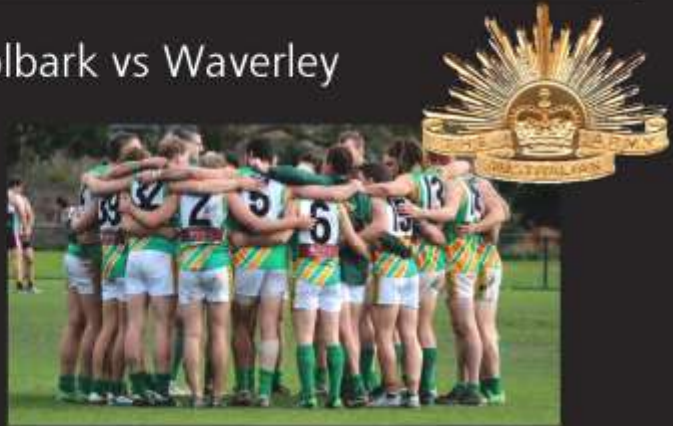

U.K. wont stop Georgiou still getting a kick . . .

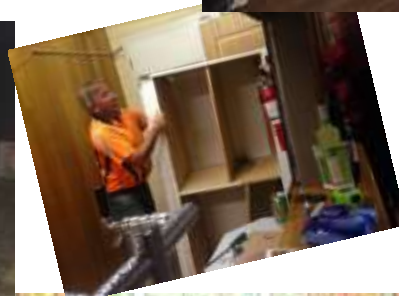

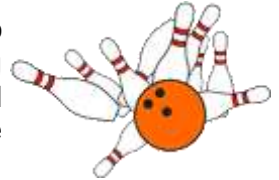


### Old Boilers (Bowlers)
