

Mooroolbark Wall of Fame: Final

A very good junior footballer with Mooroolbark, Cam won the 3rd Division Colts League B & F in 2004 before moving on to East Ringwood and then Box Hill Hawks. He was drafted to North Melbourne in 2011 as a mature age recruit, and debuted in round one of that year, playing as North's sole ruckman against the Eagles Dean Cox & Nic Naitanui. He impressed with 20 possessions but after a fairly consistent season, found it hard to break back into the side in 2012, and at the end of that season was traded to Melbourne after 16 games with North. So far Cameron has managed another 6 games with the demons as he tries to consolidate his position in the side.

Aaron Mullett

Youngest of the three Mullet brothers, who all played their junior footy with the Mustangs, Aaron has managed to surpass his older siblings by making it all the way to the top. After 2 years at Eastern Ranges he was 34th pick in the 2011 AFL Rookie Draft. After playing well for Nth Ballarat in the VFL he was elevated to the senior list and made his debut in round 22 of that year. After a further 6 games in 2012, Aaron has now earned his place in the best 22 at North, playing every game so far this season and picking up a NAB Rising Star nomination in round 2. Initially a wingman, he has found his niche in the back half where his accurate left foot kicks have sent North from defence to attack on many occasions. Aaron had a career high 31 possessions in round 10 against St Kilda and looks destined for a long and successful AFL career.

Melees

As we progress to the latter part of the season and into junior and senior finals, and given there have been a number of incidents reported to us recently, it is timely to remind all involved in EFL football the rules regarding melees.



A melee is an incident involving six (6) or more players and/or officials who are pushing, grappling, wrestling or otherwise struggling with one another and which, in the opinion of the umpire(s) is likely to bring the game of Australian Football into disrepute or prejudice the interests or reputation of the EFL or the competitions conducted by the EFL.

In the event of a melee taking place and following three (3) continued instructions from the umpire(s) to break up the melee, if the melee continues, the umpire(s) shall report the incident to the league. The field umpire(s) appointed by the EFL shall record on the Umpires Match Report at the conclusion of the game an incident where the melee has taken place. This will include the quarter and the position on the field where the melee took place. Penalties for melees during home and away season include fines ranging from \$140 to \$280. All melees occurring during EFL finals games will be referred directly to the Board for consideration with regard to penalty.

We ask clubs to remind players that where incidents occur in games, umpires are there to manage such times, and that tribunal and investigation procedures are in place to further manage these incidents. Players should be reminded not to involve themselves in any melee type situation or risk personal penalties if the situation were to escalate as well as club fines.
