



Club Person of the Year – Judge's Guidelines and Score Sheet

1. Judge's Guidelines

- a) <u>Conflict of Interest</u>: Where a judge believes there may be a conflict of interest due to the relationship (parent/child; husband/wife) between the judge and the nominee, the judge will pass all nominations for that person over to his/her fellow judges for assessment.
- b) <u>Assessment Criteria</u>: The testimonials must be assessed against the following criteria:
 - i. <u>Quality</u>: The quality of the testimonials accompanying each nomination will be the <u>primary reference</u> when deciding scores not just the number of nominations received for a particular nominee.
 - ii. <u>Definition Club Person of the Year (CPoY)</u>: A person, who during their time at the club, has been observed to have made an outstanding contribution to the development and sustainability of the club on and/or off the field.
- c) <u>CPoY Categories</u>: (i) Senior CPoY (over 18 yrs)and (ii) Junior CPoY (18 yrs and under)
