



Club Person of the Year – Judge’s Guidelines and Score Sheet

1. Judge’s Guidelines

- a) Conflict of Interest: Where a judge believes there may be a conflict of interest due to the relationship (parent/child; husband/wife) between the judge and the nominee, the judge will pass all nominations for that person over to his/her fellow judges for assessment.
 - b) Assessment Criteria: The testimonials must be assessed against the following criteria:
 - i. Quality: The quality of the testimonials accompanying each nomination will be the primary reference when deciding scores - not just the number of nominations received for a particular nominee.
 - ii. Definition - Club Person of the Year (CPoY): A person, who during their time at the club, has been observed to have made an outstanding contribution to the development and sustainability of the club on and/or off the field.
 - c) CPoY Categories: (i) Senior CPoY (over 18 yrs) and (ii) Junior CPoY (18 yrs and under)
