## Did you know the Parents, Officials & Coaching Staff have Code of Conducts?

The SEJ have some very sensible rules around how the adults supporting our players must behave. These rules are to safeguard your child/ren and the umpires (often children) from any ridicule, abuse or intimidation.

Disappointingly this year, **the SEJ have had more adults in front of the tribunal than children** – not a great example being set for our kids. With this in mind, we thought it a good time to remind everyone exactly what some of the key rules are.

- Parents/Officials/Coaching Staff **must not abuse the umpires** - under any circumstance - fines apply
- Parents/Officials/Coaching Staff **must not ridicule players** - under any circumstance - fines apply
- Parents/Officials/Coaching Staff (excluding Runners/Water Carriers) **must not enter the ground during play** - under any circumstance - fines apply
- **No Smoking** on the ground at any time
- **No pets on the ground on game day**

### SUPPORTERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Remember that you are there for the participants to enjoy the game.
- Encourage participation, but don't force it.
- Teach that enjoyment is more important than winning.
- Never ridicule mistakes or losses – supporters are there to support not downgrade.
- Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, umpires and spectators – physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- Recognise all volunteers who are giving up their valuable time.
- Never publicly criticise umpires – raise personal concerns with club officials in private.
- Do not use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability – you'll let down your family and yourself if you do – and many such comments are actually now illegal.



By registering your child with South East Juniors you have agreed to abide by these principles. You must support the Club in its undertakings and encourage the Club to take any necessary disciplinary actions including the suspension and banning where warranted of any players, parents and or spectators for repeated or serious breaches of these Codes of Conduct.
