## **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES**

### **Under 13 and 15 Teams**

1. Run trials in accordance with WBC Representative Trial Procedures, trial dates booked for November 2-3 2013 (Cambridge High School).
2. Design a plan to prepare the team for the Easter Tournament.
3. Take team to Easter Tournament (if WBC is sending teams).
4. Consider a re-trial after Easter Tournament in accordance with WBC Representative Trial Procedures, to capture the few athletes not available for basketball until after Easter. The decision to re-trial is at the discretion of the appointed coaching staff.
5. Design a plan to prepare the team for the Premiership and National Tournaments.
6. Take team to Premiership and National Tournament (qualification dependent).
7. Arrange 30 hours of team practices eg: 15 weekly two hour practices or six camps of five hours each throughout the season.
8. Two weeks after the conclusion of the team's season, submit a report to the WBC.

### **Under 17 and 19 Teams**

1. Run trials in accordance with WBC Representative Trial Procedures, trial dates booked for November 2-3 2013. (Cambridge High School).
2. Design a plan to prepare the team for the Easter Tournament, Premiership and National tournaments.
3. Arrange 30 hours of team practices eg: 15 weekly two hour practices or six camps of five hours each throughout season.
4. Two weeks after the conclusion of the team's season, submit a report to the WBC.

### **Under 23 Teams**

1. Run trials in accordance with WBC Representative Trial Procedures. Accessing this population of athletes has been most successful when trials have been held at the end of the current season, and again at the beginning of the University year the following year. This allowed students new to the area attending tertiary learning institutions to have access to this level of basketball and significantly improved the numbers available for this age group.
2. Design a plan to prepare the team for the National tournament.

All coaches will be asked to enter into a formal coaching agreement with WBC on acceptance of their position and be expected to take part in a formal evaluation process at the end of the agreement period.
