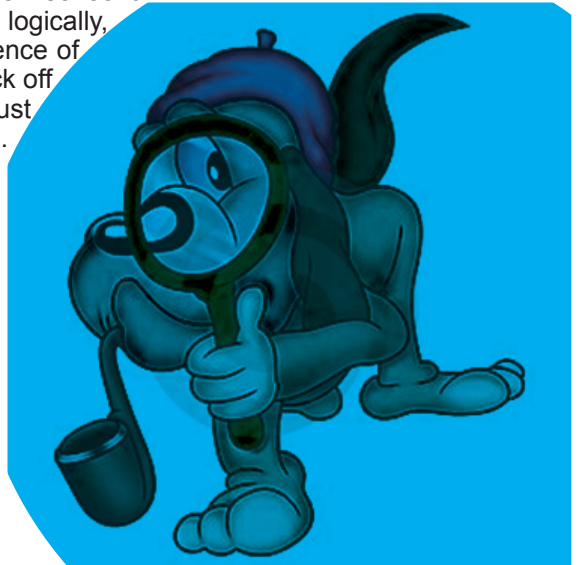
On Friday there was enough bacon to feed 40 blokes, or one rather hungry hound, but come Saturday morning there was no bacon for breakfast.
