The abovementioned meeting has been authorized by Motorcycling Queensland (MQ) who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number (as per permit and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National, Club, Mini and One Meeting Licences (OML to junior riders if they hold a current JCP Log Book, who are full financial members of the Promoting Club (no discount or one day memberships are allowed).
- The meeting will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any Final Instructions approved by MQ.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS

2.3. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport General Competition Rules (GCR's) these Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions approved by Motorcycling Queensland.

9. AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

Trophies will be awarded to 1st to 3rd place for each competition class.

Medals will be awarded to each 50cc Auto demo participant and novice classes.

10. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

- 10.1. To constitute a Class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each Class shall be 10
- 10.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any Class of Competition, the decision to run or cancel the Class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards, will be at the discretion of the club, subject to MQ approval.

11. RACE FORMAT: 3 Rounds

3 Rounds; 4 laps 50cc Div. 1, 4 laps 50cc Div. 2, 7 laps 65cc/mini lites/vets & women's/trail/unlimited/junior lites/senior lites/ open champs. We reserve the right to add 2 rounds of 15 minute moto's in place of the 7 laps for the unlimited class should the numbers warrant it on the day.

12. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 12.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for **Motocross** Competition.
- 12.2. Multiple entry of the one Machine in the same Class of Competition is not permitted.
- 12.3. Change of Machine during competition may be permitted if submitted in writing to the clerk of course via the race secretary and approved at least ten minutes prior to the start of the event in which the substitution is requested. Substitute machines must have already have been entered for the meeting and passed scrutineering.
- 12.4 Helmets must be worn by persons using any bike, trike or quad at an event.

13. RIDING NUMBERS:

- 13.1. Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their Registered Riding Number. All others will be allocated numbers at the Club's discretion.
- 13.2. All Number Plates on all Machines MUST comply with the GCR's.

14. GRID POSITIONS:

Announced at Riders Briefing

15. RIDERS BRIEFING:

A Riders Briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing and ALL Competitors MUST attend the Riders Briefing. Riders Briefing is a NON Smoking Area.

16. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

- 16.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with the Australian Sports Drug Agency policy.
- 16.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors telephone the Drugs in Sport Hotline 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prizemoney may be delayed at the Motorcycling Queensland's discretion until the results of the tests are known.

When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed at MQ discretion until the results of the tests are known

17. CODE OF CONDUCT

All Competitors, Officials and Parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law – CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all Motorcycle Race Meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

19. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

Medium to hard packed surface with man-made obstacles.

20. STARTS:

31 backward falling gates

21. RACING:

Practice will be 3 laps for seniors and juniors and some classes may be combined.

The maximum number of riders to practice will be 125% of the number of start gates
4 laps 50cc Div1, 4 laps 50cc Div 2, 7 laps 65cc/mini lites/vets & womens/trail/unlimited, 7 laps junior lites/senior lites/open champs. 2 rounds of 15 minute moto's to replace of 7 laps if numbers and time permits.

22. SOUND TESTING:

Random Noise Testing will be conducted as per current GCRs. All machines must comply with the current MOM's for Sound emissions. Testing may be undertaken at any time throughout the event. Penalties or exclusions may be applied for machines which do not comply. It is suggested that all competitors be prepared to adjust/replace exhausts systems that do not comply.

23. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- **23.1.** 4 OUT OF 5 ROUNDS WITHIN THE SERIES MUST BE COMPLETED FOR THE CLUB TO HOLD ANNUAL END OF YEAR PRESENTATION.
- 23.2 CANTEEN WITH HOT FOOD AND COLD DRINKS AVAILABLE. CAMPING AVAIL ON SATURDAY NIGHT.

HEREBY AGREE with Motorcycling Australia Limited ("MA") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting" or the "Event") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms

and conditions set out in this document. 2. DEFINITIONS In this declaration:

1. I THE UNDERSIGNED (see below):

- "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation;
- "Indemnitees" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
- "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
- "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA;
- "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity;
- "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

3. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS

I ACKNOWLEDGE that:

- motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
- that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
- that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed; that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
- that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability;
- that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events:
- that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
- that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport vii) of me if I am injured;
- that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and
- within the rules and regulations of MA; the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
- to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law;
- have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.

4. WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC) Under the provisions of the Fair Trading Act 1999 (Vic) several

conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are: rendered with due care and skill;

- as fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and
- reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

Under section 32N of the Fair Trading Act 1999, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the Fair Trading Act 1999 if you are killed or injured because the services were not rendered with due care and skill or they were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form. NOTE: The change to your rights, as set out in this form, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. "Gross negligence" is defined in the Fair Trading (Recreational Services) Regulations 2004.

For the purposes of the clause 3, "the Supplier" shall mean and include the Indemnitees.

5. INDEMNITY AND RELEASE GIVEN TO ORGANISERS

- I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND KEEP INDEMNIFIED to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnitees and each of them in the following
- that I participate in the meeting at my sole risk and responsibility;
- ii) that I accept the Venue as it stands with all or any defects hidden or exposed:
- that I indemnify and hold harmless the Indemnitees, their respective servants, agents, officials and competitors against any actions, costs, losses or claims which may be made by me or on my behalf for or in respect of or arising out of my death or any injury loss or damage caused to me or my equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other manner whatsoever.

I understand and accept the Indemnitees will continue to rely upon this declaration as evidence of my fitness and ability to participate.

I acknowledge and agree that if required, the Indemnitees (or any of them) may arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation) for me. I authorise such actions being taken by the Indemnitees and agree to meet all costs associated with such action. I understand it is compulsory for me to have ambulance insurance in some form and I accept responsibility for the cost of ambulance transportation, ambulance cover and further agree to maintain ambulance cover during the term of my license / membership.

7. PRIVACY
