

Policy R2013-06.2: Referee Allocation Policy

Purpose:

To create a transparent policy creating some clarity around the allocation of Kilsyth referees. This policy refers to how rosters are completed and what justification is used to decide what Kilsyth referee is allocated to which fixtured game.

Director of Referees (DOR)

Policy:

Safety, referee performance and referee capabilities are of the utmost importance and will be taken into consideration with every appointment made.

The Referee Administrators will be responsible for all referee appointments under the guidance and supervision of the DOR.

Referees will be rostered to a maximum of three (3) consecutive domestic basketball games unless unavoidable due to rostering requirements. Referees will also be rostered to no more than five (5) games in a session unless unavoidable due to unforeseen circumstances.

All venues require an appropriate spread of experienced officials. Referees must expect that they may be rostered at any venue as required by Kilsyth Basketball. The Referee Administrators will make all best efforts to roster referees at the same venue in which they have playing or coaching commitments provided the information is accurately entered in the Referee Manager Program. On all occasions the Referee Administrators will endeavor to roster around player and coaching commitments.

The Referee Manager program shows warnings to the Referee Administrators about Kilsyth referees who may be playing in the same grade as the game the Referee Administrators may be attempting to roster the individual. Unless unavoidable Kilsyth referees will not be rostered to games that are the same grade to which they play or coach.

Kilsyth referees may be rostered to a game that they have an immediate family member or close friend participating. This should be adjusted by the Referee Supervisor on the session and the appropriate form filled out under the Roster Changes Policy. Referees must enter this immediate family member or friend's team in their own "playing/coaching" details in the Referee Manager program under the "COI" (Conflict of Interest) category to avoid further occurrences.

The Referee Administrators will make best efforts to ensure the experienced officials are spread across all games giving opportunity for these referees to educate the lesser experienced officials. Two referees will be rostered to every game unless circumstances result in this being unachievable.
