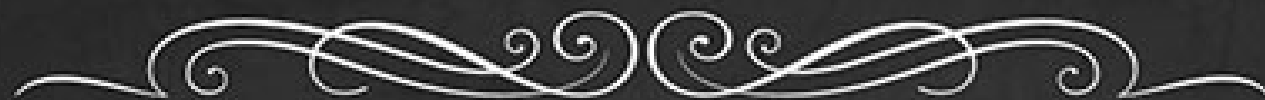

On another note I would like to remind parents of the need for their assistance at training and game day. Whilst it may be difficult to attend training sessions, parental assistance on game day is essential. Each team manager will provide families with a weekly roster of duties needed for game day, e.g., goal umpire, timekeeper, interchange, first aid and

oranges. If you are rostered on for a duty and become unavailable for some reason please contact your team manager or arrange a suitable replacement.
