**1. ANNOUNCEMENT:**

The Ravenshoe motorcycle Club Inc. , hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct a two day event being the **2013 Natural Terrain Motocross Milnes Farm** for Senior riders in Open, Lites, Veteran, Masters, Vintage, Evo, Trailbike & Women's classes and Junior riders in Junior Lites, Mini Lites, 65cc and 50cc Auto classes. The promotion is on behalf of and the Clubs and these clubs are here after referred to as the Promoters.

**2. JURISDICTION:**

- 2.1. The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling Queensland, who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Numbers as above and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia Senior and Junior National, Club and One Meeting Licences. **NB: Juniors must have current JCP Logbook to be eligible for a One Meeting Licence.** This event is restricted to **full financial members of Ravenshoe Motorcycle Club.**
- 2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any Final Instructions approved by Motorcycling Queensland.  
**BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.**

**3. ENTRIES:**

- 3.1. Entries open forthwith and the Early Bird discount applies only to entries received by close last mail **Wednesday 11 days before the event.**  
**Entries will be accepted on the day but Early Bird nominations are encouraged.**
- 3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Promoter, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling Queensland.
- 3.3. Only entries received on the official Entry Form with the correct fee will be accepted. No phone, email, fax entries will be accepted. **ENTRIES BY MAIL ONLY** and must be sent to the **Race Secretary**, PO Box 693 Ravenshoe Qld 4888, **PLEASE NOTE: ALL RIDERS MUST PROVIDE A VOLUNTEER ON RACE DAY FOR FLAG DUTIES, A LIST OF NAMES WILL BE KEPT AND YOU MAY BE CALLED UPON. NO VOLUNTEER AND YOUR RIDER WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM THE DAYS RACING!!**
- 3.4. Riders seeking **One Meeting Licence** must state on their nomination form that a **One Meeting Licence is required.**

**4. INSURANCE:**

- 4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 4.2. **AMBULANCE INSURANCE** is compulsory for licensees.
- 4.3. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**

**5. MEDICAL SERVICES: Medical Officers/QAS** will be in attendance from the start of practice until 15 minutes after the last race.

**6. ENTRY FEE/S (an Early Bird Discount of \$10 per entry applies if noms are received before cut off date)**

- 6.1. Senior \$60.00 one class \$10.00 per extra class  
Junior \$45.00 one class \$10.00 per extra class

- 6.2. Payment by Cheque or Money Order only (do not send cash).

## 10. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

- 10.1. To constitute a Class, the number of competitors entered and competing in each Class shall be six (6).
- 10.2. Should there be insufficient entries in any Class of Competition, the decision to run or cancel the Class, or to Combine and vary any awards and/or trophies, will be at the discretion of the promoter, subject to MQ approval.

## 11. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 11.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for MOTOCROSS Competition.
- 11.2. Multiple entry of the one Machine in the same Class of Competition is not permitted.
- 11.3. Change of rider or machine (not both) may be permitted if submitted in writing to the Clerk of Course and with the approval of the MA Steward at least ten (10) minutes prior to the start of the event in which the substitution is requested. Substitute rider must be eligible to compete ie already be entered for the meeting and be the correct grade or if not entered substitution must be made at machinery with a new entry form. Substitute machine must have passed machine examination, be eligible for the class and replace a machine that can not be reasonably repaired.
- 11.4. Helmets are mandatory. All persons including officials using any bike, trike or quad at an event must be wearing a properly secured helmet.

## 12. RIDING NUMBERS:

- 12.1. Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their **Registered MX Riding Number**, but the Promoter does reserve the right to allocate numbers at their discretion.
- 12.2. All Number Plates on all Machines **MUST** comply with the GCR's.
- 12.3. Note:- **Back numbers are compulsory for all Junior and Senior competitors.** Failure to wear a back number will result in a competitor being stopped from competing, until they comply. Back numbers that correspond to the machine number must be shown at machinery.

## 13. GRID/GATE POSITIONS N/A

14. **RIDERS BRIEFING:** A Riders Briefing will be held prior to the commencement of practice and **ALL Competitors MUST attend the Riders Briefing.** Riders Briefing is a NON Smoking Area.

## 15. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

- 15.1. All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.
- 15.2. If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors telephone the Drugs in Sport Hotline 1800 020506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prizemoney may be delayed at MQ's discretion until

the results of the tests are known.

16. **CODE OF CONDUCT:** All Competitors, Officials and Parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all Motorcycle Race Meetings. The CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and will be enforced.

**Depending on numbers some classes may be combined for practice or racing.**

**NB:** All bikes must go through machinery on Saturday or Sunday and must comply with GCR's.

18. **CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:** Natural Terrain MX Track.
19. **STARTS:** All starts are rubber band starts. A two minute board may be displayed and competitors must be ready to start after the two minutes as per GCR's . After this time a 15/5 second signal will be used with the gate dropping a minimum of 5 seconds after the 5 seconds board is displayed. Starts may not be delayed after the two minutes has expired. All rounds have minimum thirty (36) gates.
20. **RACING:** There will be a minimum of 6 minutes or 5 laps of practice offered. Race format will be as per paragraph eight (8). Practice is limited to 125% of the grid per group. Some classes can be combined provided the GCR's and the maximum number are not breached.
21. **NOISE:** As per GCRs (be prepared to replace exhaust systems that fail)
22. **SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:** Due to council noise requirements **ALL juniors must be back in their own camp by 8.30pm and all generators must be turned off at 10pm. Absolutely NO BIKES must be started at anytime before 9am or after 4pm ....there will be no exceptions to this rule and anyone found in breach of it will be removed from the venue. PLEASE CONSIDER THE FUTURE OF THIS EVENT**
- 22.1 The age of Junior competitors will be age as at 1<sup>st</sup> January. Competitors may choose to move up an age group after their birthday but can not take any points with them to the higher age group.
- 22.2 Depending on entries the Mini Lites classes, Lites classes & Open classes may be combined but scored separately.
- 22.3. Senior Women & Veteran & Masters classes may be combined but scored separately.
- 22.4. Support classes are for novice riders only.  
Senior riders who placed 1st-3rd in previous years Closed to Club Series must ride in the Championship class. If required riders may be re-graded prior to racing at the discretion of the Race Secretary. Support riders cannot compete in the Championship classes and Championship riders cannot compete in the support classes.
- 22.5 Guardianship forms- Riders 18 years & under must have a Guardianship form signed by their parents or guardians if not accompanied by them on the day of racing. If this form is not filled out & handed in at sign on, that rider will not be riding.

22.7 Nominations are to be sent to the **Race Secretary, PO Box 693 Ravenshoe Qld 4888.**

22.8 Presentation: All trophies will be handed out at the presentation at the conclusion of racing on Sunday.

22.9 **Please note that tear offs are not allowed at this event.**

22.10 Details of meeting results will be posted and updated on the MQ website ([www.mql.org.au](http://www.mql.org.au)) within 7 days of the round.

## CONTRACT TO PARTICIPATE IN NATURAL TERRAIN MX MILNES FARM 2013

**WARNING! THIS IS AN IMPORTANT DOCUMENT WHICH AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS, PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY AND DO NOT SIGN IT UNLESS YOU ARE SATISFIED YOU UNDERSTAND IT.**

1. I THE UNDERSIGNED (see below): [Insert Rides Name]

HEREBY AGREE with Motorcycling Australia Limited ("MA") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting" or the "Event") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

**2. DEFINITIONS** In this declaration:

- a) "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation;
- b) "Indemnitees" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
- c) "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
- d) "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA;
- e) "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity;
- f) "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

**3. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS**

I ACKNOWLEDGE that:

- a) motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
  - i) that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
  - ii) that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
  - iii) that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
  - iv) that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
  - v) that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events;
  - vi) that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
  - vii) that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured;
  - viii) that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA;
- b) the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
- c) to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law;
- d) have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

**4. WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)**

Under the provisions of the Fair Trading Act 1999 (Vic) several conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are:

- rendered with due care and skill;
- as fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and
- reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

Under section 32N of the Fair Trading Act 1999, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the Fair Trading Act 1999 if you are killed or injured because the services were not rendered with due care and skill or they were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

**NOTE:** The change to your rights, as set out in this form, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. "Gross

negligence" is defined in the Fair Trading (Recreational Services) Regulations 2004. For the purposes of the clause 3, "the Supplier" shall mean and include the Indemnitees.

**5. INDEMNITY AND RELEASE GIVEN TO ORGANISERS**

IN CONSIDERATION of the acceptance of me as a participant in the Meeting:

- a) I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND KEEP INDEMNIFIED to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnitees and each of them in the following manner:
  - i) that I participate in the meeting at my sole risk and responsibility;
  - ii) that I accept the Venue as it stands with all or any defects hidden or exposed;
  - iii) that I indemnify and hold harmless the Indemnitees, their respective servants, agents, officials and competitors against any actions, costs, losses or claims which may be made by me or on my behalf for or in respect of or arising out of my death or any injury loss or damage caused to me or my equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other manner whatsoever.
- b) I AGREE TO RELEASE to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnitees and each of them from all liability to me for any claim, loss, damage, cost or expense (whether arising under statute, from negligence, personal injury, psychological trauma, death, property damage or infringement of third party rights or otherwise) that arises as a result of any act, matter or thing done, permitted or omitted to be done by me or which is in any way connected with my presence at or involvement in the Event.
- c) The release and indemnity provided by me in this declaration is in addition to, and will not in any way limit the application of, the conditions of sale attaching to tickets, conditions of entry, conditions of credentials or any other applicable terms or conditions in respect of the Event.
- d) A term of this release and indemnity will not apply where the term contravenes the law of the relevant jurisdiction under which any legal action is legitimately taken however such terms are severable and do not invalidate the remaining terms.

**6. MEDICAL**

I declare that I am and must continue to be medically and physically fit and able to participate in the Meeting. I will immediately notify MA in writing via my SCB of any change to my fitness and ability to participate. I understand and accept the Indemnitees will continue to rely upon this declaration as evidence of my fitness and ability to participate. I acknowledge and agree that if required, the Indemnitees (or any of them) may arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation) for me. I authorise such actions being taken by the Indemnitees and agree to meet all costs associated with such action. I understand it is compulsory for me to have ambulance insurance in some form and I accept responsibility for the cost of ambulance transportation, ambulance cover and further agree to maintain ambulance cover during the term of my license / membership.

**7. PRIVACY**

I hereby consent to the collection of my personal information by the Promoter/Event Organiser, MA and the SCB in connection with my involvement at the Event and the use and disclosure of my personal information by Event Organiser, and MA to other agencies and officials associated with the Event for the purposes of conducting and managing the Event. I understand that I may gain access to my personal information held by contacting MA at 147 Montague St, South Melbourne, Victoria, 3205. I understand that if I do not provide the personal information requested above that I may not be permitted to participate in the Event.

**8. PERSONAL HEALTH INFORMATION**

I hereby agree with MA and the SCB that in consideration for my participation in the Event that MA and the SCB may receive, collect, store and use personal health information about me in the manner set out below:

- a) I ACKNOWLEDGE that:
  - i) If I am injured, become ill or die at or following the Event the party listed at Item 8 in Schedule 1 in addition to any hospital at which I am treated (together "my Carers") will have health related information about me in their possession, power and control relating to me which is subject to obligations imposed by the Privacy Act ("my Information") and the Privacy Act is intended to protect my personal information;
  - ii) MA and my SCB wish to collect my Information for purposes that include their risk management programs, evaluating and improving the safety of MA and SCB events and of the Meeting organisers and facility providers of MA / SCB permitted events, and generally to reduce the risks to persons engaged in motorcycle sport; and

- iii) It is reasonable for MA and my SCB to collect, store, use and disclose my Information in accordance with clause 11(a)(i) above and in the manner set out in clause 11(b).

**9. POLICIES AND REGULATIONS**

- a) I acknowledge, understand and agree that it is a condition of my participation in the Event that I agree to be bound by, and subject to, the rules, regulations and jurisdiction of MA as amended from time to time. Copies of all MA rules, policies and regulations are available by contacting the MA office.

Any participant infringing MA's policy or refusing a drug test may be disqualified or otherwise dealt with in accordance with the terms of the anti-doping policy.
