Congratulations to the South Australian National Football League for their deserved win against the Peter Jackson VFL last weekend at the North Port Oval.

It was a high standard State representative match between two proud and determined rivals, a game that had intensity and plenty of pressure from the first to almost the last siren.

For most of the match it was your old fashion arm wrestle, our VFL team pushed their lead out to 11 points about 10 minutes into the last quarter but credit to the South Australians for rallying after that point to claim a hard fought victory.

Once again the depth and talent of State League football was readily evident, the honour of representing their State League competition not lost on any of the players.

Speaking with some of the coaches and officials the camaraderie, spirit and passion that State Football engineers is something quite unique and special to the game.

The feedback from both captains when interviewed after the game was that all the players were really committed to being part of the team and appreciated the opportunity.

Many thanks to the coach of the Peter Jackson VFL Damian Carroll, support staff and all those who volunteered their time to help represent the VFL competition so well. The time and effort that this support group put into the State game and the players was significant and very much appreciated.

The Peter Jackson VFL wasn't the only Victorian representative team in action last weekend with Vic Country and Vic Metro continuing their NAB AFL U18 Championship schedule of matches, another spotlight occasion during the football calendar.

Vic County, after jumping South Australia early in its match at AAMI Stadium, succumbed by 22-points.

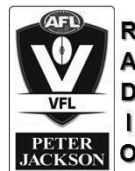

Williamstown celebrates 150th Anniversary with Hall of Fame induction

Williamstown Football Club headlined its 150th anniversary celebrations by honouring five former players as 'legends' in its inaugural Hall of Fame induction ceremony last weekend.

Barry Round, one of only two men to win a Brownlow Medal and Liston Trophy; goal kicking goliath Ron Todd; five-time premiership captain Gerry Callahan; five-time premiership player and triple best and fairest winner Ray Smith and Ian 'Chops' Rickman, a mercurial goal-kicker and dual premiership player are the inaugural WFC legends.

As well as honouring those afore mentioned legends, Williamstown inducted 51 players, coaches, officials and volunteers into its inaugural Hall of Fame in front of more than 600 people at Crown Casino.

Williamstown's proud and successful journey was depicted in film and in interviews with the pivotal people that have made the club what it is today.

Included in the production was the recruitment of Todd from Collingwood, the reasoning behind the late Ron James being selected as a 14-year-old for the 1985 Grand Final as well as documenting the failed forced merger with Werribee in 1995.

Club General Manager Brendan Curry, one of the Hall Of Fame inductees, said the club decided the Hall Of Fame would headline its historic 150 years milestone.

Curry said after countless hours of pain-staking research and discussion it was settled on 51 people as deserved recipients of Hall Of Fame status.

He said to assist in defining the Hall Of Fame they broke the club up into three specific eras.

The first era was named the trail blazers, which categories

those who were at the club from its formative year of 1864 until 1900.

The second era was termed the Villagers, which takes in the history of the club from 1901 until 1950.

The final era is from 1951 to the current day, the most successful era of the club where it has won 10 premierships and five JJ Liston Trophy's.

Janet Dooley is the only woman in the Hall Of Fame, a reflection of her continuous volunteer work for the club stretching back more than 60 years.

Dooley still runs the canteen at Point Gellibrand, just as she did back in 1952. She also organised and ran the ladies Committee for 15-years and just three years ago was awarded the League's Alex Gillon Medal for services to the competition.

Also among the inductees is John James Liston, president of Williamstown for eight years before occupying the same position with the VFA for 28 years. And, of course, JJ Liston's name is annually perpetuated in the award honouring the competition's fairest and best player.

18 captains - Martin 'Tottie' Fitzpatrick, William 'Jaspar' Jones, Walter Warren, Jim Caldwell, Gordon 'Butch' Ogden, Ron Todd, Gerry Callahan, Ray Smith, Daryl Ward, John Fanning, Barry Round, Max Papley, Terry Wheeler, Tony Pastore, Saade Ghazi, Troy West, Brad Lloyd and Brett Johnson - were inducted.

And, just seven coaches - Wally Carter, who led the Seagulls to a hat-trick of premierships in the mid-1950s, Caldwell, Ogden, Callahan, Papley, Wheeler and Round - also found themselves in the Hall Of Fame.

SANFL triumphs again over VFL

The decade long winless drought against the SANFL continued last weekend for the Peter Jackson VFL, suffering a 22-point defeat.

Despite the VFL opening an 11-point lead early in the final term, the visitors stormed home with six of the last seven goals of the game to claim the win 18.10 118 to 14.12 96.

Williamstown's Adam Marcon was awarded the Frank Johnson Medal for his tireless work around the ground, amassing 29 disposals in the VFL loss. It was the VFL that opened the scoring for the afternoon through Julian Rowe, but then struggled to contain Tim McIntyre who sparked the SANFL with two goals in five minutes to grab the lead. Leigh Ryswyk made it three in a row, but a late snap by Adam Cockie ensured the VFL were back within five points at quarter time.

SANFL extended its lead to 17 points early in the second with the first two majors to Michael Wundke, but a few positional moves saw the VFL fight back.

Rowe was strong on the lead up forward, while his Port teammates Chris Cain and Shane Valenti started to rack up possessions up forward. All three goaled to give the VFL the lead, and Scott Sherlock saw it out to seven points nearing half time.

Nick Lower was gaining possessions at will, with 19 up to half time, but the home side were unable to hold the advantage at the main break, as Ian Callinan showcased his skills on both sides of the body with two late goals to see SANFL lead by four points.

Neither team could gain the early advantage in the third, till Cain again came into the match, firstly up forward with a goal, then in the middle with numerous forward entries.

Marcon was steady in the middle for the VFL but missed opportunities early cost the home side. The SANFL was deadly with its run off half back, opening up their forward line for Steven Summerton and Wundke to kick two each, and suddenly the lead was out to 20 points entering time on.

The VFL finished the term with three of the last four goals to cut the margin back to nine points at the final change. The VFL looked as if it would break its drought that dated back to 2002, with three goals in six minutes to open the final term. Scott Clouston, Lower and Josh Scipione giving the home side an 11-point lead.

But as had been the case all afternoon, the SANFL got a run of goals, with the likes of Zane Kirkwood, Joel Cross and James Boyd continuing to push them forward. It was

a list of former VFL players that came back to haunt the competition with Callinan (3 goals), Wundke (5) and Brett Eddy (3) adding four in a row to quickly see the SANFL back in the lead by 15 points. A pair to Jonathon Beech ended the contest with the visitors home by 22 points.

Kirkwood was presented the Fos Williams Medal for the best on ground for the SANFL.

For the VFL, Marcon was a four quarter performer, along with Lower who finished with 32 disposals, Cain (30 & 8 marks), Cam Lockwood in defence(22), the captain Sam Fleming (23) and Nick Meese in the ruck with 39 hit outs.

Stats don't tell the story

Winning the statistics was not enough to get the Peter Jackson VFL over the line against the SANFL.

Despite dominating possession and all of the key match indicators, the VFL didn't come out on top on the scoreboard.

"The players, coaches and staff were really disappointed that we could not get the job done, especially when we thought we controlled a lot of the game, but were unable to use the ball well enough and hurt them with scoreboard pressure," VFL coach Damian Carroll said after the game.

"Full credit to the SANFL, their run was really good, along with their ability to use the ball. Their transition from defensive 50 was good through quick and clean ball movement.

"We had over 50 more touches, won the clearances and won the contested ball but they were the better side on the day."

Carroll believes that the experience of the SANFL side was evident during the game, with an awareness of their teammate's game style a key to the way they ran the ball.

"They had a lot of guys that have played together for a long period of time, and it seemed to show as they knew

each other's game pretty well."

For the younger players, Carroll believes they will only benefit from the step up in standard, and what is expected playing against the best from other states.

"It was another step up in their football, and will hold them in good stead for future years and back at their VFL club.

"They acquitted themselves well, and there is definitely some ability there to get an opportunity at AFL level and it will help to get them exposed to a higher level."



Frank Johnson Medallist

Like all his teammates, Adam Marcon was devastated by the VFL's lost to South Australia in last weekend's State representative match. But for the young Williamstown player the day came with moments he'll always cherish.

Presented with the Frank Johnson Medal for the best Victorian player, Marcon by chance bumped into Johnson as he was leaving North Port Oval.

During his career Johnson won five best and fairest awards at Port Melbourne, captained and coached the club, played in a premiership, won All Australian honours in an era when the team included then VFL players and then moved to the VFL aged 27 where he won the South Melbourne best and fairest in his first season.

Johnson was inducted to the AFL Hall Of Fame in 2008, the only VFA player to receive such kudos.

For Marcon, the chance to chat casually and candidly with Johnson is something he said he would "always hold very close to his heart".

He and Johnson shot the breeze for about 10-minutes during which Marcon could only marvel at some of the stories the ex-Port Melbourne ruck man was to tell.

"I told him it was such an honour to win the medal carrying

his name," Marcon said.

"It was great to have a chat with such a legend."

Marcon was a deserved winner of the Frank Johnson Medal.

He collected 29 possessions in a tireless performance that saw coach Damian Carroll start him on the wing and then push him into the midfield.

While he wasn't entirely satisfied with his first half, Marcon said he felt he worked into the game better after half time and was able to help his team more.

"It was a really disappointing result," Marcon said.

"I thought we had the legs to run over the top of them in the last quarter. We came at them really hard and then we seemed to hit the wall.

"I think we can still hold our heads up high that we played really well and obviously, we came up against a really good team."

Vale Laurie Hill

Out at Cramer Street, Northern Blues players talk about the 'Ants spirit'.

It's been a baton passed on down through time since Preston joined the then VFA back in 1903 and was prevalent in the 20-year period from the mid-1960s to the mid-1980s when Preston was a competition powerhouse.

Few typified the Ants spirit more than Laurie Hill, the boy from Thornbury who represented Collingwood and Victoria with distinction before he made his way to Cramer Street.

Hill passed away last month. Peter Weightman, a former teammate of Hill, who enjoyed a lifelong friendship, described him as a "wonderful human being and a champion player."

The esteem in which Hill was held both at Collingwood and Preston was showcased by the hundreds who came to farewell him in Watsonia late last month.

Preston and Hawthorn premiership coach Alan Joyce, Wayne and Max Richardson, Barry Leslie, Ray Saltmarsh, Lenny Clark, Harold Martin, Mick Irwin and Eddie McGuire were among the mourners.

What remains a vivid memory for Weightman is the "raking left foot drop kicks" which were Hill's signature disposal as well as his innate ability to read the play.

"I remember watching him play great football for Collingwood, it was a surprise that he got let go. He was very talented," Weightman recalled.

"He was one player that took advantage of the fact there was no wings in those days in the VFA. He was always able to obtain a possession from the centre bounce because he knew where to run and receive.

"His big, raking drop kicks were fantastic."

Hill brought to Preston 114 games experience at Collingwood, two Big V guernseys, two Grand Final appearances (1964 & '66) as well as an eighth-place in the 1964 Brownlow Medal.

He came to a club laden with ability, led by subsequent Hawthorn premiership coach Alan Joyce and Dick Telford, Clark, Leslie, Schickert, Bob Heard and Weightman as his teammates.

To the surprise of no-one Hill made an immediate impact with the Bullants.

Hill was a pivotal player in Preston's 1969 premiership win against Dandenong at the Punt Road Oval in a team that included Joyce, Telford, Schickert, Clark, Heard and Leslie.

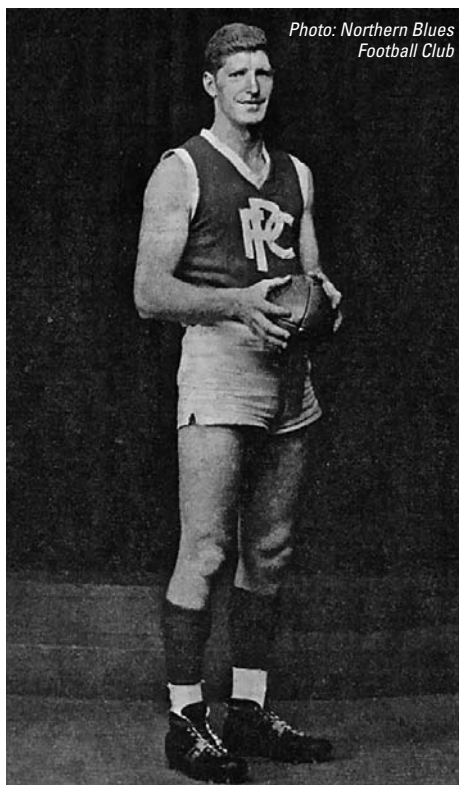

It was also the year that Hill would be acclaimed as the JJ Liston Trophy winner, the highest individual honour in the competition.

He did not win the club best and fairest that season - it was won by the Telford, the Liston Trophy winner from the previous season.

Hill would win the next two Preston best and fairests and be a member of the Bullants team which controversially lost the 1971 VFA Grand Final to Dandenong by one goal.

It was also the year where Hill claimed his second Liston Trophy and thus becoming one of just six players - Alan Poore (1965-66), Vic Aanensen (1979-81), Billy Swan (1982-83), David Robbins (2000, '03) and Shane Valenti (2010-11) to win the award twice.

These days the Northern Blues best and fairest award carries Laurie Hill's moniker.

It's a fitting reminder to a true champion.

The right fit

As reigning premiers Box Hill Hawks embarked on their planning for season 2014 one of their first priorities was to replace retiring captain Daniel Pratt.

Just like all clubs, Box Hill General Manager Paul Barnard was tracking the exiting players from the AFL.

The VFL Hawks tend to hone in on one or two delisted AFL players rather than cast the net too wide. It's been a successful recruiting practice over a number of years.

One player that kept on coming back into the spotlight was Ayden Kennedy, a fifth round selection by North Melbourne from the 2009 National Draft.

Kennedy had spent four seasons on the Roos' list, but was unable to break into the senior team. With 40 VFL games with North Melbourne's affiliate Werribee, the 22-year-old was what Barnard described as the "perfect fit".

While Kennedy admitted he was tempted to remain playing with Werribee, several things helped Box Hill Hawks get him over the line.

Kennedy lives in the eastern suburbs and came through the Eastern Ranges with David Mirra, who this season was elevated to Box Hill captain.

He also still has a burning desire to reignite his AFL passion and play football at the highest level possible.

"He was ear marked as the player we wanted," Barnard said.

"He could provide leadership to our young list, he had experience of being in an AFL club environment and we were confident he could provide what we were after on field."

Kennedy hasn't disappointed his new club.

He has been a consistently good player as evidenced by the fact that he was selected and represented the VFL in last weekend's State match against South Australia.

For the unobtrusive Kennedy he's just happy to play whatever role coach Marco Bello asks him. Certainly, he's not looking any further ahead than the clichéd next game.

"Winning has to be your first priority regardless of where you are playing," Kennedy said.

"Playing your role within the team and helping getting towards the ultimate goal of winning a premiership is what it's all about.

"If everyone is playing well and contributing, it showcases everyone."

Kennedy said he was able to "read the play" midway through last year that his time with North Melbourne was coming to an end.

While he had played consistently well he had been unable to force his way into the team.

Football doesn't stand still for anyone so Ayden Kennedy had to look towards the next chapter of his football life.

All the indicators are positive that he's just the player Barnard and the VFL Hawks had hoped.

VFL Round wrap: Round 8

Let's take a look back at Round 8 of the Peter Jackson VFL and how the results unfolded:

Cats losing streak continued by Collingwood

Collingwood bundled Geelong out of the top eight for the first time this season with a 40-point win.

The win was a fitting way to celebrate Sam Dwyer's 100th VFL match, after 97 games with Port Melbourne over eight seasons, and his third game for Collingwood VFL (all in this season).

The loss made it three defeats in a row for Geelong.

After a goal for goal start to the game, it was a Patrick Karnezis first of six goals for the day that gave his side the lead midway through the first quarter, one they would not relinquish for the rest of the afternoon.

With only 22 points separating the sides at half time, Collingwood set up its win with a four goal to one third term, with Geelong only able to find one goal from its eight scoring attempts.

Karnezis added his sixth on the three quarter time siren, already disposing of three opponents for the game, giving the home side a 40 point lead – the margin it would remain after an even final term.

Kyle Martin was again among the best for Collingwood, along with Lachlan Ferguson, Karnezis and Tim Broomhead.

Brad Hartman, Jackson Thurlow (20 disposals) and Tom Maas were the best for Geelong, with Shane Kersten kicking two goals on his return from injury, one of four multiple goal kickers for the Cats.

Werribee win battle of the Tigers

Werribee has continued its climb up the ladder moving into the top four with a 51-point win in the battle of the Tigers.

Werribee overcame a slow start against an inaccurate Richmond, with the first goal of the game not scored until the 25-minute mark of the first term by Jesse Crichton.

It gave the home side the lead, with Richmond having to wait until midway through the second term for their first major, kicking nine straight behinds to start the game.

With a 17-point lead at half time, Werribee jumped out to a 33-point lead in the third term, with Ben Brown kicking his second, and the home side finding multiple options to goal.

Richmond surged back within three goals, with Aaron Edwards kicking his second and Anthony Miles giving his side plenty of drive. But when Ben Warren added his first goal on the siren it gave the home side a 20-point lead going into the final term.

It was all Werribee in the final term, kicking seven goals to two to run out 51-point winners.

Jye Bolton, Tom Gribble and Scott Sherlock were among the best for Werribee with Warren 3, Brown 2 and Mason Wood 2 part of 13 individual goal kickers.

Ivan Maric (19 disposals) and Aaron Edwards both kicked two goals to be part of the best for Richmond along with Nick Wynne (20) and Ricky Petterd (28).

Footscray ends Coburg's winning run

Footscray has gone a game clear inside of the top eight after a 34-point win over Coburg.

Footscray kicked three unanswered goals to open the game, Jack Redpath (two first quarter goals) providing a forward focal point along with Ayce Cordy.

Leading by 19 points at quarter time, Footscray withstood fierce pressure from Coburg during the second term to lead by 22 points at half time. Coburg kicked the first and last goal of the term, but was unable to stop the Bulldogs' run midway through the quarter.

Out to a 59-point lead in the third term, Footscray looked home, but Coburg again challenged through Lech Featherstone to cut the deficit to 46-points at the final change.

The Bulldogs quick starts to each term were a highlight of the match, as they again dominated early in the final term jumping out to a 54-point lead. Coburg however showed resilience to cut the final margin back to 34 points.

Mitch Honeychurch was the leading goal kicker along with Redpath with three each, with the Bulldogs best including Christian Howard, Jarrad Grant and Jordan Russell.

Featherstone 2, Dan Younan 2 and Ozgur Uysal 2 all kicked two for the Lions, with Adam Saad (23 disposals), Erroll McConnell and Michael Hartley their best.

Essendon continues Northern's Blues

Essendon had a dominant 44-point win over the Northern Blues in their final game of the season at Windy Hill.

A four goal to one third term helped set up the win for Bombers, as Essendon led from start to finish, winning every quarter for the afternoon.

The defeat sees the Blues slump to its fourth loss in a row, dropping to 13th spot on the ladder.

Dan Coghlan continued his good form with four goals – three in the final term – in a best a field performance, joined by Nick O'Brien, Ariel Steinberg and Lachlan Dalgleish in the best. 23rd player Jack Langford kicked three, Cory Dell'Olio two.

For the Northern Blues, Tom Wilson (22 disposals) was their only multiple goal scorer with two, named among the best along with Ciaran Sheehan, Daniel Watson (22) and Nick Graham (28).

Port moves to top spot

Port Melbourne is on top of the ladder, after defeating Box Hill Hawks by seven points in an enthralling contest at Box Hill City Oval.

The top of the ladder clash between the Hawks and the Borough lived up to the hype, with Port Melbourne remaining the only undefeated senior team in the VFL after eight rounds.

Despite Port Melbourne leading from start to finish, they were unable to shake Box Hill all afternoon, with 17 points the biggest margin of the day.

After Port kicked the first three goals of the game, Box Hill settled late in the first term, turning the match into a goal for goal shootout. This was typified by the second term, with 11 goals scored as the margin fluctuated between eight and two points all quarter; Ayden Kennedy influential up forward for the Hawks.

The same continued in the third stanza, with Box Hill Hawks able to draw level at the 19 minute mark, but not hit the front, in the epic encounter.

Leading by two points going into the final term, the experience of a John Baird, Marcus Marigiani, Chris Cain and Toby Pinwill proved the difference, as Port ran down the clock in the dying stages to deny the Hawks any late chances.

Julian Rowe led the way for Port with five goals, with

Sandy Robinson kicking two. Baird, Pinwill, Cain, Daniel Noonan, Rowe and livewire Jack Sinclair were among their best.
