Players agree to:

- Cooperate with my coach, team members and opponents.
- Not arrive at the venue under the influence of drugs or alcohol nor will I consume drugs of alcohol at the games.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the game, regardless of their gender, ability or cultural background. (Vilification will not be tolerated under any circumstances).

- Not shout advice to players during the game.(The coach provides instructions to the players and your comments may be in contradiction to these guidelines).
- Not use bad language, nor will I harass players, coaches, officials or other spectators. (Parents that loudly harass the referee are embarrassing to the player and the team).
- Encourage my child to play within the rules and respect officials' and coaches' decisions – no matter what.
- Teach my child to respect the efforts of their opponents.
- Recognize and acknowledge all good play for both teams, not just my own child. Winning isn't everything !
- Not criticize the coach in front of my child. I will support the coach and stand behind his/her decisions.
- Not criticize or ridicule my child's performance after the game.
- Volunteer my services and help when asked by a coach or official.
- Not arrive at the venue under the influence of drugs or alcohol nor will I consume drugs or alcohol at games.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all people involved in the game, regardless of their gender, ability or cultural background. (Vilification will not be tolerated under any circumstances).
