## 12.0 **PERMITS**

- 12.1 A player may be granted a permit to play with another club providing their club does not have a team competing in the same junior or senior division. Except in Division One (1) where players will be granted a permit to a club even if their club has a team in that competition.
- 12.2 An underage player granted a permit may only represent one senior club and one junior club. A senior player may only represent one club.
  - 12.2.1 Permits must be renewed each and every season.
- 12.3 A player is only able to be permitted to another club for a maximum of two (2) seasons.
