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

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No Gold in 2015 VFL

Late last month the Bendigo Football Club informed AFL Victoria that it would not continue in the Peter Jackson VFL in season 2015.

It's disappointing news given the tireless hard work of Chairman Tim Dickson, his board and coach Aussie Jones in the past couple of seasons.

Dickson and Jones in particular have put their heart and soul into the past two seasons and into the Bendigo community and neighbouring areas to build a standalone VFL club in Bendigo.

But, Bendigo, after analysing the club's financial projections, made a tough, but correct decision that its current business model was unsustainable to run a prosperous, viable and suitably supported club in the Peter Jackson VFL.

Bendigo felt it was best for all concerned, particularly for its loyal and dedicated players, coaches and support staff, to make an announcement at this point of the season that the club will not seek a VFL licence next year.

It was a responsible decision, given that at the end of last season Bendigo chose to execute a campaign to garner local support which provided some initial impetus but in the end was not able to be translated into a long term solution.

The club has looked calmly and pragmatically at their position and acted clinically when they determined that they would not be able to meet the commitments expected of them.

Bendigo has made a commitment to play out the 2014 season and AFL Victoria will assist as far as possible for the final seven home and away games.

Meanwhile, as the season enters its second half the competitiveness of the Peter Jackson VFL is evidenced by the fact that mathematically 14 of the 16 teams still remain in the race for the finals.

Obviously, the challenge for Casey Scorpions and

Richmond is greater than some other clubs, but what makes the Peter Jackson VFL so engrossing is that on any given week any club

can beat another club, regardless of their ladder standing.

It's what makes the competition so strong, competitive as well as highly entertaining.

Entwined in the run home is not only the battle for the final eight, but the battle within for the upper rungs of the ladder, which bring with it the coveted double chance.

It's been a season that has sprung more than the odd surprise, but reigning premier Box Hill Hawks is well placed to defend its crown.

Certainly, the good first half from Footscray, fielding for the first time a standalone club, as well as Williamstown, also standing as its own entity, has been encouraging.

Now that the NAB AFL U18 Championships are over, the focus in the TAC Cup is aimed towards the finals where the opportunity for players to showcase their ability under finals pressure historically enhances their prospects of being selected in one of the AFL Drafts.

Congratulations to all those associated - coaches, players and support staff, with Vic Country and Vic Metro on their successful NAB AFL U18 Championship campaigns.

As always the final seven weeks of the season will produce many twists and turns before the composition of the Peter Jackson VFL and TAC Cup finals are ultimately determined

The annual finals race in any competition is one of the many aspects that make our game so great.

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Full Forwards - A disappearing act

Bob Bonnett and Fred Cook, the goal-kicking goliaths who recently had the ends of the North Port Oval named in their honour, would be wondering what's happened to today's spearheads.

Bonnett and Cook sit third and first respectively on the VFA/VFL goal kicking honour roll with a collective 2269 goals, a combined 10 competition leading goal kicking titles and an accumulative 23 club goal kicking awards.

Bonnett kicked a century of goals once in a season and twice finished in the 90s while Cook booted a hundred goals seven times.

Centurian goal kickers was a signature of VFA full forwards, but over the past quarter of a century it has diminished with just two reaching the coveted ton.

Springvale's Shayne Smith kicked 106 goals in 1997 and Aaron Edwards booted 100 goals in his historic JJ Liston/'Frosty' Miller winning season of 2006.

Current Essendon General Manager, Matthew Little, has come the closest of any spearhead since Edwards with his 'Frosty' Miller winning season of 80 in 2010.

No longer is the talk of a full forward kicking the ton, its more will they crack the 50?

As the VFL heads into the back half of the 2014 season, the leading goal kicker is on track to kick the lowest total since somewhat ironically, Bonnett kicked 44 goals to top the goal kicking in 1963.

Coburg's Lech Featherstone leads the goal kicking with 26 goals. There are 14 players within eight goals of the Lions' gun recruit.

Last season Dean Galea won the 'Frosty' Miller Medal with 55 goals, the smallest since Bonnett's '64 competition-leading performance

Not only did full forwards from previous eras kick triple figure tallies, but they kicked the proverbial 'bags' - football parlance for double digit goals.

Not anymore.

The highest individual haul this season is six goals, kicked by Kyle Martin, Patrick Karnezis and Ryan Ferguson.

The biggest haul over the past couple of seasons is the 11 that Ben Warren kicked to open the 2013 season against Port Melbourne.

So, what's happened to all the goal kickers?

Galea, who kicked 333 VFL goals, is now plying his trade



with Avondale Heights in the Essendon District Football League. So is his Port Melbourne teammate, Paddy Rose, winner of the 2011 'Frosty' Miller Medal.

Warren is still playing and he's just two goals adrift of Featherstone.

Nick Sautner, a winner of an extraordinary nine 'Frosty' Miller Medals, regularly kicked between 70 - 90 goals during his reign as the VFL's best full forward. But, the number of goals kicked by a full forward has been on a rapid decline in the past five seasons.

Port Melbourne coach Gary Ayres believes there's several reasons to explain why there's no longer the high scoring full forwards.

Ayres said the key forwards in the competition now are the AFL listed players, who if they show goal kicking prowess like Geelong's Josh Walker find themselves in the AFL.

He also noted the defensive mindset of coaches to have an extra player in defence, which not only allows defenders to double team a full forward, but also to cut out his space.

"The style of playing that most clubs are predominantly playing is numbers back in front of the key forward or most dangerous forward," Ayres said.

"Really, there is very little space for them to find to ply their trade. With the game now very much about defensive half

saturation the ball generally is not being moved quickly to a one on one situation.

"The one on one situation now that a key or dangerous forward craves is very limited."

Ayres said the scrutiny of opposition clubs is now so diligent that if clubs do have a dangerous key forward, so much work goes into shutting him down and if that is a club's sole avenue to goal then clubs are not going to win too many games.

He said clubs these days needed multiple goal kickers, particularly with midfielders chipping in to spread the effectiveness and make clubs more difficult and unpredictable to play against.

"You become too predictable if you have just the one main

goal scorer. We are always on about trying to find multiple options," Ayres said.

Williamstown coach Andy Collins, a member of the Sandringham 1985 premiership team as well as playing in three flags with Hawthorn, said the generational change was another important factor.

Collins noted that players now are "taller, bigger and stronger" as evidenced by the players who are now playing in the midfield where previously they would have been forwards.

He said players on a half back flank are now 190 cm plus.


"The whole football field is bigger, stronger, taller than it's ever been in the history of the game," Collins said.

"It's therefore more difficult to mark the ball in the forward line than it has ever been and then you combine that with tactics of today and it's tougher than ever for players to kick big totals of goals."

Collins, who played alongside lan Morrison and Ross Brewer during his days at Sandringham, would like to see the great VFA full forwards of previous eras recognised with retrospective 'Frosty' Miller medals.

He believes it would be fitting recognition for their achievements.

Another factor is the money available



in suburban or country leagues, which is luring away players who previously played or could have played in the VFL.

Brendan Fevola and Justin Koschitzke are being well rewarded playing in the country, so, too Galea and Rose in community leagues.

Essendon General Manager Matthew Little said football has evolved even since he finished playing three seasons ago.

Little said with the nature of how the VFL, with all its alignments, rolled there was more volatility in selection on a weekly basis now than in the past.

He noted the pool of players who play an entire season, particularly in a set position, no longer prevails.

"With the AFL (listed) players if they are kicking a lot of goals they are tending to go up (to the AFL) pretty quickly," Little said.

"It does make it pretty difficult, but if you look at the AFL they used to have players kicking 100 plus goals. You don't see it happen very often now.

"The leading goal kicker now in the AFL is probably going to kick the 70-75 mark. They don't often kick too many more than that.

"The other thing is that scores have dropped.
Everyone is focusing very heavily on defence with so many players back inside the 50 it makes it difficult for forwards to kick big bags."

Little also noted the 'stay at home' full forward has gone the way of the typewriter - they had become obsolete.

"You don't really have that forward that plays out of the goal square anymore," Little said.



"Dean Galea played his footy from the goal square and that's probably how I played my footy to some degree."

While the days of the century goal kickers or even the half century goal kickers may appear to be a thing of the past, as football continues to evolve who knows what the future holds

Certainly, most fans would love nothing more than to see a full forward reliving the feats of Bob Bonnett or Fred Cook.

Kefford going forward with Essendon

Sometimes football can throw up the strangest set of circumstances.

Take Alistair Kefford, for example.

Kefford was amongst the best players for Calder Cannons in their stunning TAC Cup Grand Final victory against Gippsland Power in 2010.

It was a Cannons team that featured Dion Prestia, Tom Liberatore, Mitch Wallis, Cam Guthrie, Brandon Ellis, Michael Talia, Jordan Schroder and Tom Sheridan who've all progressed to play AFL.

And, in the case of Prestia, Liberatore, Wallis, Guthrie and Ellis they've all advanced to play significant roles for their respective clubs.

"I think it was the greatest Cannons team to every take the park," Kefford said.

While there were a ridiculous number of the 2010 Cannons crop selected in the various forms of the AFL Drafts, Kefford was overlooked.

He found himself at Williamstown, where he spent the season in the Seagulls Development League team.

"I enjoyed my time at Willy, but where I was with Uni and a few other things, I got a bit sick of footy," Kefford said.

He returned to his junior club Aberfeldie, but last season he spent most of the season in the twos after travelling overseas in the middle of the year.

While he played in Aberfeldie's winning Semi Final, Kefford found himself squeezed out with the return from VFL club Essendon of Josh Toy, Dave Fahey, Anthony Tipungwuti and Zac O'Brien.

Given that backdrop, Kefford has made the quantum leap to find himself actually playing with Essendon VFL.

He is one of the few VFL players to have played every game so far this season.





Out of nowhere Kefford was given a call by Essendon General Manager Matthew Little inviting him down to pre-season training.

So, what gives?

"I knew 'Skippy' (Hayden Skipworth, Essendon coach) as he played a few games at 'Abers' (Aberfeldie) and I knew Matty (Little, the Essendon General Manager) through Williamstown." Kefford said.

"Given Essendon had lost (Scott) Gumbleton and (Stewart) Crameri they were a bit short on a few tall forwards.

"I went down for pre-season, loved it and I've been able to string a few games together. I'm really happy with how the year is going."

Kefford said he had to crank up his fitness, but he's done that and kicked a goal in 10 of the 11 games as well as playing a required role.

"I thought I had enough talent to play at a decent level, I've just been working myself into the season," Kefford said.

"I've been the beneficiary of playing in a good team with good supply."

When opportunity knocks, you've got to be ready to open the door. Just ask Alistair Kefford.

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Young leading the way at Richmond

Ross Young is always up for the challenge.

It's a philosophy he's embraced from the time he played with Bendigo Pioneers in the TAC Cup to University Blues in the VAFA to Northern Bullants to Carlton to Perth then back to University Blues and finally his return to Richmond as its inaugural VFL captain.

Young has always pushed himself to test himself at the best possible level against the best possible opposition.

Along the journey it has seen him rewarded with Carlton rookie listing him, working his way on to the Blues list and finally rewarded with six AFL games.

When he moved west, Young won two best and fairest awards with Perth, captained the club as well as winning the Sandover Medal, the highest individual honour in the West Australian Football League.

On returning to Melbourne he rejoined University Blues, captained the VAFA team and won representative selection for a match in Ireland

It's an impressive CV, but Young still wanted to achieve more from his football and that's what drove him to seek an opportunity to play with Richmond.

Young initiated contact the Tigers through a friend at Coburg Tigers, which was aligned up until last year with Richmond. That led to a meeting with Richmond VFL coach Tim Clarke

"I thought I still might have a little bit to give and I thought I would give it a go," Young said.

"It was that challenge to play at the highest level and hopefully help out where I could, that's why I wanted to get involved."

For Young the most eye-opening difference is the level of professionalism that permeates through a club like Richmond.

Young said he finds himself in a "remarkably different professional environment" than the one which operated when he last played in the VFL seven seasons ago.

"The competition has definitely improved, it feels more professional, it feels more structured. The quality (of play) certainly has improved," he said.

While Richmond recruited extensively for its VFL list the season so far has not panned out as well as the Tigers would have expected.

Richmond would need to go on a winning streak of six, seven games if it is to figure in the finals.

"Obviously, we haven't got the wins we wanted to. As a

group we've tried to challenge ourselves to win as many games as possible," Young said.

"The AFL boys that have come back each week have been fantastic. I've been really impressed with their attitude.

"We've played some poor games, but we've also been in a lot of games then drop off unfortunately for a quarter.

"We have to continue to work on the game plan and play a four quarter effort. If we do that we will beat a lot of sides."

That's the next challenge for Ross Young.

WFL Round Wrap: Round 12

Let's recap all of the Peter Jackson VFL Round 12 action:

Footscray moves to second

Footscray has recorded its sixth win on the trot, with a 29-point win over North Ballarat. The win ended the Roosters six game winning run, and propelled the Bulldogs to second spot on the Bailey Ladders VFL ladder.

The first half was a scrap between the two sides, with only four goals scored. Neither team could master the blustery conditions at Simonds Stadium

With a five point lead at half time, Footscray restricted the Roosters to just six behinds in the second half, while adding four goals of their own. Brett Goodes helped set up the win for the Bulldogs with two goals in the third term.

Goodes was the only multiple goal scorer for the afternoon with two, and was among the best for the Bulldogs with Tom Campbell, Jordan Russell (24 disposals), Lin Jong and Christian Howard

Nick Rippon was best for the Roosters, along with Oliver Tate and Liam Hov in defence.

Seagulls better in the breeze

Williamstown entered its Round 13 bye for the FOXTEL Cup with a percentage boosting win against Casey Scorpions, defeating them by 80-points.

The Seagulls made the most of the breeze in the first term and third terms, keeping the Scorpions scoreless while adding 14 goals of their own (seven in each quarter). Dylan Conway was the star up forward with a match high five goals.

Jake Best scored the home sides' first goal at the 25 minute mark of the second term, and they entered half time trailing by 49 points after a textbook defensive quarter by Williamstown.

Trailing by 93-points at three quarter time, a three goal final term was unable to stop Casey recording its lowest score ever against the Seagulls.

Conway led the way with five goals, Anastasio four and Ben Davies two. Ed Carr, Nick Meese in the ruck and Davies were the best for Williamstown.

Sam Blease was the only multiple goal kicker for Casey with two (23 disposals), with Jay Kennedy Harry (31), Luke Taspott (30 and Mitch Clisby (23) their best.

Nothing separates Frankston and Essendon

Frankston has held on for a thrilling draw against a fast finishing Essendon, the Dolphins second tied score of the season.

Leading by 39-points at three quarter time, the Dolphins had no answers for the Bombers use of the corridor in the final term, as they withstood an avalanche of final term inside 50s (19-2) to come out of the match with two points for the draw.

While Frankston kicked 8 goals to 7 with the breeze, the most telling score proved to be Essendon's third term goal to Ben Duscher, the only one against the breeze to the bay end of the ground all afternoon.

Frankston had led all day when Duscher put his side within six points early in time on in the final term. But the Bombers were unable to find the major needed to put them in front, registering five behinds in a row, with a rushed behind finally tying the scores.

J.Newman kicked three for Frankston, and was among the best along with Cavarra (29 disposals), Tynan (28) and Riley Heddles in defence

Duscher was the best for the Bombers with two goals, and was joined by Dan Coughlan, Shaun Edwards and Ariel Steinberg as the better players.

Regional win for Magpies

Collingwood returned from a successful visit to Morwell, recording a 44-point win over Richmond in their regional clash

The Magpies put in a solid first term, kicking five goals to one to hold a handy 27-point lead at quarter time. Pat Karnezis returned from injury and helped the Magpies with more options to goal.

The second quarter saw the ruckman start impacting the scoreboard at either end, with Orren Stephenson and Brodie Grundy both kicking two for the term, but it was still the Magpies by 30-points at half time.

While Richmond closed the gap to 24-points early in the third term, it was the closest they would get for the second half, as Collingwood took control in the final term.

Lachlan Ferguson kicked five for the Pies - four in the second half - with Caolon Mooney 3, Jack Hellier, Corey Gault and Brodie Grundy kicking two each. Hellier, Tim Broomhead and Peter Yagmoor were the best for the Magpies.

Geelong led from start to finish, mastering the conditions early to knock the Northern Blues' from the top eight with a 71-point win.

The Cats run of unanswered goals in the first term quickly turned to eight as they restricted the Blues to just one behind in the second quarter to race out to a 57-point lead at half time

The second half was a slog between the two sides, with the scoring reduced to just six goals. Nick Graham ended a 10 goal unanswered run by Geelong midway through the third term, but the Blues could not gain any momentum.

To add to the scoreboard woes, Jarrad Waite did not take any further part in the game after three quarter time, after a knock to the hip. The Cats eventually ran out 71-point winners in a lacklustre final term.

Geelong produced five multiple goal scorers in Daniel Gibbs (3), Lincoln McCarthy, James Toohey, Nick Bourke and Jackson Hollmer (2 each), with Brad Hartman (20 disposals), Mitch Brown, Jesse Stringer (17) and Dom Gleeson (31) among their best.

Tom Wilson kicked two for the Blues, with Nick Holman, Tom Bell (23 disposals), Andrew McInness and Nick Graham (29) their best

Zebra back in the 8

Sandringham returns to the top eight after a 65-point win over Bendigo at Trevor Barker Beach Oval.

Spencer White kick two first term goals, and the Zebras produced goals from up the ground with Farren Ray and Myke Cook both scoring to help the home side to a 19-point quarter time lead.


The second term was more even as inaccuracy plagued both teams with nine behinds scored for the quarter.

Vic teams selected for UIS Championships

The next generation of players that will take to the elite stage in coming years have been chosen as part of the Vic Country and Vic Metro Under 16 squads.

Each squad has named 30 players, including five emergencies, for the NAB AFL U16 Championships which begin on the Gold Coast on Friday July 4.

As AFL Victoria Metro High Performance Manager Anton Grbac explains, the U16 Championships is the first step for these players in the national talent pathway.

"We pick with an eye on the future, to see whether a player will be an U18 Championships player.

"We do not look beyond that. If you are good enough to be an U18 Champs player that means you will obviously be considered for a draft. But you don't need to worry about setting those benchmarks at this level," Grbac said.

The Vic Metro side will be coached by Eastern Ranges assistant Mark Fisher. The coaching staff has kept a close eye on the players since late February when clubs held internal trials at regional level. The key selection period was during the formal U16 carnival over two weeks during the April school holidays.

A recent trial game versus Vic Country gave the squad the perfect warm up for the Championships.

"I think the group got a rude awaking to the demands of nationals when we played Vic Country in a trial game. Country were far better at the physical part of the game and the work part of the game.

"The guys got a quick reality check of what the nationals really mean, and to what elite football means," Grbac said.

"Across the board we are excited about the shape, size and athletic ability of the group, and are happy where the prospects are for the types of players that are on our list, even to the point where the players that missed out on the cut of 50 were quite unlucky."

AFL Victoria Country High Performance Manager Leon Harris will gather the Country squad, coached by Geelong Falcons assistant Paul Henriksen, a few days prior to the Championships for the groups' final training session. The reigning U16 champions will look to defend their title in 2014

"The Country players will come in a few days before we fly out. We had a trial match versus Metro, and the initial form from that game was good for the new group," Harris said

"You never know at U16 level, but there were very



encouraging signs which is pleasing."

A further 11 young Victorians will also participate in the NAB AFL U16 Championships as part of the World Team and Flying Boomerangs squads.

The World Team provides boys from a multicultural background with elite training, personal development and AFL talent pathway opportunities.

Six Victorians won selection in this year's World Team after being a part of the U15 Vic All Nations Squad which won the National Multicultural Championships in April.

Similar to the World team, the Flying Boomerangs is a squad made up of U15 indigenous footballers who took part in the National Kickstart Championships.

Five Victorians have been chosen in the Boomerangs line-up, rewarded for not only their performances but their leadership, school attendance and attitude.

The World Team and Flying Boomerangs will compete in a Division 3 of the NAB AFL U16 Championships against each other and teams representing the South Pacific and North-West Western Australia.
