The Senior Coach is also responsible for delivering game day coaching along with leading assistant coaches in the delivery of the game plan.	
Overview of Role	The Seniors Coach will lead a team of volunteers to deliver a professional, equitable and rewarding experience to all participants in the squad. As Senior Coach you will be required to work directly with the AFL Sydney Football Operations Manager, have exceptional leadership skills and an excellent knowledge of AFL Sydney.

## Assist in developing a program for the AFL Sydney Representative squads from selection date through to the match including the requirements outlined by the AFL Sydney Football **Operations Manager** Communicate with clubs and players in respect to player form, injuries, availability etc Attend the AFL Sydney v AFL Canberra match on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2014 in Canberra Job/Task Profile Assist the AFL Sydney Football Operations Manager in the appointment of a selection panel to attend AFL Sydney matches Assist in the appointment of support staff and squad coaches as required in conjunction with the AFL Sydney Football Operations Manager Communicate all training dates, locations and times in a suitable and timely manner to ensure maximum attendance Agree to and adhere to the coaches code of conduct as supplied by AFL NSW/ACT Develop a player itinerary for the match including travel to and from Canberra by working closely with the Team Manager and other staff as required for distribution prior to departure Manage and develop all game day plans working with the Assistant Coaches and Team Manager including team recovery sessions, group feedback sessions etc Mandatory Level 1 Coaching Qualification **Key Selection Criteria** Senior coaching experience Demonstrated personal initiative and ability to work effectively unsupervised. Demonstrated attention to detail Well developed verbal and written communication, interpersonal, presentation, and negotiation skills Desirable Intimate knowledge of AFL Sydney Level 2 Coaching Qualification Availability The following is a list of the expectations of the Senior Coach. Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> June – travel to and from Canberra for the match Expectations Set, coordinate and attend squad training sessions on the three Wednesday nights prior to the match Possible training camp on weekend of 24<sup>th</sup> / 25<sup>th</sup> May (AFL Sydney Wet Weather Round). Final details TBC in conjunction with appointed coaching staff Various weekends and evenings as required to attend selection meetings as well as AFL Sydney matches to assist with selections Provide regular feedback to players and AFL Sydney Club Coaches on expectations and performance
