(Order of Australia Medal) on Australia Day, 26th February 2014, in recognition of his service to the local community and to fencing since he immigrated to Australia as a young man. A reception morning tea was held at Fioretto Fencing Club, his pride and joy, on the 15th of March to celebrate his achievement. Guests included federal MP Anna Burke, Bill Pontikis (Monash Council) and Simon Auty (President of Fencing Victoria), with many other apologies and letters sent in. Most importantly Maestro's children and grandchildren were all there to share the moment with him.

Many people had kind words to share about their relationship with Maestro in the many years around the local community. We heard from Bill Pontikis, a local business owner when he met Maestro, now councilor with Monash City, Damon Fowler (a coach & member of Fioretto) spoke about the impact Maestro has had on his life and that of his family, and most importantly Maestro's grandchild, lead by his daughter, Lisa, all got up to say a few words, or in the youngest one's case, present him with their own version of the OAM ahead of the official presentation on the Queen's Birthday.
