End of Financial Year Advice

The end of the financial year is fast approaching. In preparation you should consider the following tax planning measures to help optimise your tax position in 2014:

- Ensure that all superannuation contributions

owing on behalf of employees are paid by 30 June 2014. Unpaid superannuation at 30 June 2014 are not deductible in this financial year.

- Pay any bonuses due to staff prior to 30 June 2014.

- Review debtors listings to recognise any bad debts which need to be written off.

- Bring forward any repairs and maintenance work which will be required in the foreseeable future.

- Write off or physically dispose of obsolete trading stock.

- Review your plant and equipment listing and identify any items which need to be written off or physically disposed of.

- Bring forward the purchase of non-perishable consumables.

- Make planned donations to tax deductible charities before 30 June 2014.

- For business owners not receiving employment income from any other source, consider grossing up wages to a maximum of \$80,000 each (including tax). Please note that PAYG Withholding of \$18,800 needs to be remitted to the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) to cover a gross wage of \$80,000. See Kingy for advice.
