The FAR NORTH QLD MOTORCYCLE Clubs, listed above hereafter called the PROMOTERS will conduct a Interclub Series of 4 rounds being the FNQ Interclub Development Motocross Series for Seniors riders Lites, Open, Vets & Women's classes and Junior riders in Junior Lites, Mini Lites, 65cc & 50cc classes. The promotion is on behalf of the clubs whom are here after referred to as the promoters.

JURISDICTION:

- The abovementioned series has been authorised by MQ who have issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Numbers (as listed above and 2.1. is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National, Club, Nipper and One Meeting Licences (OML) to junior riders if they hold a current JCP Log Book), who are full financial members of one of the Promoting Clubs (no discount or one day memberships are allowed).
- 2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current Manual of Motorcycle Sport General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any Final Instructions approved by MQ.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

- 3.1. Entries open forthwith and will be accepted up until the Monday 7 days prior to the event. Pre nominations are required for each event, so that Coaching can be selected & these riders can be notified so they can be at the track on the Saturday & Volunteer Roster can be drawn up and posted at sign on. You will be required to include your payment with the Nomination forms, however you will be required to sign in on the day. You will check the Volunteer Roster and record when your volunteer is required. - No Volunteer No Ride Entries will be accepted by Post, Hand delivery, Fax & Email. - 3.2. In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Club, if such retention is approved by MQ.

12 MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 12.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for *Motocross* Competition.
- 12.2. Multiple entry of the one Machine in the same Class of Competition is not permitted.
- 12.3. Change of Machine will be allowed during the competition as per the current GCR's. Change of machine must be submitted in writing.
- 12.4 Helmets are mandatory. All persons including officials using any bike, trike or quad at an event must be wearing a properly secured helmet.

13 RIDING NUMBERS:

- 13.1. Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their Registered Riding Number. All others will be allocated numbers at the Club's discretion. National licence holders have precedence over club licence holders when it comes to number allocation.
- 13.2. All Number Plates on all Machines MUST comply with the GCR's.
- 13.3 **Back Numbers: all competitors must wear** a legible numbers on their back in contrasting colours. Any rider that does not display an approved back number whilst competing MAY NOT be awarded points for that race.

14 GRID POSITIONS: Peg Draw

15 RIDERS BRIEFING:

A Riders Briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing and ALL Competitors MUST attend the Riders Briefing. Riders Briefing is a NON Smoking area.

16 DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

- All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency.
- 16.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors telephone the Drugs in Sport Hotline 1800 020506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prizemoney may be delayed at MQ discretion until the results of the tests are known.

17 CODE OF CONDUCT:

All Competitors, Officials and Parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia By-Law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all Motorcycle Race Meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

Random Sound Testing will be conducted as per current GCRs. All machines must comply with the current MOM's for Sound emissions. Testing may be undertaken at any time throughout the event. Penalties or exclusions may be applied for machines which do not comply. It is suggested that all competitors be prepared to adjust/replace exhausts systems that do not comply.

24. GUARDIANSHIP FORMS

Riders18 years and under must have a guardianship form signed by their parents or guardians if not accompanied by them on the day of racing. If this form is not filled out and handed in at sign on, that rider will not be riding - no exceptions

25. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- 25.1 GST: The Goods and Services Tax affect the payment of prize money. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 48.5% of prize money over \$ 50.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure full amount is paid to you.
- 25.2 The Series Race secretary will receive from the promoters for each round \$ 5.00 per rider for all riders competing.
- 25.3 The age of junior competitors will be aged as at 1st January. Competitors may choose to move up an age group after their birthday but cannot take any points with them to the higher age group.
- 25.4 Depending on entries, some junior classes may be combined but scored separately.
- 25.5 Chain classes are for Novice (Beginners class) riders only. Riders who placed 1st to 3rd in the previous year's Series or closed to Club series must ride in the Axle Grade class. If required, riders may be moved to Axle class prior to racing at discretion of the Race Secretary in conjunction with the promoting clubs. This will be assessed by level of experience and ability.
- 25.6 Series Nominations are encouraged and only 1 entry form is required. If nominating rounds individually, separate entries will need to be filled in for the respective rounds. NO nominations will be accepted less than 7 days prior to each round.
- 25.7 Verification **of conditions of refunds/Transfers:** Transfers/Refunds of riders not able to attend can be made if Race Secretary is notified by the Wednesday before the event. After this it is up to the discretion of the promoting clubs on the day. If no notification at all is given to the race secretary, no refund will be given.
- 25.8 250cc 2/ can only be ridden in senior lites class NOT in open class
- 25.9 Presentation will take place under Club house/canteen after racing & scoring is complete.
- 25.10 3 Rounds of the 4 round series must be run to be eligible for the overall trophy Presentation.
- 25.11 Canteen facilities have food and drinks available. Hot and cold shower facilities as well as camping available.
- 25.12 Coaching for the series: Glenn Macdonald of MACA Coaching has made a huge commitment to Far North Qld riders Development. This is a very unique opportunity to have one of Australia's most successful coaches guide your riders development throughout a full race series. Places are limited. Early Bird discount of \$15.00 per round on series coaching if booked & paid by the 24th May. This is fantastic! Glenn Macdonald will be coaching on the Saturday of each round for \$65.00 per rider. CONTRACT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FNQ Interclub Development Series 2014

WARNING! THIS IS AN IMPORTANT DOCUMENT WHICH AFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS, PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY AND DO NOT SIGN IT UNLESS YOU ARE SATISFIED YOU UNDERSTAND IT.

1. I THE UNDERSIGNED (see below):

HEREBY AGREE with Motorcycling Australia Limited ("MA") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting" or the "Event") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document.

2. DEFINITIONS In this declaration:

- "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation;
- "Indemnitees" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1. "MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
- "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA;
- "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity:
- "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

3. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS

I ACKNOWLEDGE that:

- motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
- that I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed
- that my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
- that competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
- that track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability; that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents
- or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events; that any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or
- mental health may be voided;
- that there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if I am injured; vii)
- that I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA:
- the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
- to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law:
- have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event

4. WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)

- Under the provisions of the Fair Trading Act 1999 (Vic) several conditions are implied into contracts for the supply of certain goods and services. These conditions mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you are: rendered with due care and skill;
- as fit for the purpose for which they are commonly bought as it is reasonable to expect in the circumstances; and
- reasonably fit for any particular purpose or might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

Under section 32N of the Fair Trading Act 1999, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these conditions do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the Fair Trading Act 1999 if you are killed or injured because the services were not rendered with due care and skill or they were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form. NOTE: The change to your rights, as set out in this form, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the

supplier's part. "Gross negligence" is defined in the Fair Trading (Recreational Services) Regulations 2004.

- I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND KEEP INDEMNIFIED to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnitees and each of them in the following manner:
- that I participate in the meeting at my sole risk and responsibility;
- that I accept the Venue as it stands with all or any defects hidden or exposed:
- that I indemnify and hold harmless the Indemnitees, their respective servants, agents, officials and competitors against any actions. costs, losses or claims which may be made by me or on my behalf for or in respect of or arising out of my death or any injury loss or damage caused to me or my equipment whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other manner whatsoever.
- I AGREE TO RELEASE to the full extent permitted by law the Indemnitees and each of them from all liability to me for any claim, loss, damage, cost or expense (whether arising under statute, from negligence, personal injury, psychological trauma, death, property damage or infringement of third party rights or otherwise) that arises as a result of any act, matter or thing done, permitted or omitted to be done by me or which is in any way connected with my presence at or involvement in the Event.
- The release and indemnity provided by me in this declaration is in addition to, and will not in any way limit the application of, the conditions of sale attaching to tickets, conditions of entry, conditions of credentials or any other applicable terms or conditions in respect of the Event.
- A term of this release and indemnity will not apply where the term contravenes the law of the relevant jurisdiction under which any legal action is legitimately taken however such terms are severable and do not invalidate the remaining terms.

I will immediately notify MA in writing via my SCB of any change to my fitness and ability to participate. I understand and accept the Indemnitees will continue to rely upon this declaration as evidence of my fitness and ability to participate.

acknowledge and agree that if required, the Indemnitees (or any of them) may arrange medical or hospital treatment (including ambulance transportation) for me. I authorise such actions being taken by the Indemnitees and agree to meet all costs associated with such action. I understand it is compulsory for me to have ambulance insurance in some form and I accept responsibility for the cost of ambulance transportation, ambulance cover and further agree to maintain ambulance cover during the term of my license / membership.

7. PRIVACY

Promoter/Event Organiser, MA and the SCB in connection with my involvement at the Event and the use and disclosure of my personal information by Event Organiser, and MA to other agencies and officials associated with the Event for the purposes of conducting and managing the Event.
