# The best of the VFL and TAC Cup on display



**State representative football has been a rivalry, a tradition and a highlight for a long time.**

The first representative match the VFA played against South Australia, its long-standing foe, dates back to 1905 when Punt Road hosted the very first match against these two passionate football States.

While the regularity of State matches has fluctuated over time it still remains an eagerly anticipated fixture, particularly for the players fortunate enough to be selected.

Next week when the Peter Jackson VFL hosts the SANFL at Port Melbourne, the first meeting between the two fiercest of State rivals since 2008.

Apart from the intense competitiveness between States, representative football offers players and fans much more than bragging rights.

Firstly, it allows players an opportunity to challenge themselves against their peers at, what for some, is the highest level the game offers them.

It's also unique to State League football as the traditional representative matches are currently not part of the AFL calendar, primarily due to its development into a national competition.

Significantly, it also offers aspiring players the chance to impress AFL club recruiting scouts who will scrutinise the match as part of their preparation for the 2014 NAB AFL Drafts.

Included among the VFL team that played against WAFL last year and Tasmania the year before were Sam Lloyd, Sam Dwyer, Brett Goodes, Kyle Martin, Kyle Hartigan, Ben Ross, Leigh Osborne and Dean Towers who were all subsequently drafted by AFL clubs.

And, when the VFL last played the SANFL, Robin Nahas, who is closing in on 100 AFL games, represented the VFL.

While the final VFL squad is yet to be finalised, coach Damien Carroll and selectors have many talented VFL listed players at their disposal to ensure that the VFL team represents themselves, the competition and the State in the best possible manner.

It's a great chance for all VFL and football fans to support the

competition by attending the match at Port Melbourne.

Last weekend Vic Country began the NAB AFL U18 Championships with a win over rival Vic Metro, with the best talent from AFL Victoria's TAC Cup competition on show. The Championships are a great opportunity for these players to test themselves on the national stage, against the best talent from other states. Next weekend both sides head interstate for round 2.

Next weekend also features the celebration of Indigenous Round, highlighted by the Dream Time game at the 'G'.

As a precursor to what is an undoubted highlight of the football calendar, Richmond and Essendon's VFL teams will play a match at Punt Road.

It will feature the respective clubs entering the ground with students from the REAL program (delivered at the KGI at Punt Road) followed by a welcome ceremony conducted by Auntie Joy Murphy and then the Diddgeridoo played over the loud speakers before the game begins.

At half time there will be an opportunity for fans to try Marngrook.

The Sir Doug Nicholls Award, voted on by the respective coaches, will be awarded at a post-match ceremony. It will be presented by Auntie Pam, a daughter of Sir Doug.

Victorian football has much to celebrate on many fronts next weekend.

Just finally on a sad note, the football community lost one of its own last week with the passing of legendary Richmond premiership coach Tom Hafey. Tom left a mark on all that he came in contact with and will remain in the memories of many football fans, be it from his coaching or appearances at 100's of club training nights over the years, imparting his knowledge. His passion for the game will be missed. Our condolences to the Hafey family from AFL Victoria.

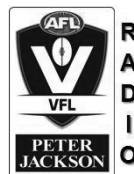

# Wormald reaches 100 game milestone

**If you think Sam Wormald has seemingly been at Chirnside Park forever, you're not alone in that view.**

It's one that Wormald also subscribes to. "It feels a bit like that," Wormald laughed.

The former Geelong Falcons player is now in his ninth season with Werribee, the longest serving player at the club, and is currently playing under his fourth coach.

And, while he's endured the character building pendulum that goes hand in hand with an aligned club, the main reason Wormald has remained a VFL Tiger is that he loves the club.

"Werribee has been very good to me, it's been easy to stay around," Wormald said.

It was Simon Atkins and Dom Gleeson who helped convince Wormald that Werribee should be his club when he graduated from the TAC Cup at the end of the 2005 season.

Along the journey, Wormald has played under Atkins, Paul Satterley, Scott West and now John Lamont. He can count James Podsiadly, Michael Barlow, Travis Robertson, Gleeson and Rob Castello as teammates.

Wormald played his 100th game for Werribee last weekend in a career that has been punctuated by work site accidents as well as playing a liberal sprinkling of Development League games.

"There have been a few dramas, but the last three or four years have been pretty consistent," Wormald said.

Initially, those dramas included a hip injury, which ate into a season, but the more serious was an off field incident, that required a much longer break.

Wormald fell onto a concrete slab when the balcony he was working on collapsed. It left him with broken ribs, associated internal complications and a fair chunk of the season cast as a spectator.

"I was lucky. If I hit my head, who knows," Wormald said.



For the past three seasons, Wormald has been a member of the Werribee team that has made the Preliminary Final. All three games have ended in disappointment.

"It just hasn't worked our way, we haven't turned up to play on Preliminary Final day, it's been frustrating and pretty disappointing," Wormald said.

"But, I think we have got another chance this year with the team we've got. And, this time go that step further."

Playing for an aligned club, there have been times even as recently as the opening game this season, when Wormald has had to make way for a North Melbourne player. He acknowledges the frustration that comes with it.

It's a matter of coping it on the chin, as hard as the proverbial punch may feel, play your role in the Development League and present yourself for senior selection.

While it is never easy, it speaks volumes for a player's character, and everyone at Chirnside Park knows Sam Wormald has plenty of character.

# Countdown to State Game

**Next Saturday, May 31, the best of the Peter Jackson VFL will take on the best of the SANFL in an epic State League battle at North Port Oval. We take a look at both squads leading up to the game**

## VFL

**VFL coach Damian Carroll is not underestimating the challenge confronting his players when they host South Australia next Saturday at Port Melbourne.**

Carroll said the performances of South Australia in recent years in State representative matches had earned them bragging rights as the best State League competition.

He noted it was something that the VFL were keen to wrest away from the visitors when they meet for the first time in six years.

"We think we have some good depth and good experience. We're certainly excited about the upcoming challenge," Carroll said.

There's a mix of experience and rookies in the VFL squad with many of last year's VFL Team of the Year being joined by some of this season's most exciting recruits.

A total of 16 players - David Mirra, Evan Panozza, Michael Lourey, Chris Cain, Sam Fleming, Josh Scipione, Adam Cockie, Jake Wilson, Toby Pinwill, Peter Faulks, Myke Cook, Ben Jolley, Shane Valenti, Ben Duscher, Khan Haretuku, Adam Marcon - have previously represented the VFL.

Included in the squad are six club captains - Mirra (Box Hill Hawks), Panozza (Casey Scorpions), Duscher (Essendon), Nick Lower (Footscray), Cockie (Sandringham), Jolley (Williamstown)

"The SANFL have been the measuring stick over the past few years and certainly deserve the No 1 ranking in Australia, but we believe we have a good mix of guys who are really enthusiastic about playing and representing Victoria," Carroll said.

When the VFL last hosted the SANFL at Port Melbourne in 2005, the visitors emerged from an epic battle four point winners, but then the SANFL smashed the VFL by 65-points in 2008.

Carroll said the strength of the VFL will be measured by those players who don't gain selection when the final 22 players are announced, with the focus on picking a team that is suited to the Port Melbourne ground.

He believes the ability to win the contested football on the small Port Melbourne ground will play a telling role in which team will emerge victorious.

Carroll, the games record holder at Springvale (nee Casey Scorpions) who played VFL State football in 1997-98, said it had been challenging reducing the initial squad to 40 players.

He noted that players can come from outside the squad if their form over the past few weeks warrants it.

Williamstown recruit Ryan Ferguson, who represented

the SANFL and won a Fos Williams Medal for the best SA player, could not be considered because of injury while Box Hill Hawks premiership players best and fairest winner Sam Iles was unavailable for family reasons.

# SANFL

**There is no shortage of familiar names, both from an ex-VFL and also ex-AFL perspective, in the South Australian National Football League squad that faces the VFL next week.**

Headlining the former AFL contingent is ex-Tiger/Crow Richard Tambling, who was taken at number 4 in the 2004 AFL National Draft.

Tambling played 125 AFL games in a career that never reached the dizzy heights that his draft selection may have indicated.

But, the 27-year-old showed he still has much to offer at the SANFL level with his performances this season with Sturt.

The SANFL squad, coached by Michael Godden, also includes a JJ Liston Trophy winner - Ian Callinan, who won the VFL's highest individual award in 2005 when he played with Tasmania.

Callinan, 29, played 32 games with Adelaide after making his AFL debut in 2011.

Former North Melbourne small forward Matt Cambell, who played with the Roos' aligned club North Ballarat, is another ex-AFL player in the SA squad.

The squad also includes another ex-Rooster, Michael Wundke, who spent several seasons on North Melbourne's list, but is best remembered as a dual North Ballarat premiership player.

Wundke, now playing for Woodville-West Torrens, proved a pivotal forward for the Roosters in its 2008-09 flags.

Matthew Panos (Williamstown), Nick Liddle (Coburg Lions), Brett Eddy (Collingwood/Geelong) and Joel Cross (Box Hill Hawks) all played in the VFL in recent years.

Cross is an interesting case study as he graduated from Old Xaverians, played a season with Old Camberwell before spending the 2000-09 seasons with Box Hill Hawks.

During his time with the VFL Hawks, Cross won the '09 A. Todd Medal for the fairest and best player in the VFL Development League.

Unable to secure a permanent position in Box Hill Hawks senior team, Cross moved to Eastern District Football League club Scoresby.

For the past few seasons, Cross has been playing with South Adelaide and in 2012 he tied with Brad Symes for the Margarey Medal, the SANFL version of the JJ Liston Trophy.

# Standing tall for the Lions

**Peter German candidly admitted his knowledge of Lech Featherstone was confined to sketchy background information when Coburg's pre-season opened.**

German noted that Featherstone was just another face in a sea of new faces when Coburg began the task of assembling a list for its standalone 2014 season.

It quickly became evident to German that Featherstone wasn't just another anonymous face. He had some size about him - 193 cm - but also many other qualities.

Featherstone, 25, arrived at Coburg having won the past two best and fairests at Pascoe Vale in the Essendon District Football League. Before that he played in a couple of premierships at Heathcote.

But, it was Featherstone's personal qualities that impressed German, so much so he elevated him to the leadership group.

"He generally cares about what is happening and about how the team performs," German said

"Lech has turned into a real key contributor at a club where the average age is 20, he has taken on that responsibility."

While Featherstone has shouldered that responsibility, just as importantly he has performed at a consistently high level. That form has been rewarded with a place in the VFL State squad for next week's representative match against South Australia at Port Melbourne.

Not bad for a guy who thought he'd come down for a run at pre-season training to see if he could make it on to the list.

"I went for a bit of a run around to see if I enjoyed it and here we are," Featherstone said.

"I didn't really have too many expectations. I just wanted to train hard and see if I could improve my fitness and my game.

"I was just happy to be on a list and playing seniors." His football journey stretches back to the TAC Cup where he played under Mark Ellis at Bendigo Pioneers for a couple of seasons

After leaving the Pioneers, Featherstone returned to his junior club Heathcote where he played in four Grand Finals in as many years.

While he enjoyed playing with mates he'd come through the juniors with, the constant travelling to and from



Melbourne where he was attending university saw him join Pascoe Vale.

Following two outstanding personal seasons, it was suggested to him that he should challenge himself at the VFL level.

Featherstone is Coburg's sole tall marking option among a 'mosquito' fleet, but he's more than held sway against a bevy of taller opponents.

He hopes he can make it through to the final squad of 22 for the State match, but if he doesn't it won't be the worst thing in the world.

Lech Featherstone is just happy to be playing good football for a club he's really embraced and that's embraced him.

# Mirra making the captaincy his own

**David Mirra was appointed captain of Box Hill Hawks for season 2014, but in essence he captained the club in its premiership triumph last year.**

Mirra found himself elevated to acting captain last year when club captain Daniel Pratt injured himself in late July. Try as hard as he did, Pratt was unable to get back into the team.

He admitted there was an element of a "heavy heart" attached to his wonderful moment as the VFL Hawks upset the heavily favoured Geelong.

"Obviously, 'Pratty' had been our skipper for the past two years, but he succumbed to injury and couldn't get back into the side," Mirra said.

"You feel bad because your captain is not playing, but at the same time to be acting captain and be fortunate enough to win the premiership was a huge thrill."

When Pratt decided to retire from playing VFL, it paved the way for Mirra to be officially appointed club captain.

"It is my fifth year at the club, it is a massive honour and a huge thrill to be captaining the club," Mirra said.

"When 'Pratty' was injured last year it gave me an opportunity to step up and it gave me some good experience.

"And, when 'Pratty' left the club at the end of last year, the club and the boys voted on the position and I was able to get the nod."

Mirra captains a club that has what most belief is the best

alignment in the VFL with Hawthorn. He notes the synergy is readily evident.

He said everyone on the Box Hill Hawks and Hawthorn lists "buys in" to what the alignment is trying to achieve.

"When everyone does that, we are going to have some good results," Mirra said.

"It is a partnership that works well and it has been really good to see some of the Hawthorn listed players - Mitch Hallahan, Will Langford, Angus Litherland, Derick Wanganeen - who played in the Box Hill premiership get their opportunity in the AFL this season."

Along with the responsibility of being captain and a VFL Multicultural Ambassador in 2014, for the second successive year, Mirra has been named in the VFL State squad.

"It's absolutely huge," Mirra said.

"Just to be able to pull on the big V jumper, it is such a tradition going back more than 100 years. If I'm fortunate enough to again be representing the VFL against such a rival state in South Australia will be a huge honour.

"It is a good concept and we've seen from the past State games guys like Sam Lloyd, Kyle Martin, Leigh Osborne all play well and then be drafted.

"It is a great chance to test yourself against the best from another State as well as having the honour of representing your State."

# Metro and Country square off

**Football's oldest rivalry is alive and well after Vic Country's U18 Boys Squad helped square the ledger with their Vic Metro counterparts on Sunday.**

A come-from-behind victory in Round 1 of the NAB AFL U18 Championships saw Country claim bragging rights and draw level with on one win apiece on the 2014 scorecard.

Representative sides from all levels of football will see the battle between the bush and the burbs reach new heights this year.

Metro were the first to strike in the AFL Youth Girls National Championships, edging out a determined Country side by five points.

But Sunday's triumph by the Country lads ensured a tied ledger with four massive games to come.

The U18 squads will clash for a second time in the reformatted NAB AFL U18 Championships on June 9 at Visy Park, which could go a long way to deciding the 2014 title.

Country and Metro will also clash at the Under 16 National Championships, with Country looking to defend the title captured in 2013.

The fight for bragging rights will also be waged in the

Victorian Women's Football League's Country v Metro blockbuster on June's Queens Birthday Weekend.

The WorkSafe AFL Victoria Country team will be selected following the WorkSafe Country Championships, held this weekend, and is likely to include talent from every corner of the state.

The Country boys will play a Metro line-up, selected on the back of the Metro Championships on Saturday, March 29, which saw Melbourne's premier six senior leagues involved in an epic triple header.

# VFL Round wrap: Round 7

## We take a look at the Peter Jackson VFL Round 7 action:

### Box Hill remain on top

Box Hill Hawks continued its unbeaten start to the season with an 18-point win over Richmond.

In front of a full house of 2,500 at the reduced capacity Punt Road Oval, the Hawks overcame a slow start to take control of the game in the second term and set up win number six of the season.

Trailing by 12 points at quarter time, Box Hill added seven goals to two in the second term, to take a 20-point lead into the second half.

Despite the return of Ivan Maric for the Tigers, it was Hawks tall Jon Ceglar who was the best bigman on the day, among the best for the Hawks as he combined in the ruck and up forward.

It was an even spread of goal kickers that got the Hawks over the line, with Tim O'Brien and Xav Murphy their only multiple goal kickers from 11 separate goal scorers. Ben Ross was among the best along with Ayden Kennedy, Luke Andrews and David Mirra.

For Richmond, Luke Conca bagged three, and Shane Edwards two, with their best Dylan Grimes, Matt Dea and Brad Helbig.

### Port still unbeaten

Port Melbourne gave 200 game player Sam Fleming a milestone match to remember, as they defeated Essendon by 18 points at Windy Hill.

Port got off to the best start possible, leading by 23 points before the Bombers hit the scoreboard. But at quarter time Port's early ascendancy was not evident with two late goals to Essendon reducing their lead to just nine points.

The game followed a similar path in the second term as Adrian Bonaddio helped Port back out to a 23 point lead, only for Josh Mellington to lead a home side revival with two goals cutting the half time margin to just six points.

After Port Melbourne led in the first half, Essendon drew level then kicked in front with a Shaun Edwards goal. The goal for goal finish to the term set the game up for a thrilling finale.

The final term however was a less than spectacular finale to the tight match, with 3.13 scored for the final term between the two teams; Port unable to ice the game with an eleven behind final term.

Kyle Hardingham drew the Bombers back within six points in the final term, two late goals saw Port record win number six.

Mitch Wooffindin and Bonaddio led the way with two goals each for Port, while their best were Luke Tynan,

Shannon Lange and Chris Cain.

Hardingham and Mellington kicked two each for Essendon, with O'Brien, Sean Gregory and Cory Dell'Ollio were their best.

### Seagulls into third spot

Williamstown has moved to third on the Peter Jackson VFL ladder with a strong 25-point win over Geelong.

The loss meant back to back defeats for Geelong, with the Cats yet to record a win against a top eight side this season.

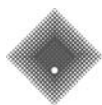
