Dolphins 64 defeated Rovers 62

Dolphins ended a disappointing winter on a high, coming from behind at half-time to beat Rovers 64-62. Anthony Kimble capped a fine season with 28 points, while teammate Mikey Lesic contributed 19. Chris Eichler starred for Rovers with 26 points, while Josh Symons finished with 16.

Sharks 75 defeated CC Eagles 68
