

COACH CONTACT INFORMATION & WET WEATHER

Full contact details (mobile number & E-Mail) for all Hill Top Soccer Team's coaches is now available on the 'Coaches & Wet Weather' Tab in the main menu of the website. Please take the advice of your coach as the *single source of truth* for all game related matters. Also please keep in mind that circumstances for one team can be very-different for another team, so do-not pass your coaches information onto a player in another team – For Example, it might be raining in Bundanoon and your game is 'off', but sunny and dry in Yerrinbool where another Hill Top team is playing who's game is still 'on'.



SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY

Most members would be aware of the recent article on the club's website, outlining details of a new Social Media Policy which was introduced following the club's committee meeting on 17 March. To recap, the new policy was introduced as a measure to protect the club and its members, following some unfortunate comments published recently in social media forums (primarily Facebook) which left the club and its committee potentially liable for those same comments. To clarify the intent of the new social media policy, it's important to be mindful of the following key messages –

- The club *only* endorses information published on the official website and in this (Kookaburra Squawk) newsletter
- Comments or opinions published by members about the club, it's officials, or fellow members in any social media forum is *not* endorsed by the club
- Members who choose not to follow point 2 (and publish comments in forums about the club, officials, or members) leave themselves liable to potential expulsion from the club if the breach is deemed to be significant

UPGRADES AT BORONIA PARK

New Storage Facility & Road Diversion Update

Further to our article in the previous issue, Wingecarribee Shire Council (as Trust Manager for Boronia Sportsground) was approved \$40,000 in state government funding via the Department of Trade and Investment Crown Lands - Public Reserves Management Fund Program (PRMFP).

The purpose of the grant is to provide a permanent maintenance storage facility as a replacement for the existing shipping containers. It is hoped that the securing of this grant will allow Council to leverage additional Council funds to provide additional roadwork's to upgrade the Carpark area, and relocate the existing access road to run behind the current amenities (canteen) building.

Joshua Patterson, Council's Recreation Planner, offers that "The securing of this grant is a great result for the user groups and broader Hill Top community, and follows on from the hard work shown by the Hill Top Soccer Club. The removal of the existing shipping container's and provision of a purpose built triple storage building will greatly enhance the general amenity, while the relocation of the access road will remove the considerable risks associated with vehicle movement through the sportsground"

HTSC president Mark Johnson was pleased with the outcome, noting "The club is happy to finally see the start of works after a slow and lengthy battle with regulation, and would like to thank Josh Patterson from the council for simplifying & speeding up the process. Hopefully works will now proceed quickly on all stages of works".
