Understand and play by the rules.

Respect referees and other officials. If you disagree with any decision, ruling or official call, speak to your coach at an appropriate time and allow the coach to make the decision about speaking with the game official at a reasonable time.

Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials and other players or deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent will not be tolerated. If you feel you are beginning to become agitated or frustrated then ask your coach to sub you off.

Work equally hard for yourself and your team. You and your team will benefit. Basketball is a team sport.

Be a good sport. Acknowledge good play whether it be by your team or the opposition.

Treat all players, on and off the court, as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player. Do not take personal issues onto the court.

Play for the enjoyment of it, and not just to please parents and coaches. Playing basketball should be fun! If you enjoy playing you will perform much better and derive more benefits from it.
