Welcome to season 2014



WELCOME to what shapes as the most fascinating, exciting and anticipated Peter Jackson VFL season we've witnessed in many years.

In many ways it is a back to the future journey with traditional clubs Coburg, Footscray, Richmond and Williamstown all entering the 2014 season as stand-alone entities.

And, it paves the way for some games to once again be played at spiritual grounds like the Whitten Oval and Punt Road. Further facility development work that the respective clubs are committed to will result in more games being played at these venues in future years.

If possible the Peter Jackson VFL is even more unique than ever before with a 16-team competition with five stand-alone VFL clubs, five stand-alone AFL teams and six VFL clubs with either full or partial alignments with AFL clubs.

Such an increase in clubs provides even more opportunities for young Victorians to play at a level that is the best outside the AFL.

It can only be viewed as a massive positive for the game and those players who aspire to not only test themselves at the highest level they possibly can, but also take their game to the AFL competition's elite level. Importantly, the VFL also serves as the perfect competition for the listed players of AFL clubs to develop.

There are currently more than 800 players on AFL club lists; nearly 400 of these were recruited directly from the TAC Cup and VFL competitions.

Breaking down those impressive numbers even further reveals that 345 were directly taken in various forms of the Draft from the TAC Cup with 47 from the VFL.

It is a resounding endorsement of these two competitions and also the contribution of the many community football leagues, clubs and volunteers that work so hard to maintain and carry the game. The Victorian football network is such a critical part of the supply chain for the AFL.

Last year, 38 players were selected by AFL Clubs from the TAC Cup competition, a further eight players were chosen from Peter Jackson VFL Clubs. Nearly 50% of the new players drafted or rookie listed by AFL Clubs last year originated from Victoria.

Certainly, AFL Victoria is delighted that Peter Jackson Melbourne is once again the naming rights partner of the VFL and the Toyota Victorian Dealers return as a premier partner along with Dairy Australia, who not only support the VFL finals with their Legendairy campaign, but also AFL Victoria's U18 Metro and Country Academies.

ABC TV will again provide its excellent coverage of the match-of-the round each Saturday afternoon in a telecast which continually reaches new heights and generates the much needed exposure that the VFL needs.

On Saturday at Visy Park a triple-header involving representative teams from the Essendon District Football League, Eastern Football League, the Victorian Amateur Football Association, Southern Football League, Northern Football League and Western Region Football League will be conducted.

From those games a team representing the Victorian metropolitan clubs, to be coached by Brian Royal, will play a Victorian country representative team, coached by Peter Knights in July.

Season 2014 offers so much on so many fronts across Victoria. Enjoy what promises to be a truly memorable season.

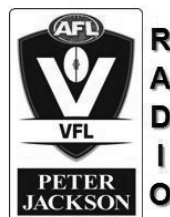

PETER JACKSON VFL SEASON PREVIEW

It is a season where there is now 16 clubs with Footscray and Richmond joining Collingwood, Essendon and Geelong as stand-alone AFL clubs while Coburg and Williamstown join Bendigo, Frankston and Port Melbourne as stand-alone VFL clubs.

Matches played for premiership points will return for the first time in a long time to Punt Road and Whitten Oval, two traditional and famous venues.

There's a veritable army of players either joining or re-joining the competition, some in familiar, some in different guernseys.

And, there's a host of new coaches, again some familiar to the competition, others launching their VFL careers.

It all makes for a season like one we have not witnessed before.

Here is a snapshot of each club, its additions and departures and how the season may unfold.





BENDIGO GOLD

Overview: Ascension is the only acceptable way for Bendigo following a horrific season, which not only saw them lose all 18 games, but a third of the games were by 100-points plus and in its last match Geelong inflicted a 200-plus point defeat. Certainly, the first thing coach Aussie Jones will be searching for is that the Gold is at least competitive – last year its average losing margin was 100-points. What will help Bendigo in that regard is that all those who remained of the list will have a VFL season behind them and now will have experienced two VFL preseasons. That will be a plus, so will the addition of Messrs McFarlane, Sketcher, Wallin and Redfern who have all played State league football. Bendigo needs to earn the respect of the league and that's something that rests squarely with them.

Certainly, Box Hill Hawks enjoy the best working relationship of any of the aligned clubs and that will make it easier for new coach Marco Bello, who knows how the culture of the club operates having played and been on the Box Hill Hawks coaching staff. Expect Box Hill Hawks to again occupy the upper rungs of the ladder.

Overview: Casey Scorpions were again engulfed by a Ground Hog day-like feeling once the finals began. For the fourth successive season, the Scorpions earned a top four finish at the end of the home and away season, but were bundled out in straight sets. It took Casey's losing streak in finals to 10 and that doesn't do a whole lot for the club or the player's mojo. Casey lost a bunch of experience, headed by former captain Kyle Matthew, Danny Nichols and Luke Tynan and won't have the year round services of Melbourne phenom Jesse Hogan. It has placed all its recruiting stock in youngsters with TAC Cup backgrounds and surrounding leagues. Once again, Casey will rely heavily on the Melbourne list to make it back to the finals for the eighth consecutive season.

Overview: The Lion is back at City Oval (or Piranha Park as it is now called), but just how loud will we hear it roar? For the first time in more than a decade Coburg enters a VFL season as its own entity and while that presents the faithful with a warm and fuzzy feeling how will it equate to wins and a far loftier position on the ladder than has been the case in recent years? With Richmond as its affiliate, Coburg Tigers last made the finals in 2008 and now without the AFL Tigers to bolster their ranks they have to go it alone. One plus is that new coach Peter German is no stranger to the VFL. In fact, German has coached first Casey and then Williamstown to the finals in each of the past five years. He'll rely on the influx of an army of young players from the TAC Cup and local suburban competitions. It shapes as a tough challenge for all concerned at Coburg.

The VFL Magpies should again win more games than they lose and that should be enough for them to again play finals.

At its best Essendon will prove formidable, especially at Windy Hill, but they have to cover some big losses and the competition is also far stronger.

Overview: Geelong must still be wondering what happened in the day that mattered most in September. After dominating the home and away season and for that matter the lead-in finals, the VFL Cats were devoured by the VFL Hawks in the Grand Final. It was a sobering end to a season that had been so outstanding. During the off-season, Geelong has made significant changes to its list with last year's captain Troy Selwood retiring, Jaxson Barham travelling overseas and then losing Ben Raidme to a season-ending injury. Once again, Geelong has cherry-picked talent from the strong Geelong Football League to top up its VFL list and strong AFL list. It is hard to imagine Geelong could be as powerful as it was last season, but that is not to say that it won't again find itself among the leaders in the competition.

Overview: North Ballarat enters a historic year with coach Gerard FitzGerald set to break the VFA/VFL record for the longest serving coach before the season reaches the half-way mark. The Roosters certainly have something to crow about with such an extraordinary accomplishment, but its on-field success is questionable. How does North Ballarat cover the loss of arguably its best two players –Myles Sewell and Stephen Clifton, both Liston Trophy winners, premiership players and 100-game players? If that's not daunting enough, the Roosters will also be without Billy Driscoll its most dangerous forward. While Nick Peters returns and they've picked up some young TAC Cup talent, North Ballarat, even with its partial alignment with North Melbourne, have struggled against top-of-the-table clubs in recent years and that's resulted in them finishing outside the eight the past two seasons.

Overview: Certainly a changing of the guard down at the Borough where members remaining from its historic 2011 season is now down to single digits. Port Melbourne farewelled dual 'Frosty' Miller medallist Dean Galea, ruckman Wayde Skipper and premiership players Billy Burstin, Nathan Batsanis and Michael Dillon. More than 500 VFL games depart with that quintet while Johnstone was also an 80 game player. While it leaves a Grand Canyon-like void, Port Melbourne secured a bevy of ex-AFL players headed by James Magner who is a ball magnet and has dominated previously at this level. So, too Marcus Marigliani, who brings experience, class and leadership. Chris Michaliades represented the VFL last year; there's never been a knock on Daniel Connors ability and Tynan, Davies and Browne are all good acquisitions. Although the Borough made the finals last year there was a vast discrepancy between its best and worst. Maybe the arrival of so many new and quality players will take Port Melbourne back up the ladder.
