whole new level.

Riddle described as a "bit weird" captaining such greats of the game.

"I definitely didn't give any of them a spray," laughed Riddle.

"Credit to them all. They've all come back and played their role for the team and offered a lot of on field leadership.

"They've all bought into the team and made my job a lot easier."

Collingwood has started this season far more competitively than last season and its first three losses ranged from six to 13-points.

"We have been thereabouts, we just need to play four quarters and finish off our games," Riddle said.

"We have been in all games so it's been disappointing that we have not been able to win them.

"We have some big games coming up so we need to put

together a four quarter game."

Riddle reflected back to the pre-season of the 2012 season where he hoped to get the opportunity to play the occasional game with Collingwood's VFL club when he was invited to train.

He knew that Collingwood players took priority over all VFL listed players. It was something that sat comfortably him.

Nothing much changed in his mindset when Riddle received the call-up to play in Round 4 against Northern Blues.

Not only did Riddle acquit himself well, but he held his spot for all the remaining games.

Riddle was keen to continue the association in 2013, but not even in his wildest dreams did he expect what was to unfold.

"It's been massive," Riddle said.

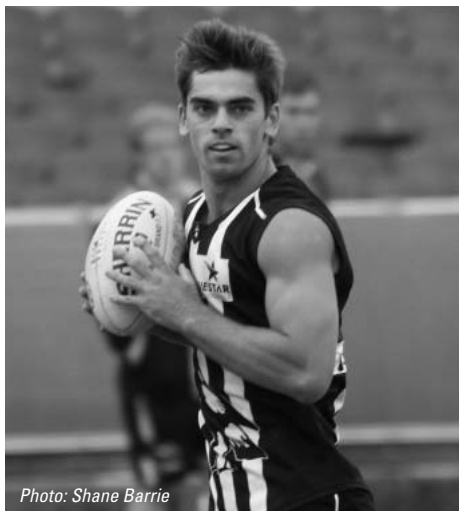

Brown celebrates game 150

THE first Matthew Brown knew of his impending 150th match as a VFL umpire was when he was contacted by Victorian Football Umpires Association historian David Flegg in the days before the match.

For Brown game 150, which was last weekend's Essendon/Port Melbourne match, is just a number. He's not driven by racking up milestones or reaching a particular statistic.

Brown umpires simply because of the enjoyment factor and the camaraderie of the umpiring fraternity.

"I've met a lot of good mates through umpiring. I got married last year and there were six to eight umpires at my wedding," Brown said.

"I've made a lot of good friends over the years and the most enjoyable part is training with those guys, having a laugh."

Brown played junior football, but he decided to switch to umpiring when he was a 'bottom age' player in the Under 17s.

"I'd intended to go back and play when I was a bit older, a bit bigger. I wasn't the biggest person going around," he said.

"I took up umpiring because my old man did it in his day. I never went back to playing and just kept umpiring."

Brown's father Ian was on the VFL panel, but umpired around the country leagues. He's an umpire observer these days.

It was back in 2003 that Brown joined the VFL Development panel and he served a two year 'apprenticeship' before breaking through into the senior ranks.

Matt Brown can vaguely remember his first VFL match. It was at Skilled Stadium in 2005, but he can't remember who the VFL Cats were opposed against in the curtain raiser to an AFL match.

"Apart from that I have no real memories of it," Brown said.

Brown has tried a couple of times to progress to the AFL, but hasn't quite made it.

"It was a lack of spots or whatever, but I probably wasn't quite good enough when I had my opportunity," he said.

"I've got no real desire to get there at the moment and I'm getting on now. I'm 31."

What Brown has noticed is the upsurge in appreciation and recognition umpires now receive. "Obviously you get the odd mug that has a go at you. Ninety per cent of the people are pretty good and the clubs are pretty good in the way they look after us," he said.

"It's gone away from the 1980s and 90s when umpires were getting abused left, right and centre. It's not really an issue in the VFL."

Brown is unsure if he'll get to 200 games.

"I just go out there because I enjoy it. I try to do my best every game, I'm not out there to get to any certain amount of games," he said.

"I keep doing it until I stop enjoying it and then I'll stop."

A day out at... Mantello Holden Oval

Each week on the VFL website, Kent Winzer reports on his weekend visits to VFL venues.

Below is his recent visit to Mantello Holden Oval

In Round 5 of the Peter Jackson VFL I headed to the suburb that was known until 1870 as Pentridge. Due to the stigma connected to the prison of the same name that was built in 1850, residents petitioned the government of the day for a change of name, to disconnect the stigma of the prison from the suburb itself. In March 1870, the government officially declared Coburg as the new name, and it has remained so until this day.

In 1891, the Coburg Football Club was formed and commenced playing at what is now Mantello Holden Oval, formerly known as Coburg City Oval. The club and venue have a proud history, with six 1st Division Premierships, and two in the 2nd Division. The club has also been home to three J.J. Liston Trophy winners, and two winners of the Recorder Cup, which preceded the JJ Liston Trophy. Famously, some of Coburg's favourite sons include Phil Cleary, Ray 'Slug' Jordan, Col Kinnear, Mick Erwin, Brad Nimmo, and Nick Carnell, but a less well-known example is the fact that Bob Pratt kicked 183 goals for the Lions in the 1941 VFA season.

As we crossed the busy Sydney Road, we found ourselves mixing with locals undertaking their normal Saturday morning shopping rituals. The area is now incredibly diverse and cosmopolitan, as can be noted when you look at the array of retailers of different backgrounds in the vicinity. From here, we head down Harding Street, through the car park, and to the main gate at Mantello Holden Oval.

This brings a tinge of sadness to those who, like myself, have attended the venue many times in recent years. The sight you'd normally see is volunteer George Parry, either clicking memberships or selling footy records. Sadly, George passed away over the summer, leaving quite a large hole in the volunteer base that makes the Coburg Football Club a great organisation. Many regulars have a story to tell about George, whether it be handling the club

BBQ, cooking the steamed dim sims, or welcoming people to the ground, and club, he loved so much.

We enter the ground before the 1:10pm start time, and see Ross Booth with Phil Cleary on the boundary line doing their pre-match routine. Phil is decked-out in his old Coburg jumper, talking-up the prospects of the club as they go it alone in 2014.

The terraces are quiet today, with both Coburg's and Essendon's AFL affiliates playing on the same day. The terraces are an item of note, somewhat oversized for a Peter Jackson VFL venue. This is because they were built when the venue hosted North Melbourne games in 1965, including a record of 21,626 when Collingwood visited during that season. The main grandstand still awaits funding from the local council to be rebuilt after a fire almost destroyed it nearly a decade ago.

As we settled in to the first quarter, the Burgers kicked away early, and we did too with a sausage with onions from the BBQ. The snag was top notch, clearly a butcher variety, and was a perfect start to our day out. We complemented the sausage with a barista-brewed coffee, which was also excellent. A fully-fledged coffee machine, whilst welcome, is not something you'd expect to see on the terraces at a venue like Mantello Holden Oval!

For the regulars at Coburg, there is a real community atmosphere at this ground. You run in to people you see regularly, and always see someone who you haven't seen in a long time. Great conversations ensue, old jokes come to the fore, and generally a good time is had by all.

Coburg had extended their lead from 28 at quarter time to 40 by half time, at which stage it was necessary to sample more of the tasty treats on offer. The kiosk at Coburg has actually started selling South Melbourne Market Dim Sims! A masterstroke! For anyone who has not tried this famous delicacy, words cannot describe the experience whatsoever.

The second half of the match felt as though both teams were playing for time. Coburg extended their lead to 67 at the final change, and the clouds rolled in with a chilly wind. Essendon fought back respectably in the final term, kicking six goals to one to reduce the margin at the siren to 34 points. At this point, it was time to grab our bags and head back to Coburg station, celebrating a very enjoyable day at this classic Peter Jackson VFL venue.

Celebrating Indigenous Round

VFL Indigenous Round will be celebrated for the second consecutive year at Victoria Park. The theme for Indigenous Round this year is Identity.

Identity is a concept central to Indigenous people, particularly in terms of heritage, community involvement and acceptance. Having the themed game at Victoria Park is of extra significance this year due to the 20th anniversary of the game at Victoria Park where Nicky Winmar lifted his Guernsey and pointed to his skin. This is the single most powerful statement of Aboriginal identity in the history of the game.

At Victoria Park this Saturday, a curtain raiser game between the Under 16's Kickstart Squad versus the Multicultural Squad (Ahmed Saad Squad) will kick off the VFL Indigenous Round. This will be the beginning of a two game series which will conclude on Multicultural Round in Round 13. Team lists for both sides are on page 16.

The Under 16's is an extension to the Under 15's State Indigenous program which included regional trials, a high performance weekend, State camp and the National Championships. A further addition to this year's program has been created with the Laguntas team for 16 – 18 year old Victorian Indigenous youth playing three TAC Cup invitational games.

Prior to the Peter Jackson VFL game between Collingwood and Essendon at Victoria Park, a "Welcome to Country" Ceremony will introduce proceedings followed by the national anthem being sung by 20 year old Angel Renee Bruce who is the Sport & Recreation Officer from the very remote community of Alpururulum, which in the Northern Territory. It is 600kms north east of Alice Springs and 250kms north east from Mt Isa.

The celebration of Identity at Victoria Park as part of Indigenous Round is just one event arranged by AFL

Victoria this weekend. Other activities coordinated by AFL Victoria include:

- 140 local Victorian Indigenous Auskick participants will be taking part in the half time Auskick grid games with representation from the following NAB Auskick centres: Dandenong, Nowa Nowa, Fitzroy Stars, Rumbalara and Warrnambool
- A Dreamtime Career Expo will be taking place at the Korin Gamadji Institute, Richmond Football Club, ME Bank Centre, Punt Road Oval.
- The AFL in partnership with Rio Tinto has developed an U24 program to maximise talent and employment opportunities. The program is a two week program, with the first week held in Perth and a second to be held in Melbourne. This includes a Northern vs Southern match for U24 Indigenous Players to be played on the MCG as a curtain raiser to Dreamtime at the G. There are 9 Victorian participants in this program.
- AFL Victoria, the North Melbourne Football Club and with the help of Indigenous Ambassador and current North Melbourne player, Lindsay Thomas, have partnered to create an academy for participants aged 11-14 to take part in both boys and girls football as well as netball. The academy is open to Indigenous boys (AFL only) and girls (AFL and netball) aged 11-14 years, inclusion in the Academy will be based on character, commitment to education and community and club engagement. The Academy will be launched on Sunday as part of the North Melbourne vs Adelaide game at Etihad Stadium on Sunday.

Victorian selection for Kennedy-Harris

AS he reflected on last year's exhilarating TAC Cup Grand Final, Jay Kennedy-Harris noted "some special things can happen in footy".

Kennedy-Harris, a first year science student at Melbourne University, is the co-captain of Oakleigh Chargers - the first Indigenous player to captain a TAC Cup club.

As well as his leadership role with Chargers, Kennedy-Harris is also in the Vic Metro squad, which this weekend will open its NAB AFL Under 18 Championship campaign in Brisbane.

He admits he's looking forward particularly to this weekend for many reasons, quite apart from the honor of representing Victoria on the national stage.

"To have the acknowledgement of the Indigenous contribution to the AFL recognized is pretty special," Kennedy-Harris said.

"I feel a little special being able to play for Victoria in this round. Football is pretty big in the Indigenous community and it's been a big part of my life.

"To be where I am now, I'm pretty proud of myself. Each step is a little closer to a childhood dream of playing AFL.

"Like a lot of Indigenous boys it is a pretty proud thing."

While he said he hasn't had what he would call a role model, Kennedy-Harris said he's taken great solace from some of his Indigenous peers like Jarman Impney and Clay McCartney, who also play in the TAC Cup.

He said the camaraderie of those and others helped him progress through the KickStart program.

"It's kept me going, kept me stepping it up," Kennedy-Harris said.

"I remember when Jarman and Clayton were part of the AIS (AFL Academy) squad and how proud I was that they had been able to do that.

"For us there hasn't been too many Indigenous players to look up to in Victoria. To start setting a new trend is pretty special. It's like we're starting a bit of a movement for the Indigenous talent in Victoria.

"I have a lot of recognition and respect for the KickStart program and what it's done for myself and the other boys coming up through the TAC Cup system."

The Kickstart program is for Indigenous players at the Under 15 level, which introduces them to an elite football environment and includes playing for the Flying Boomerangs, an all Indigenous team.

Kennedy-Harris said it had helped him with his leadership skills.

"We talk a lot about our culture and what it means to be an Indigenous person to each other," he said.

"I think it accelerated a lot of us in terms of our character and our footballing ability and I think it is starting to show with growing number of players starting to represent TAC Cup teams.

"I've been given a lot of opportunities, some of them I may not have deserved, so I feel pretty fortunate," he said.

"If you really want to reach somewhere you just work as hard as you can until you achieve it and then you set a new goal.

"You keep climbing until you can't climb any further. It is the best way to look at things, not just football."

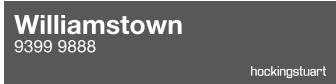
